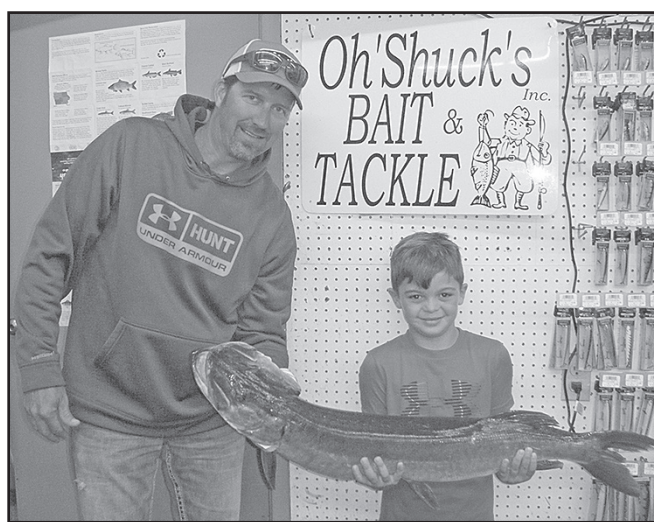

It could also be related to: alcoholism, vitamin B-12 deficiency, infections, prescriptions or over-the-counter drugs. The good news is, if the memory loss is related to one of these things, it could be temporary or reversed.

Here's the deal, if stage 1 - encoding isn't good, you're not going to get the information in properly for stage 2, and then you're going to have difficulty in stage 3 with retrieval because the information isn't there in good form. Stress affects the way the brain processes memories. That's why it's no shock if you experience memory issues during very stressful times. Part of the brain isn't engaged the way it needs to be in order to have good memory.

No matter how "normal" memory lapses may be, it's still frustrating none the less, right? Some great ways to keep your brain fit is to make sure you keep using it. There are several things worth doing to help slow down aging of the brain such as: mental activities, exercising/fitness, reduce stress levels, and keep a healthy diet. Diets rich in antioxidants help protect brain cells and exercise also helps with your overall health.

It is important for us all to keep intellectually and socially engaged - it can help extend and maintain our cognitive abilities longer. We can challenge ourselves by learning new things, reading a book or taking up hobbies to keep our brains active and strong. Some ways to help improve memory are: focusing, getting good sleep, structuring environment or doing memory tricks.

Clay County Fair Beats Mother Nature

Despite five days of measurable precipitation and numerous event cancellations due to weather conditions, "The World's Greatest County Fair" was able to beat Mother Nature with smiling fairgoers and stellar family programming, September 7-15.

"I have always known that our guests were some of the most loyal and passionate fairgoers anywhere," said Fair Manager Jeremy Parsons, "and this year they proved it by their positive attitudes and faithful attendance - rain or shine."

Fairgoers reacted favorably to many programming changes, including free daily admission for children 12 and under; the 9/11 Never Forget mobile exhibit; Tiny Town, the new interactive play experience for young fairgoers; new competitive classes in the open class draft horse show; Balloon Masters' farm-related sculpture in the Ag Marketplace; the Fair Foodie Challenge; and nearly \$250,000 in capital improvements.

"We were thrown several curveballs particularly in the Sleep Number Grandstand during this year's Fair," he said. "However, fairgoers were so patient and supportive as we worked through those issues, especially a concert refund process and the addition of bag checks."

Parsons continued that the success of the 2019 Clay County Fair can be measured in several metrics, including:

Fairgoer Satisfaction - According to data from surveys conducted by Iowa Lakes Community College, 70% of fairgoers said they were "very satisfied" with the Fair. Additionally, 90.5% of those surveyed said they "definitely would" or were "very likely" to recommend attending the Fair to their friends and family.

Youth Involvement - 806 4-H and FFA exhibitors from 46 counties in Iowa, Minnesota, and Nebraska participated in livestock and human sciences events at the Fair. 1,045 third and fourth grade students from 14 regional schools visited the Fair as part of the AgCiting and SciCiting field trip programs coordinated by ISU Extension Clay County.

Fairgoer Spending - Fairgoer spending on food, beverage, specialty concessions, and carnival rides totaled \$2,223,998.58 (down approximately 2.5 percent from 2018). When Mother Nature cooperated, fairgoer spending responded by setting three single-day records for Tuesday (September 10), Friday (September 13), and the second Sunday (September 15).

Exhibitor Participation - 497 commercial exhibitors, concessionaires, and vendors showcased at the Fair. With at least 150 ag-specific exhibitors, the Fair again hosted the largest farm machinery and ag equipment show at any fair in the United States. 1,384 exhibitors participated in various open class livestock and non-livestock competitions and took home nearly \$100,000 in premiums, ribbons, trophies, and awards.

Attendance - Despite the cancellation of the Foreigner concert on September 7, the Sleep Number Grandstand attracted 17,368 fairgoers to multiple stage performances and dirt events. The top two attended events were the final appearance of Chuckwagon Races (4,025-two sessions) and Jon Pardi with special guest Jake Rose (3,451). Overall Fair attendance totaled 296,998 (down roughly 4 percent from 2018's attendance number of 308,603). Complete daily attendance numbers can be found at www.claycountyfair.com.

"Inclement weather, which of course is completely out of the Fair's control, is always the number one factor that affects attendance," said Parsons. "While the rain may have affected which day our passionate fairgoers attended, it is obvious that they still came out and enjoyed the Fair."

2019 was the second year that estimated daily attendance numbers were not released during the Fair so a more accurate attendance number could be provided following the Fair.

More detailed information on the 2019 Clay County Fair will be made available at the Clay County Fair Association's annual meeting on October 29. Lifetime memberships to the Fair Association are available for \$100. Call (712) 580-3000 for more information.

That being the case, we're probably in trouble here, as research director RD has come up with information marking Saturday as Ask A Stupid Question Day. We will note here that her choice for the song of the day makes really good sense, with the father-daughter duet, *Something Stupid*, by Frank and Nancy Sinatra -- plus an instrumental by guitarist Al Caiola, and a rumba by Michael Bubl  and Reese Witherspoon...

Anthony Newley was born in London, on this day in 1931. The actor, singer, and songwriter -- usually in partnership with lyricist Leslie Bricusse -- is best remembered for songs like *On a Wonderful Day Like Today*, from the 1965 musical *The Roar of the Greasepaint, The Smell of the Crowd*. Many versions of the song were recorded when the show was first produced. In addition to a recording by the composer himself, some of the best were by Sammy Davis, Jr., pianist Ahmad Jamal, and flutist Herbie Mann, on his own LP of the complete soundtrack...

Wednesday is Comic Book Day. In the day, kids turned many comic book pages reading about the adventures of favorite characters like Bugs Bunny, Casper the Friendly Ghost, and Top Cat, who also starred in his own TV series from 1961-1962. While the show lasted only one season, his comic books had nine lives (years) and were published until 1970. The theme song for TC's show was written by Hoyt Curtin, who was a part of the Hanna Barbera Studio since its inception in 1957...

Wednesday is also One Hit Wonder Day, for which RD picked *The Poni-Tails'* 1958 release: *Born Too Late*, as the song du jour. (Maybe *BTLate* was a single success because each member of the trio from Lyndhurst, Ohio, is dark-haired!) Strangely enough, the song was co-written by Charles Strouse, whose more ambitious efforts include the music for the Broadway shows *Bye, Bye, Birdie*, *Annie*, *All American*, and *Golden Boy*...

September 26, 1898, is the day composer George Gershwin was born in New York. Perhaps it is because Julie London shared his birth date (in 1926) that she selected Gershwin songs for at least two of her record albums, *Love is Here To Stay*, on the 1965 LP, *By Myself*, and *Bidin' My Time*, and *The Man I Love*, on her 1968 release, *Easy Does It*...

It was September 27th, 1954, that *Steve Allen's Tonight Show* premiered on the NBC Television Network, starting with the star's own composition, *This Could Be the Start of Something Big*. In addition to composing thousands of songs, Allen gave many young performers their first opportunities to be seen on the small screen, and set standards for creativity and professionalism with that first late night show that have been largely ignored by more recent late night hosts. He was a class act!

Sunday will mark the 66th anniversary of the premiere of the family-oriented situation comedy, *Make Room for Daddy*, starring Danny Thomas -- another class act of mid-20th century television. Thomas' theme song was a jazzed up version of the Irish tune, *Londonderry Air*, better known when sung with different lyrics, and called *Danny Boy*...

Grilled Green Tomato "Sandwiches" with Herbed Cream Cheese

Herbed Cream Cheese
8 oz. package cream cheese at room temperature
1 garlic clove, minced
2 tablespoons chopped fresh basil
1 tablespoon snipped fresh chives

Heat grill to medium-hot. Place an oiled perforated grill rack over direct heat.
In a bowl, combine the herb cream cheese ingredients until smooth. Set aside.

A Q&A Regarding Property Taxes

Who Controls Your Property Tax Bill?
The county assessor does NOT determine your bill. Members of your city council, the county board of supervisors and school boards have the largest impact on your final bill when they set their budgets. Property taxes are complicated, but the basic formula is simple: assessed value multiplied by rate equals your bill. When a community's total property value increases and levy rates are not reduced, local government revenue increases automatically; and so, does your tax bill.

Does Iowa Have A New Property Tax Transparency Law?
Yes, earlier this year Governor Reynolds signed a property tax transparency bill into law. It will now be more difficult for city council members and county supervisors (but not school board members) to claim they didn't raise taxes. Levy rates for city and county budgets will now be adjusted so the property tax revenues generated will be the same as the year before.

If cities and counties want to increase property tax revenue more than two percent, they now must:

1. Hold an additional public hearing explaining the need for an increase.
2. Give local taxpayers the opportunity to submit objections to the proposal.
3. Approve the increase by a two-thirds majority of the board or councils.

Because this new law focuses on transparency more than hard limits, citizens must engage in the process to control property taxes.

What Should I Say To My Local Elected Officials?

Cut the rate!
Remind them that government budgets should not grow faster than household budgets.

Ask them to justify a budget increase larger than the cost of living and inflation.

Tell them that spending more taxpayer dollars will not solve every problem.

Oh, one more thing, cut the rate!

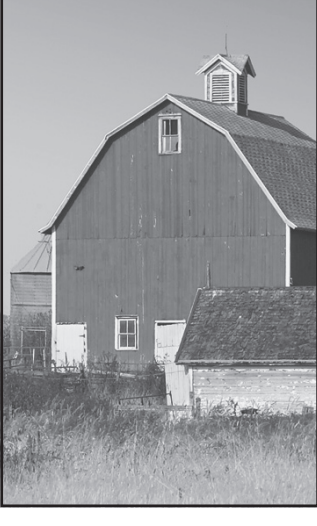

Hospital's West Entrance Limited To ER Patients Only

Lakes Regional Healthcare (LRH) has been undergoing construction of a new west entrance and a new medical office building (MOB) for Avera Medical Group-Lakes Family Practice and Avera Medical Group-Spirit Lake Medical Center physician clinics. Demolition of Avera Medical Group-Spirit Lake Medical Center occurred in June and demolition inside the space previously occupied by LRH's surgical services is currently underway. Work is also underway to prepare the new MOB for plumbing and structural steel.



Construction is now beginning on the hospital's west entrance. As a result, the main west entrance will be closed beginning the week of September 23 and a temporary entrance on the west side will be used for emergency patients only. Those receiving care at Lakes Family Practice, LRH's Outpatient Center, and Dickinson County Public Health can still use the entrance on the north side of the hospital's west parking lot by Lakes Family Practice. However, all other patients - such as those needing surgery, lab tests, imaging procedures, or visits to Spirit Lake Medical Center - must use the hospital's east entrance off of 23rd Street and Zenith Avenue.

Construction is anticipated to be completed in Summer of 2020. Those interested in learning more about the project are encouraged to follow Lakes Regional Healthcare on Facebook.

Lodge and Shelter in Kenue Park

Construction is progressing quickly on the new lodge and open-air shelter in Kenue Park in Okoboji.

Asbestos was removed from the former County Home building previously on the site, and it was demolished in 2018.



"We researched renovating the former County Home building, but it wasn't financially responsible, so the Dickinson County Conservation Board decided to start from scratch and demolish the structure," said Kiley Roth, community relations coordinator for the Dickinson County Conservation Board. Poppema-Sikma Construction broke ground on the donor-funded building in July.

The approximately 6,000-square-foot lodge and outdoor shelter face east and will feature a 2,900-square-foot open area, catering kitchen and restrooms. The main room will seat up to 175 people, and the covered shelter will seat 60.

"We have been asked quite often if people can rent the Dickinson County Nature Center in Kenue Park for gatherings and parties, but we do not do private rentals at the nature center, because there just isn't room with our many interactive and educational exhibits," Roth said. "This new lodge and shelter will provide a much-needed gathering space for the community, and we're so grateful for the donation to the Conservation Foundation of Dickinson County that made this facility possible."

Both the lodge and outdoor shelter will be able to rent together or singularly through the Dickinson County Conservation Board. The open shelter will be available for public use when not rented.

Rates for the building have not yet been set, and the opening date has not yet been finalized. No reservations are currently being taken for the new facility.

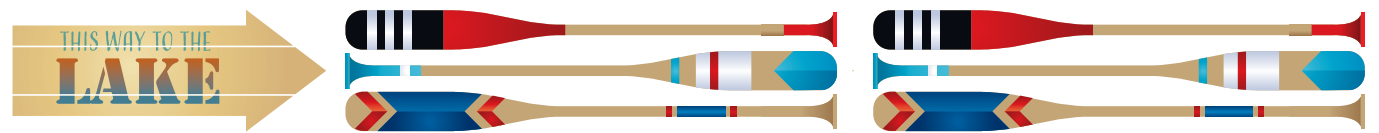
