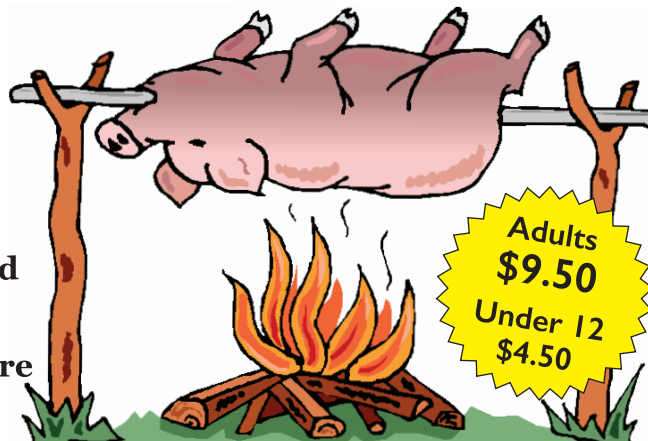

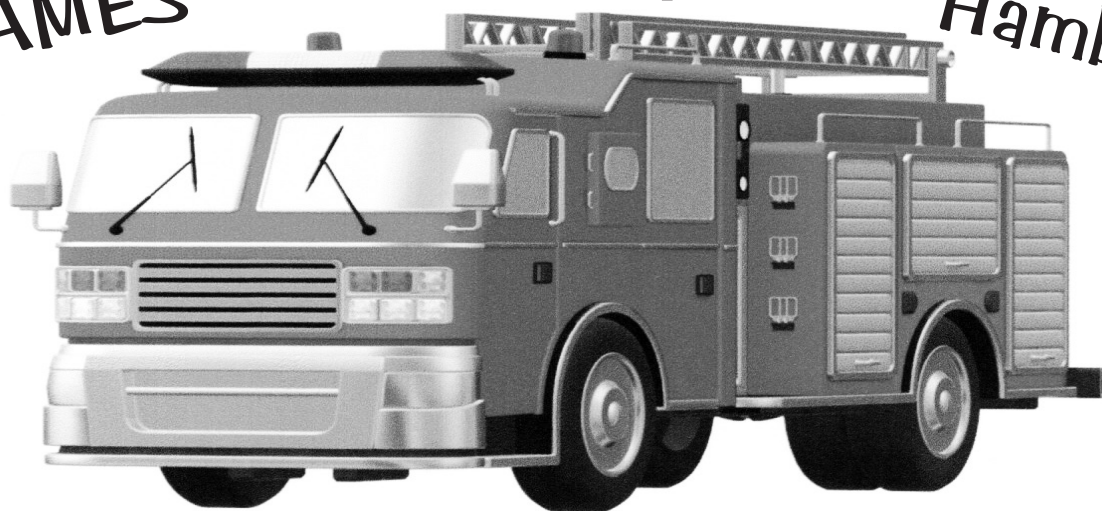

As we have said before, we are lucky to live in a community that shows so much sympathy and offers of help when needed. It is all whole heartedly appreciated.

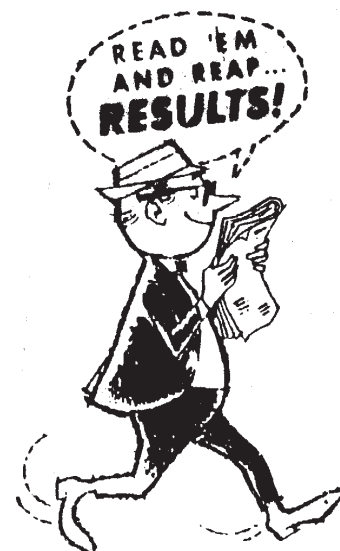
