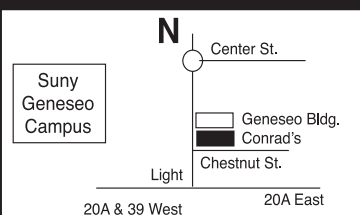

# New York State Bans the Sale of Flavored E-cigarettes

## The latest in a series of actions to combat the increase in youth users

Mount Morris, NY, September 19, 2019 – The Livingston County Department of Health is alerting residents of the ban regarding the sale of most flavored e-cigarettes in New York. Per the New York State Department of Health, the ban is the latest in a series of actions to combat the increase in young people using vape products. This is largely as a result of e-cigarette companies marketing flavors that are intended to get children addicted to nicotine.

The New York State Department of Health is providing retailers with a two-week grace period before visits are conducted to enforce this ban. The enforcement will begin on October 4, 2019, and will be the responsibility of local health departments. Retailers who do not follow this State directed ban, could face fines up to \$2,000 per violation.

Health officials, including the Livingston County Public Health Director, are urging people to stop using vape products. E-cigarettes are not an FDA-approved method to help people quit smoking. 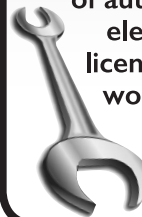

## **Need Help Paying for Medicare?**

The Medicare Savings Programs can help with Medicare costs, like your monthly Part B premiums and sometimes also Part A and Part B coinsurance and deductibles.

The Extra Help Program helps pay some of your Medicare Part D drug plan costs.

If your gross monthly income is less than \$1,581 for an individual or \$2,134 for a couple, you may be eligible for one or both of these programs. These figures are based on the 2019 federal poverty limits and are subject to change.

### **Livingston County to Receive Matching Funds from State for New Shared Services Initiative**

County Administrator Ian Coyle recently announced that Livingston County will receive \$80,000 in first year matching funds from New York State as part of the County Wide Shared Services Initiative (CWSSI).

In 2017, New York State introduced the CWSSI, which requires counties to convene local municipalities to develop and approve plans that lower the cost of local government by finding efficiencies and shared services. The CWSSI offers to match each county's savings from their first year with additional funding.

Coyle said, "In Livingston County, we pride ourselves on running an efficient, resident-focused government at all levels - Town, Village and County. I am glad that the State of New York recognizes the County's efforts to reduce taxpayer-funded redundancies. I thank the Board of Supervisors, Village Mayors and all County and municipal government officials for their commitment to reducing inefficiencies in our communities."

The \$80,000 in savings from the first year came from a consolidation of grant-writing services through Livingston County via formal, codified intermunicipal agreements. The agreements allow towns and villages in Livingston County to receive grant-writing services from the County at no cost while reducing redundant expenses for these services at the local property tax level.

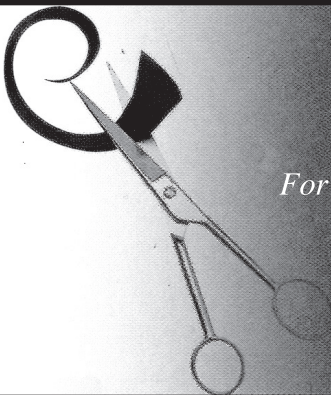

# **HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOMS**

## **HEALTH ADVISORY**

### **September 19, 2019**

Harmful algal blooms (Blue Green Algae) have recently been found along the southeast shoreline of Conesus Lake. Blooms occur when algae multiply very rapidly over a short period of time, usually in calm, warm water. There are thousands of different algae species, however, a few of these may create toxins. The toxins are a concern when there is a high level present in the water.

The Livingston County Department of Health is monitoring for algae blooms and may collect samples of the water if the bloom is concentrated and persistent. Harmful algal blooms may persist in varying degrees and at various locations throughout the summer and fall seasons. The public water supply is safe for drinking.

At this time, visual monitoring has found the presence of harmful algae in the affected areas. Contact with the algae may result in some health issues such as itching, rashes, fever, headache, upper respiratory symptoms, vomiting and diarrhea. These symptoms are not just caused by harmful algae contact. If you have any of these symptoms and they persist, you should seek medical advice. You are advised not to drink or use the lake water for cooking and do not swim, wade, play, or come into direct contact with water that is discolored or has scums on the surface. Pets should not be allowed to drink or to come into contact with discolored water. If contact occurs, wash with soap and clean water to remove algal material. Always rinse after coming into contact with any surface water whether or not a blue-green algae bloom is present. Avoid contact with surface water when open cuts or wounds are present on the body.
