



DRIVERS

Please be aware that school reopens on Wednesday September 4, 2019. Please keep your eyes open for children crossing the street. Remember, when a stopped school bus flashes its red light(s), traffic that approaches from either direction, even in front of the school and in school parking lots, must stop before it reaches the bus. You should stop at least 20 feet away from the bus. Before a school bus stops to load or discharge passengers, the driver will usually flash yellow warning lights. When you see them, decrease speed and be prepared to stop. When you stop for a school bus, you cannot drive again until the red lights stop flashing or when the bus driver or a traffic officer signals that you can proceed. This law applies on all roadways in New York State. You must stop for a school bus even if it is on the opposite side of a divided highway. After you stop for a school bus, look for children along the side of the road. Drive slowly until you have passed them. Remember that vehicles that transport people with disabilities can be equipped as school buses and you must stop for them as you would for other school buses.



Local Patriot Guard Riders to Escorted Cremains of Twelve Unclaimed Military Veterans to Final Resting Place

On Friday, August 30, 2019, the Patriot Guard Riders of New York once again, through its Veteran Recovery Program (VRP), had the honor of escorting the cremains of twelve (12) unclaimed Military Veterans to their rightful resting place at the Bath National Cemetery, where they will receive the full Military Honors they have earned. These 12 Veterans served in the Marine Corps, Army, Navy, or Air Force and passed away from 1–19 year ago. The escort began in Buffalo and traveled through Erie, Wyoming, Livingston, and Steuben Counties. The Interment Ceremony and Military Honors took place at 11:00 a.m.

As with past VRP Missions, the Livingston County Hampton Corners Complex at Gypsy Lane in Mount Morris played host as an intermediate staging area for this Mission.

The contingent traveled from East Aurora on Route 20A and entered Livingston County at Pine Tavern Corners in Leicester. It then swung through the Village of Leicester to Route 36 and proceeded south on Route 36 to Mount Morris. The contingent headed east on Route 408 to Route 63 and south to Hampton Corners around 9 AM then headed back to the Village of Mount Morris and then south on Route 36. Finally, it passed by the Mount Morris Veterans' Park, traveled through Sonyea, and continued to Dansville at approximately 10 AM.

The escort then entered I-390 at Exit-5, and continued to Bath.

Law Enforcement from Erie, Wyoming, Livingston and Steuben Counties as well as the New York State Police assisted in escorting the contingent, which was expected to have 150-200 motorcyclists.



Previous VRP Missions have seen an outpouring of residents, groups, and organizations displaying patriotic and reverent honor and respect to the Veterans as they pass by along the route.

Many have also stood along Gypsy Lane as the contingent leaves Hampton Corners.

New York State Division of Consumer Protection Warns about Callers Posing as Utility Employees

Mount Morris, NY, August 29, 2019 — The New York State Division of Consumer Protection is alerting consumers to a scam where people claiming to represent an electric, gas or water company – whether the consumer is a customer of theirs or not – ask for consumer information, including account numbers, social security numbers, and dates of birth, and request payment for alleged past-due bills.

The scammers also send emails seeking the same information and, in some instances, have visited targets' homes. The scam has now transitioned to communities where English is less prevalent, with callers speaking in the target's native language, including Spanish and Chinese.

"Unfortunately, utility scams periodically pop up throughout the year, but scammers are now targeting vulnerable and limited English-speaking communities that may not be aware of these nefarious tactics," said New York Secretary of State Rossana Rosado, who oversees the Division of Consumer Protection. "If you are called or approached by someone purporting to be from a utility company and seeking payment, take steps protect yourself."

The Division of Consumer Protection offers the following tips to prevent falling victim to these recent scams:

Confirm the caller. Consumers should not rely on the number that comes up on their phone. Callers can "spoof" the number to look like a local utility company. If someone has contacted an individual and they are suspicious, they should hang up and go directly to the official website for the utility company or call the number on their utility bill to confirm whether there is a problem with their account.

Don't give the caller information. Consumers should never give out or confirm sensitive information, including utility account numbers, credit card numbers, or Social Security numbers unless they are 100 percent sure they know who they are dealing with.

Utility companies will not shut off utilities via the phone. Real utility companies issue several disconnection warnings before shutting off utilities and they never demand money over the phone or specify a method of payment.

Utility companies do not ask for payment via gift cards, Green Dot Money-Pak, bitcoin, or wire transfer. Gift cards and bitcoin allow scammers to get money without anyone tracking them. Once an individual gives them the number, they can take the full value without anyone knowing who they are. If someone on the phone asks an individual to buy a gift card and call them back with the number, transfer money with bitcoin, wire transfer, or other non-traceable payment, it is a scam.

Don't let them in before confirming. All utility company employees carry credentials. If someone requesting entry into a home or place of business does not show a valid ID card, don't let that person in. If they do show credentials, the individual should call the utility company to confirm those credentials.

Consumers can also file a complaint with the Division of Consumer Protection. The New York State Division of Consumer Protection investigates Do Not Call violations and provides voluntary mediation between a consumer and a business when a consumer has been unsuccessful at reaching a resolution on their own. The Consumer Assistance Helpline 1-800-697-1220 is available Monday to Friday from 8:30am to 4:30pm, excluding State Holidays, and consumer complaints can be filed at any time at www.dos.ny.gov/consumerprotection. 




