Summer is a time of special pleasures. During this unique season, those who still live close enough to the land and livestock are lucky folks! Add to that the privilege of being a grandparent to small children who still find honest delight in nature's wonders along with you, and Honey Child, you've got a recipe for some major lasting memories!



One of my best friends ever in my life, Mr. Loyd Chapin, grows a great garden at Brashear, Texas. And he is always willing to share his squash, okra, peas, cucumbers and tomatoes with me. When the watermelons and cantaloupes start to get ripe, it's a time to take a seat at the table under his shade tree, enjoy nature's bounty and appreciate the blessings of good friendship and being alive in a free country. But for me, an even better delight is when the watermelons get ripe at the same time I'm expecting a visit from out of town grandchildren. You can be sure I take them for an experience they may never get any pother time in their lives!

Mr. Chapin grows big round green melons and he grows the long oval-shaped melons and he also sometimes grows the green stripe melons. Now, if you have been buying your melons from a grocery store or produce market, you probably are getting mostly 'seedless' melons. They're handy to eat, but some of flavor and fragrance of the natural grown melons is sacrificed. The old-time seeded melons are best. And don't forget the seed-spitting contests that go along with a watermelon feast!







Some people tell a ripe melon by thumping it for sound. That's OK but there is a surer way that some gardeners use. Mr. Chapin says that the way you tell if a melon in the field is ripe, is to look closely at the melon vine near where it is attached to the melon. There will be a little curly-cue end near the attached vine. If that curly cue is dry, it's ready. Now, if you wait until the 'umbilical' vine that is actually attached to the melon dries up, you will have probably lost the best flavor and sweetness, and your melon may actually be over-ripe and mushy!

My mother used to make watermelon rind preserves, and there's really nothing like that flavor in anything you can buy in a store. The long slow simmering of the cut-up white part of the rind with sugar produces a preserve that is honey-colored and honey-thick but with a deep, delicious flavor. We always enjoyed this on toast, or even on a slice of bread spread with peanut butter. It's a way of preserving the richness of summer's bounty. Another favorite home-cooked product is green tomato preserves. Now you have probably had green tomato relish at a fish restaurant, but this is a sweet preserve made of sliced green tomatoes and sugar, slow-cooked and simmered sort of like my mom did with the watermelon rind. But this unmistakably delicious treat comes in the fall, maybe late fall. For gardeners whose tomato plants are still bearing when a freeze is predicted, the idea is to strip the plants of all the red and green tomatoes. Cut them up in slices or

narrow hunks and use a 'right smart' amount of sugar and set em to simmering low. The finished product is rather dark and deeply flavored, sweet but also savory, a pulpy spread perfect for biscuits, that has the power to i mpress itself on your memory via your taste buds. To some folks like me.






