



Governor signs bill making big game rifle hunting permanent in Orleans

Hunters in Orleans County have been given permanent permission to use rifles for big game hunting.

Gov. Andrew Cuomo on Friday signed the legislation that was backed by the Orleans County Legislature and local sportsmen's clubs.

Cuomo and the State Legislature agreed to permanently authorize pistols, rifles, crossbows, longbows, muzzle-loaded firearms and shotguns to be used when hunting big game, including rifle hunting between Nov. 16 and Dec. 8 this year.

State Sen. Rob Ortt, R-North Tonawanda, issued this statement:

"I am glad that this legislation was passed and signed in a timely manner to allow for big game rifle hunting this upcoming season, and I want to thank my colleague, Assemblyman Steve Hawley, for his work in helping to get this legislation passed. For many, hunting is a way of life and provides generations of families a chance to bond, learn about nature, and educate the younger generations about what it means to hunt. This legislation will ensure the practice of hunting and outdoor education continues in Orleans County for decades to come."

Assemblyman Steve Hawley, R-Batavia, issued this statement:

"I am proud to announce that big game rifle hunting has been permanently authorized in Orleans County – paving the way for this year's season to open on November 16. Hunting is such an important staple of our culture here in Western New York and a fall tradition that many families look forward to each year.

Permanently protecting this tradition is very important to me and the thousands of hunters I represent across the 139th Assembly District. I will always stand by our right to hunt, fish and exercise the Second Amendment and I wish all hunters a safe and productive season this year!"

Local sportsmen leaders said hunters have discovered fewer wounded animals since rifles were allowed. Terry Williams of Carlton told county legislators at a recent meeting that shotguns often require multiple shots, and sometimes don't take down an animal, leaving them hurt.

"It has been a very clean and prosperous year for those of us with rifle hunting," Wiliams told legislators last December. "It's one shot and it's over with. It's very clean and neat."



GAINES — If efforts are successful, visitors to the historic Gaines Basin No. 2 cobblestone school on Gaines basin Road will have another attraction to look at. The Orleans County Historical Society, which is restoring the schoolhouse, has been given a log cabin, which they hope to move behind the school.

The idea was born about a year ago when Bill Lattin, retired as both the Orleans County historian and director of the Cobblestone Society Museum, was talking with Al Capurso at a Cobblestone board meeting. "Al made the suggestion that it would be nice to build a replica of a log cabin on the Cobblestone Museum grounds," Lattin said. "I could see by the look on the board members' faces, that wasn't going to fly."

Lattin commented it was the mission of the Cobblestone Society to preserve historic buildings, and asked why they didn't consider preserving a log cabin, instead of building one. Capurso asked where they

"I said, 'On Linwood Avenue in Albion,' and his jaw dropped," Lattin said. Lattin knew the property owners, Pat and Ralph Moorhouse, and when they were contacted, they agreed to donate the deteriorating log cabin if it could be moved. The Cobblestone Building and Grounds Committee felt they had enough on their plate without taking on another project, so Capurso presented the idea to the Orleans County Historical Association, which agreed to allow the cabin to be moved behind the Gaines Basin cobblestone schoolhouse — if Lattin and Capurso could raise the \$6,000 needed to get it in shape to move.

The log cabin was built by Boy Scouts in 1930 as a place to camp out, which makes it kind of unique, Lattin said. "It's one of a kind," he said. It is 10 feet by 14 feet and barely six feet tall at the peak. The Scouts also constructed a cot of sorts inside and a fireplace. On the outside in back is a tank, which held oil and was rigged so a drop of oil would fall periodically on the fire, keeping it burning.

What makes the log cabin so special is that Pat Moorhouse's grandfather supervised building the cabin, and her father Ferris Benton was one of the Scouts. The log cabin is already beginning to deteriorate badly and the front has sunk at least a foot into the ground. "If it is not preserved now, it will soon rot out,"

Lattin said. Rick Ebbs, a local contractor who has been working on restoration work at the schoolhouse, agreed to tackle the project. He expects to line the interior and exterior with plywood to brace it so it can be lifted with a fork lift. He hopes to be able to move the fireplace intact as well. "If we have to rebuild it stone by stone, it will spoil its integrity," Lattin said. Lattin hopes to interest some Scout troops in helping with restoration of the cabin. "This would be a wonderful Eagle Scout project," he said. Lattin said they have already received about \$1,000 in donations toward the project. Anyone wishing to make a monetary donation or donate services in kind can contact the Orleans County Historical Association at P.O. Box 181, Albion. Latin said anyone who donates \$50 or more will receive a copy of Irene Gibson's book, Historic Sites in Orleans County. Lattin said the timing is perfect, as they just learned a drivable lane has been completed up to the towpath on the east side of the Gaines Basin Road canal bridge. The northernmost point of the Erie Canal is just 900 feet west of the canal bridge. "This was one of the only roads in the county which crossed the canal and didn't have access to the towpath," Lattin said. "We hope to have a kiosk and sign which tells people they can stop and see an authentic log cabin and one-room schoolhouse."

The schoolhouse was built in 1832 and is the oldest documented cobblestone building in the region. It was used until 1944, when the district centralized. Constructed of local fieldstone, it also shows early use of Medina sandstone for quoins. It is the last remaining structure of the pioneer-era Erie Canal hamlet known as Gaines Basin. It was falling into ruin until the Orleans County Historical Association took interest in it several years ago and Jim Panek, who owns the land, agreed to donate the building and surrounding lot to the Historical Association. When restoration is complete, the schoolhouse will serve as a small museum and meeting place.



Foods with Ample Antioxidants

The term "antioxidants" is frequently associated with cancer prevention. Antioxidants are helpful, but many people may not fully comprehend the role antioxidants play in fighting cancer.

Antioxidants are chemicals that interact with and neutralize free radicals, thus preventing them from causing damage, offers the National Cancer Institute. Free radicals are formed in the body by exposure to ionizing radiation and other radiation. An excessive amount of free radicals in the body can negatively affect cells and potentially lead to the formation of various types of cancer and other diseases.

While the body makes some of the antioxidants it uses to scavenge free radicals and render them ineffective, it also relies on antioxidants from food sources.

So what foods offer the highest levels of potentially cancer-fighting antioxidants? The largest and most comprehensive study to date into antioxidant levels was published in 2004 in the Journal of Agriculture and Food Chemistry by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Researchers analyzed antioxidant levels in more than 100 foods. In addition to pointing out many foods people already knew to be antioxidant-rich, researchers uncovered some surprises.

Here's a look at some of the best bets for beneficial foods that may be part of a cancer-fighting diet.

- small red bean (dried) cultivated blueberry
- wild blueberry
- red kidney bean (dried)
- pinto bean

- prune
- cranberry raspberry
- cooked artichoke
- blackberry

These foods rank high among those with the most antioxidants per serving, according to the USDA. However, many other foods also are great sources of antioxidants. These include russet potatoes, pecans, gala apples, walnuts, Indian gooseberries, cloves, and mint.

Eating a variety of fruits and vegetables, particularly berries, can provide many of the antioxidants the human body needs to neutralize the potential damage caused by free radicals. ■





Resumé Writing Rules to Follow

When professionals are ready to take a new step in their careers, it's wise to revisit their old résumés and see what can be done to update them for the current day and age. This is especially true for people who may have been out of the job-seeking arena for some time.

Writing a résumé can be complicated. The rules for finding a new job are continually evolving, and résumés remain a big component of that process. The following are some current résumé trends that will help professionals stand out from the masses.

Consider design

Design your résumé so it will look good whether it's viewed on a screen or a mobile phone or printed on paper. Classic serif style fonts can make a résumé seem dated, so select modern fonts that are crisp. The idea is for the résumé to look balanced and clear, without being overdone with modifications, like italics and bold lettering. However, a spot of color could provide muchneeded attention.

Be brief yet effective

A concise design is key. Many recruiters spend little to no time reviewing the hordes of résumés they receive. In fact, automated résumé bots may initially screen the documents to thin the crowd. According to data from the 12th annual Mystery Job Candidate survey by CareerXRoads, the average recruiter spends six seconds looking at a résumé. If a résumé is lengthy or doesn't attract attention, it will likely be ignored. Stick to a single-page and make sure wording is brief but meaty.

Keep juicy details up top

Format the résumé so the most pertinent information is within the top one-third of the document. Beef up a summary statement and use it in lieu of an objective. Make sure that summary includes keywords that promote your skills and experience to potentially lure the recruiter into reading more.

Tweak job titles

Mimic phrasing from the job listing to beat the bots and get résumés flagged for review. Slightly change job position titles so they mirror the wording used. For example, if a recruiter is looking for a "financial account manager," and you have the experience, list your title as something like "Senior manager of new financial accounts."

Who you know

Landing a new job is often about what you know, but getting a foot in the door is also largely influenced by who you know. Include any professional groups to which you belong or alumni associations. Who knows? The recruiter may have the same alma mater, and you can bond over your shared mascot.

Keywords, phrasing, formatting, and having the right skills for the job can ensure a résume is seen by a recruiter, and perhaps even lead to a new career.


