175th Birthday of Mount Morris Native

Mary Catherine Seymour Howell, an exceptional orator and suffragette, was born on August 29th, 1844 in Mount Morris, New York. She was born into the prominent Seymour family, whose members included businessmen, lawyers, and many politicians. One of Mary's relatives, Horatio Seymour (1810-1886), ran as the Democratic Candidate for President of the United States against Ulysses S. Grant in 1868 gathering 2.7M votes but lost the election. Horatio was also a NYS Assemblyman, Speaker of the House and the 16th and 18th Governor of New York State from 1853-54 and 1863-64.

Her family, along with her parents, Norman and Frances Hale Metcalf Seymour, lived at 22 State Street in Mount Morris. The Seymours are descendants of Richard Seymour of Hertfordshire England (1604-1655) who settled in Hartford, CT in 1639. Norman was a hardware merchant, well-known as an eloquent speaker who also wrote articles and obituaries for the Rochester Democrat newspaper. Norman's brother-in-law, Edward I. Chase, was Secretary of the Treasury in Abraham Lincoln's cabinet.

Mary Catherine was the only daughter of four children. Her brother, Henry Hale Seymour was an attorney from Buffalo, NY. Her brothers, Norman Alexander Seymour and Edward Chase Seymour and their families, lived in Mount Morris. She attended the local Mount Morris Academy, Genesee Wesleyan Seminary in Lima, NY and Mrs. Laura Ralston's Seminary for Young Ladies in Lockport, NY. Mary taught at the Mount Morris Academy before she was married.

In August of 1868, Mary Catherine married Reverend George Rogers Howell (1833-1899) a Presbyterian clergyman and author who became the NY State Librarian. They resided in Albany, NY and her only child was born in 1869. Her son, George Seymour Howell, died of appendicitis while attending Harvard University as a Junior classman on March 9, 1891. A beautiful stained-glass window at the Saint John's Episcopal Church is dedicated in his honor.


While living in Albany, Mary Catherine became President of the Albany County Women's Suffrage Society. She lectured on women's rights and suffragist issues while traveling extensively throughout the country. In 1890, she traveled to Kansas and the Dakotas with Susan B. Anthony of Rochester, NY. Mary delivered the graduation address to South Dakota College. She was also the first woman to address the Connecticut House of Representatives.


In 1891, Mary Catherine was appointed by Elizabeth Cady Stanton to represent the National American Woman Suffrage Association at the National Council of Women in Washington, DC. In 1892, she wrote the

suffrage bill that was passed by the NYS Assembly but did not move to the Senate. Mary was the main speaker at the Women's Suffrage Convention at Fitzhugh Hall in 1894, where she delivered the address "The Dawning of the Twentieth Century." Mary spoke at Susan B. Anthony's 76th birthday celebration at the Rochester Political Equality Club.

In 1899, Mary Catherine moved back to Mount Morris upon the death of her husband, George, residing with her mother on State Street. She continued to be politically active until her death from pneumonia on February 18, 1913. She is buried in the Mount Morris Cemetery where her gravestone reads: Mary Seymour Howell, only daughter of Norman and Frances Metcalf Seymour, wife of George Howell of Albany, died February 18, 1913. Sympathetic, Fearless, Brainy, Liberal Minded, Orator, in many states and before legislatures for Women's Rights.

The Mount Morris Historical Society will be holding a reception in Mary Seymour Howell's honor on August 17, 2019 at the Mills Mansion on 14 Main Street, Mount Morris, NY.
