





- * Mirrors make a room feel larger, because they reflect space, essentially doubling the visual area. But for maximum impact, experts say to hang your mirror on the wall adjacent to your window, not across from it.
- * Lunchbox season is here, finally. If you have an issue with odors remaining in your plastic food containers, here's a fix from B.P. in Alabama: "Fill container with hot water, and add a teaspoon of baking soda. This should remove smells. Let sit overnight if necessary."
- * Here's a way to remove stickers, especially ones that don't tear off. Rub labels with straight white vinegar or soak a paper napkin with vinegar and lay it over the label. Let it sit for 10 minutes, then remove. You should be able to rub the adhesive right off. Reapply if necessary.
- * Whether you recycle because of global warming, landfill overload or environmental issues, the planet thanks you. But remember that recycling is only one part of going green. "Reduce" and "re-use" are just as important. Choose products with less packaging. Have small appliances fixed instead of automatically replacing them. And keep recycling.
- * Clean your coffeemaker this way: Fill your coffeepot with equal parts water and vinegar. Add to machine and run as normal. Halfway through the cycle, turn the pot off and let the heated mixture sit for an hour or more. Complete the cycle, and run another pot or two of plain water through to rinse.
- * If you kids have gone wild with new school supplies, here's a tip from A.M. in Indiana to erase crayon marks from painted walls: "Make a paste of equal parts baking soda and water, and apply to the area. Then let it dry and wipe away." This works best on a white or very light wall, as dark colors may lose some color. Also, wipe gently, as baking soda is a mild abrasive.



PIEDMONT PETS

September is National Preparedness Month. As this column is being written, the weather forecasters still do not know for certain what path Hurricane Dorian will take. The best time to prepare is long before the first raindrop falls or the first wind gale is felt.

Individual households can benefit from having an emergency response plan in place. Any plan must include your companion animals. Your animal's best protection is to be with you. But taking a pet requires special planning. Locate a safe place for your pets before disaster strikes. Evacuation shelters generally do not accept any animal, so we suggest you call hotels and motels a reasonable distance from your home and ask if they accept pets, under what conditions, and whether there are any restrictions as to the size and number of animals. We have prepared the animal shelter for an emergency; however, do not rely solely on local animal shelters, because during emergencies they are filled beyond capacity with strays and rescued animals.

A few simple steps can protect your pets: Keep up-to-date identification on your dog or cat at all times. Make sure the collar is properly fitted (avoid chain link collars for dogs and use breakaway collars for cats). For the best protection, have all your dogs and cats microchipped; be sure to register the chip number. Keep current color photos of your pet, showing any distinguishing marks, with your emergency supplies. If you and your pet become separated, these photos will help identify him/her. If you know a disaster is imminent, bring your pets inside immediately! (The obvious exception to this is in the case of a house fire.) Get your animals under control as soon as possible, either on a leash or inside a carrier.

Disasters often strike while you're away from home. Consider an arrangement with a neighbor who would be willing to evacuate your pet in your absence.

The government also urges us to have at least a three day supply of food, medicine, clothes, water, etc. An emergency kit for each of your pets' needs

is also essential. Include in this kit at least a three-day supply of food and water, food/water bowls, regular medications, a first aid kit, a carrier (essential for cats), leashes, and a litter box and litter for cats. Small mammals and birds must have cages.

Dogs and cats are not the only pets that should be included in your plan. Birds can be transported in a pet carrier or travel cage. When it's cold, wrap a blanket around the cage. A few slices of fresh fruit or vegetable with a high water content placed in the cage will provide fluid temporarily.

Other small mammals should be placed in secure, suitable carriers. Be prepared to provide bedding materials, food, bowls, and water bottles.

Reptiles also need special care. Snakes may be able to be transported in a pillowcase, but must be transferred to more secure housing when the destination is reached. Take food and bowls, and include a bowl large enough for soaking. Also take a heating pad. House lizards can be transported the same way birds are.

Remember, during an emergency, your pets will also suffer from stress and trauma, just as you will. Do not expect them to react in a normal manner, so make special efforts to make them feel secure.

Our pets will benefit from our wisdom of not waiting until the disaster strikes before we take any steps to prepare for the emergency.




Financial Aid Support Specialist Hired



BELIEVE IT OR NOT

Bad enough if you have to go to the dentist to have a tooth pulled but imagine having to undergo several hundred extractions in one sitting. The Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC] reports that dental surgeons in India recently removed a total of 526 teeth from the mouth of a 7-year-old boy. Actually, the mass of tiny teeth was contained in what the surgeons called a "compound odontome," a benign tumor that had been growing in the child's mouth for several years.

DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH

Who needs a diamond mine? Just visit Arkansas' Crater of Diamonds State Park and, if you are lucky, there'll be a diamond waiting for you in plain sight, says the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. That's how Josh Lanik found his 2.2 carat gem. 
THE TROUT ARE BITING

After all, says AMAC, it's where fisherwoman Debbie Geddes recently landed not just any trout, but one with two mouths. Photos of her unusual catch posted on the Internet went viral around the world. Geddes released the fish so that future anglers might have a chance to reel it in again.

TRUE GRIT

Ray Woolley is an exemplar for senior citizens, says the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC]. Woolley, saw action in World War II. It's nearly 75 years since VE Day but Woolley's sense of derring do is still intact. Be Prepared: How Does One Pay For The Rising Cost of Long-Term Care?

It's a hard fact: The high cost of long-term care has made planning a critically important issue for most middle class seniors and their families. Sadly, too many of them are unprepared for the significant financial burdens that it places on their family's hard-earned savings. Financial devastation looms large for a family facing ongoing care at a rate of up to \$10,000 a month!

Roughly 50% of healthy Americans age 65 will eventually require some form of long-term care. This care can be nursing home care, assisted living or home care. Whatever the setting, this kind of care becomes quickly and extremely expensive. So how does one exactly pay for long-term care? Below are the following five methods:

(1) **PRIVATE PAY:** The first way is called private pay; you simply write the provider a check for the monthly bill from your hard-earned life's savings.

(2) LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE: The second but better way to plan ahead and pay for long-term care is to purchase long-term care insurance. However, only about 8% of Americans have purchased long-term care insurance. By age 65, 25% of individuals are no longer insurable, making this less of a viable option for most people.

(3) MEDICARE: The third way to pay for long-term care is through Medicare. Medicare pays for some home care for people who are homebound, and it pays part of a maximum of 100 days in a nursing home if that person is receiving skilled care.

(4) VETERANS ADMINISTRATION: For those who served in the military and their spouses, there is a fourth option. The Veterans Administration helps pay for long-term care, but the benefit is very limited. Statistically, VA programs pay for less than 1% of all of the long-term care provided in the United States.

(5) MEDICAID: The fifth way is Medicaid, which to be clear, is entirely separate from Medicare. Medicaid pays for over half of all the long-term care expenses in the United States. For all practical purposes, in the United States, the only "insurance" plan for long-term institutionalized care is Medicaid.

Keep in mind, that Medicare only pays for approximately 2% of skilled nursing care in the United States, and private insurance pays for even less. The result is that when Medicare is exhausted, most people proceed to needlessly pay out of their own pockets for long-term care until their funds are nearly depleted and they then become financially eligible for Medicaid. This is often referred to as a 'spend-down' by the department of social services or the nursing home. This process naturally impoverishes a person and their spouse if married, since <u>BOTH</u> person's assets are counted in a married couple situation.

As you can see, without proper planning, nursing home residents will quickly deplete their savings! Many people are interested in protecting their assets from the rising cost of long-term care. The key to remember is that there are options available as well as pitfalls to avoid. How to Get Social Security Disability Benefits When You Can't Work

Dear Savvy Senior,

What do I need to do to get Social Security disability benefits? I'm 60 years old and have some health problems that won't allow me to work, but I've read that getting disability benefits is difficult.

Laid Up Lenny

Dear Lenny,

Getting Social Security disability benefits when you're unable to work can be challenging. Last year, more than 2 million people applied for Social Security disability benefits, but two-thirds of them were denied, because most applicants fail to prove that they're disabled and can't work. Here are some steps you can take that can help improve your odds.

Get Informed

The first thing you need to find out is if your health problem qualifies you for Social Security disability benefits.

You generally will be eligible only if you have a health problem that is expected to prevent you from working in your current line of work (or any other line of work that you have been in over the past 15 years) for at least a year or result in death.

There is no such thing as a partial disability benefit. If you're fit enough to work part-time, your application will be denied. You also need not apply if you still are working with the intention of quitting if your application is approved, because if you're working your application will be denied.

Your skill set and age are factors too. Your application will be denied if your work history suggests that you have the skills to perform a less physically demanding job that your disability does not prevent you from doing.

To help you determine if you are disabled, visit SSA.gov/planners/disability/qualify. html and go through the five questions Social Security uses to determine disability.

How to Apply

If you believe you have a claim, your next step is to gather up your personal, financial and medical information so you can be prepared and organized for the application process. You can apply either online at SSA.gov/ applyfordisability or call 800-772-1213 to

make an appointment to apply at your local Social Security office, or to set up an appointment for someone to take your claim over the phone.

The whole process lasts about an hour. If you schedule an appointment, a "Disability Starter Kit" that will help you get ready for your interview will be mailed to you. If you apply online, the kit is available at SSA.gov/disability/ disability_starter_kits.htm.

It takes three to five months from the initial application to receive either an award or denial of benefits. The only exception is if you have a chronic illness that qualifies you for a "compassionate allowance" (see SSA. gov/compassionateallowances), which fast tracks cases within weeks.

If Social Security denies your initial application, you can appeal the decision, and you'll be happy to know that roughly half of all cases that go through a round or two of appeals end with benefits being awarded. But the bad news is with backlog of around 800,000 people currently waiting for a hearing, it can take 12 to 24 months for you to get one.

Get Help

You can hire a representative to help you with your Social Security disability claim. By law, representatives can charge only 25 percent of past-due benefits up to a maximum of \$6,000 if they win your case.


It's probably worth hiring someone at the start of the application process if your disability is something difficult to prove such as chronic pain. If, however, your disability is obvious, it might be worth initially working without a representative to avoid paying the fee. You can always hire a representative later if your initial application and first appeal are denied.

To find a representative, check with the National Organization of Social Security Claimants' Representatives (NOSSCR. org, 845-682-1881) or National Association of Disability Representatives (NADR.org, 800-747-6131). Or, if you're low-income, contact the Legal Services Corporation (LSC.gov/findlegal-aid) for free assistance.

Staying at Home as You Get Older

Aging in place means that we remain in our home as we get older. Many of us want that ... to stay where we're comfortable and things are familiar. With enough advance planning and a few changes, it's possible, but it means anticipating what our needs will be as we face the challenges of age.

For example, if you know you'll be staying in your home, there are some things you'll need to do in advance, basics like moving the master bedroom to the first floor, making the outside safe with better lighting and adding grab bars in the shower.

What about all the daily tasks you'll no longer be able to handle — driving and mowing, meals and shopping — that you'll need to hire others to do.

But what if you want to move first because your current environment isn't what you'll need? Many of us are moving to aging-in-place communities. They're loaded with amenities to keep us happy and healthy: libraries, grocery stores, buses and rides, lawn services and maintenance, meals in a dining room if desired, medical facilities, clubs, churches, classes — and the ability to upgrade to an assisted-living situation should it become necessary.

If you're just now at the thinking stage, consider signing up for AARP's free e-newsletter, Livable Communities (www.aarp.org). While it's aimed toward community leaders and residents, it will give you some ideas about things you might want or need. Look at the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging website (www.n4a.org) and put in your ZIP code to find aging resources near you. Call one or two to get more information. Ask for any to-do lists they have for aging in place.

Aging in place can work, but you need to plan for it.


