#### Lyndonville picks 'The Beloved Wild' for community read in September

#### Melissa Ostrom's book focused on pioneers who settled in WNY.

LYNDONVILLE – A book by an Orleans County author will be featured in a community reading effort in Lyndonville.

Melissa Ostrom of Holley wrote The Beloved Wild, which was published by Macmillan in March 2018. It honors the courage and resourcefulness of pioneer settlers in Orleans County and Western New York. "They will feel like they themselves are traveling into this territory, going from New England to Batavia and then into our territory," said Emily Cebula, director of the Yates Community Library.

Ostrom, in the fictional account, brings life to pioneer characters. The pioneers were typically just teen-agers

when they set out from New England to brave a hard journey by wagon, through dense forests, to get to Orleans County and Western New York. There wasn't a map. The pioneers followed markings on trees as they made their way west. The pioneer settlers tamed the land, and built homes and farms in the frontier. The obstacles were many – sickness, uninvited strangers, alcoholism, abuse.

Ostrom, a former Kendall high school English teacher, writes about those challenges and the indomitable spirit of pioneer settlers. The book has earned some lofty recognition, including a 2019 Amelia Bloomer selection by the American Library Association. The Amelia Bloomer Project creates an annual booklist of the best feminist books for young readers. The Beloved Wild also is a Junior Library Guild selection. Cebula said the book is a chance to vividly imagine life in Orleans County two centuries ago, and to be inspired by those pioneer settlers.

Ostrom will be speaking at the community library in Lyndonville at 6:30 p.m. on Sept. 9, and again at 7 p.m. on Sept. 12. The latter event is part of the 4thannual Orleans County Heritage Festival. Ostrom will also be meeting with Lyndonville students that week. Robert Smith, a Lyndonville native working on redeveloping part of the downtown, paid for copies of The Beloved Wild to be given to students.

Ostrom said she is "super excited" the Lyndonville community will be reading the book. This is the first time The Beloved Wild is featured in a community read, although Ostrom said many book clubs have picked the novel. This is the second community reading effort in Lyndonville where the author of the book will meet residents and answer questions.

The debut "Lyndonville Reads" featured The Queen of the Bremen by Marlies Adams DiFante of Rochester. The book is her memoir of travelling from Naples at age 5 to Nazi Germany during World War II. Her family left to see her mother's ailing father. They expected to be gone three months. It turned into seven years of struggling to stay alive.

Ostrom this spring also had her second book published by Macmillan. Unleaving highlights the courage and resilience of a 19-year-old sexual assault victim. That book will be featured in the upcoming school year by high school classes in Holley and Brockport.

ALBION — A contractor removed three houses on Liberty Street to make way for a 40-unit housing project proposed by DePaul Properties of Rochester.

DePaul last week started demolishing three unoccupied houses on Liberty Street, between the railroad tracks and Beaver Street.

DePaul is designing the project to support people with disabilities, including senior citizens and veterans. Well we have talked about how resident geese have become a problem, how the emerald ash borer is killing all out ash trees and the arrival of oak wilt. But there is much more!



MINNOWS

Mile-a-minute weed is our latest non-native and very invasive weed.

The very invasive mile-a-minute plant was found last year on the Oak Orchard WMA. This plant is a very serious threat to the native vegetation which can actually destroy it just because it is so aggressive. It's a vigorous, barbed vine that smothers other herbaceous plants, shrubs and even trees by growing over them. It's very name describes it's growth best - up to six inches per day! It is estimated that mile-a-minute weed is in only 20% of its potential U.S. range but because of it's ability to adapt to cold weather, disturbed soil areas, is primarily a self-fertile plant and does not need any pollinators to produce viable seeds it is going to become a major problem if not stopped. It's ability to flower and produce seeds over a long period of time (June through October) make mile-a-minute a prolific seeder. Seeds can be viable in the soil for up to six years and can germinate at staggered intervals.

Its leaves are alternate, light green, 2-, to 3-inches long and 1.7-, to 3.5-inches wide, and shaped like a triangle. Its green vines are narrow and delicate, becoming woody and reddish with time. The vines and the undersides of leaves are covered with re-curved barbs that aid in its ability to climb.

Seeds are carried long distances by birds, which are presumed to be the main cause of long distance spread. Deer, chipmunks, squirrels and even one particular species of ant is known to eat mile-a-minute weed fruit. Viable seeds have been found in deer scat; an indication that other animals may also be carriers.

Mile-a-minute seeds can float for seven to nine days, which allows for long distance movement in water. This movement can be increased during storms when vines hanging over waterways drop their fruit into fast moving waters, which then spread the seeds throughout a watershed. So we are going to have our hands full if this species is not stopped. But wait! What about Japanese knot weed? Another vine that can grow to 15-foot high and is great at crowding out native vegetation as it grows over it. The plant is an upright, shrubby, herbaceous, woody-appearing perennial. The stems are smooth, stout, and hollow. Where the leaves attach to the stem, the stem is swollen with a membranous sheath surrounding the joints. The leaves are broad and rounded at the base and tapering toward the end, 3-, to 6-inches long by 2-4 inches) wide, alternating on stem, broadly oval to somewhat triangular and pointed at the tip. The plant's shoots come up from a network of spreading rhizomes. These horizontal roots can reach lengths of 65 feet or more! The plant develops small winged fruits seeds which are transported by wind, water, animals, humans, or as a soil contaminant, stem fragments, and by shoots sprouting from its system of rhizomes. This invasive plant is already quite established around the State so it doesn't look good! Anything else? Yeah, how about phragmites? This perennial grass can reach over 15 foot and forms dense stands made up of living stems and standing dead stems. It too ends up crowding out our native vegetation. Here in our swamp area it made a slow start but in recent years it seems to be spreading like wild fire crowding out important swamp vegetation like cattails. We can go on and on with these invasive species but my question is how are all these things getting into our country? I thought someone at our borders were not doing their jobs but a little research on this found that many of these non-native species were not brought in recently years but back in the late 1800s and early 1900s either intentionally or by accident. Some, like multiflora rose was brought in by our government to provide dense cover for wildlife, erosion control and even as a barrier along super highways. Wow, another bad government project! Some of this stuff just took a long time to gain momentum before it got out of control. So what what can we do with all this crap now? I don't think a lot that can be done, there is just too much of it and a lot of it is already out of control. I feel it is basically is going to have to sort it's self out. In the month of July, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 2414 police incidents, including 965 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 216 for the New York State Police and 1233 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 540 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 409 of those calls emergency medical in nature and 2 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 50 automobile accidents, including 6 with injury and 19 car-deer collisions. Road patrol also made 97 service attempts and successfully served 50 subpoenas, civil, or court papers.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 173 incidents including 57 stray or loose animals, 4 animal bite complaints, 11 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 17 animals were taken in to shelter on voluntary surrenders. The Orleans County Jail processed in 95 inmates and handled 62 prisoner transports. We would like to thank all those involved with the 4H, who came together with all their hard work, to make this year's Orleans County 4H Fair an overwhelming success. As a result of the great attendance, the Sheriff's Department was able to perform a record number of "Operation SAFECHILD" identifications.
