

Stress affects the way the brain processes memories. That's why it's no shock if you experience memory issues during very stressful times. Part of the brain isn't engaged the way it needs to be in order to have

No matter how "normal" memory lapses may be, it's still frustrating none the less, right? Some great ways to keep your brain fit is to make sure you keep using it. 



Clay County Fair Beats Mother Nature

Despite five days of measurable precipitation and numerous event cancellations due to weather conditions, "The World's Greatest County Fair" was able to beat Mother Nature with smiling

fairgoers and stellar family programming, September 7-15.

"I have always known that our guests were some of the most loyal and passionate fairgoers anywhere," said Fair Manager Jeremy Parsons, "and this year they proved it by their positive attitudes and faithful attendance - rain or shine.'

Fairgoers reacted favorably to many programming changes, including free daily admission for children 12 and under; the 9/11 Never Forget mobile exhibit; Tiny Town, the new



interactive play experience for young fairgoers; new competitive classes in the open class draft horse show; Balloon Masters' farm-related sculpture in the Ag Marketplace; the Fair Foodie Challenge; and nearly \$250,000 in capital improvements.

"We were thrown several curveballs particularly in the Sleep Number Grandstand during this year's Fair," he said. "However, fairgoers were so patient and supportive as we worked through those issues, especially a concert refund process and the addition of bag checks."

Parsons continued that the success of the 2019 Clay County Fair can be measured in several

Fairgoer Satisfaction - According to data from surveys conducted by Iowa Lakes Community College, 70% of fairgoers said they were "very satisfied" with the Fair. Additionally, 90.5% of those surveyed said they "definitely would" or were "very likely" to recommend attending the Fair to their friends and family.

Youth Involvement - 806 4-H and FFA exhibitors from 46 counties in Iowa, Minnesota, and Nebraska participated in livestock and human sciences events at the Fair. 1,045 third and fourth grade students from 14 regional schools visited the Fair as part of the

AgCiting and SciCiting field trip programs coordinated by ISU Extension Clay County. Fairgoer Spending - Fairgoer spending on food, beverage, specialty concessions, and carnival rides totaled \$2,223,998.58 (down approximately 2.5 percent from 2018). 

With at least 150 ag-specific exhibitors, the Fair again hosted the largest farm machinery and ag equipment show at any fair in the United States. 1,384 exhibitors participated in various open class livestock and non-livestock competitions and took home nearly \$100,000 in premiums, ribbons, trophies, and awards.

Attendance - Despite the cancellation of the Foreigner concert on September 7, the Sleep Number Grandstand attracted 17,368 fairgoers to multiple stage performances and dirt events. The top two attended events were the final appearance of Chuckwagon Races (4,025-two sessions) and Jon Pardi with special guest Jake Rose (3,451). Overall Fair attendance totaled 296,998 (down roughly 4 percent from 2018's attendance number of 308,603). Complete daily attendance numbers can be found at www.claycountyfair.com.

"Inclement weather, which of course is completely out of the Fair's control, is always the number one factor that affects attendance," said Parsons. "While the rain may have affected which day our passionate fairgoers attended, it is obvious that they still came out and enjoyed the Fair."

2019 was the second year that estimated daily attendance numbers were not released during the Fair so a more accurate attendance number could be provided following the Fair.

He was a class act!

Sunday will mark the 66th anniversary of the premiere of the family-

oriented situation comedy, Make Room for Daddy, starring Danny Thomas - another class act of mid-20th century television. Thomas' theme song was a jazzed up version of the Irish tune, Londonderry Air, better known when sung with different lyrics, and called Danny Boy...

To The Editor: A Q&A Regarding Property Taxes

Who Controls Your Property Tax Bill? The county assessor does NOT determine your bill. Members of your city council, the county board of supervisors and school boards have the largest impact on your final bill when they set their budgets. Property taxes are complicated, but the basic formula is simple: assessed value multiplied by rate equals your bill. When a community's total property value increases and levy rates are not reduced, local government revenue increases automatically; and so, does your tax bill.

Does't Iowa Have A New Property Tax Transparency Law? Yes, earlier this year Governor Reynolds signed a property tax transparency bill into law. It will now be more difficult for city council members and county supervisors (but not school board members) to claim they didn't raise taxes. Levy rates for city and county budgets will now be adjusted so the property tax revenues generated will be the same as the year before.

If cities and counties want to increase property tax revenue more than two percent, they now must:

1. Hold an additional public hearing explaining the need for

2. Give local taxpayers the opportunity to submit objections to the proposal.

3. Approve the increase by a two-thirds majority of the board

or councils. Because this new law focuses on transparency more than hard limits, citizens must engage in the process to control property

What Should I Say To My Local Elected Officials? Cut the rate!

Remind them that government budgets should not grow faster than household budgets.

Ask them to justify a budget increase larger than the cost of living and inflation.

Tell them that spending more taxpayer dollars will not solve every problem.

Lake Medical Center physician clinics. Demolition of Avera Medical Group-Spirit Lake Medical Center occurred in June and demolition inside the space previously occupied by LRH's surgical services is currently underway. Work is also underway to prepare the new MOB for plumbing and structural steel.

Construction is now beginning on the hospital's west entrance. As a result, the main west entrance will be closed beginning the week of September 23 and a temporary entrance on the west side will be used for emergency patients only. Those receiving care at Lakes Family Practice, LRH's Outpatient Center, and Dickinson County Public Health can still use the entrance on the north side of the hospital's west parking lot by Lakes Family Practice. However, all other patients - such as those needing surgery, lab tests, imaging procedures, or visits to Spirit Lake Medical Center - must use the hospital's east entrance off of 23rd Street and Zenith Avenue.

vating the former County Home building, but it wasn't financially responsible, so the Dickinson County Conservation Board decided to start from scratch and demolish the structure," said Kiley Roth, community relations coordinator for the Dickinson County Conservation Board.

Poppema-Sikma Construction broke ground on the donorfunded building in July.

The approximately 6,000-square-foot lodge and outdoor shelter face east and will feature a 2,900-square-foot open area, catering kitchen and restrooms. The main room will seat up to 175 people, and the covered shelter will seat 60.

'We have been asked quite often if people can rent the Dickinson County Nature Center in Kenue Park for gatherings and parties, but we do not do private rentals at the nature center, because there just isn't room with our many interactive and educational exhibits," Roth said. "This new lodge and shelter will provide a much-needed gathering space for the community, and we're so grateful for the donation to the Conservation Foundation of Dickinson County that made this facility possible."

Both the lodge and outdoor shelter will be able to rent together or singularly through the Dickinson County Conservation Board. The open shelter will be available for public use when not rented.

Rates for the building have not yet been set, and the opening date has not yet been finalized. No reservations are currently being taken for the new facility.


