



The Residents at Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation enjoy regular activities on their neighborhoods but some enjoy a little bit more like Saturday Craft Nights.

Craft Night provides residents with an opportunity to meet new people, remain active, motivated and independent while learning more visual Arts and Crafts, not to mention improving hand-eye coordination. Last year we applied

for a GVCA Grant to provide extra funds for a Special Guest Presenter to teach us a new craft at least once a month. It was a great way to help us celebrate our 5-year Anniversary.

The Residents make jewelry and other interesting items. They can choose to keep what they make while some make items for Staff to show them how much they appreciate them. They especially love having crafts around the Holidays so they have gifts for Staff and family members too! If they don't keep what they make, they bring items to sell at the Craft Sales at the Livingston County CNR, held several times a year, which helps with costs of supplies and provides funding for extra special programming. Once the craft sale is over, they then donate whatever is left for Bingo prizes.
