

We're all emailing, texting and DM'ing as fast as our thumbs can type these days, but there's also some Old School pushback. For many style-savvy communicators, handwritten notes are the thing.

Whether it's a follow-up thank you or a stand-alone communique conveying anything from warmth to wisdom, the humble notecard can rise above life's digital froth. A thought or two is composed. Pen meets paper. And then the result must be transported. So much more than the pressing of a "send" button, the handwritten note implies effort, and is thus special.

Stationery Studio specializes in Morris prints and Impressionist ing sea glass for years around her

well-designed notecards. There prints are on offer. are hand-illustrated botanical patterns, nautical and sporting motifs, preppy striped designs, and animals. All can be personalized with names or initials in a range of fonts.

At Papyrus, notecards come engraved with tiny sea turtles, hummingbirds, pineapples, vintage airplanes, lightbulbs or gingko leaves.

Art lovers should check out the Museum of Modern Art's online store, where notecard sets include the works of Matisse, Rothko, Klimt, Calder, Toulouse-Lautrec and Monet. More art cards can be found at other museums' shops, including that of The Metropolitan Museum of Art, where William

# How to get bold, beautiful alliums for every garden

Short or tall, big or small, treat for flower gardeners the bulbs in fall and enjoy months of colorful spring and summer blooms - this year, and for years to come.

You can choose flowers that are white, yellow, pink, ornamental alliums are a purple or even blue. Plant Allium hollandicum 'Purple Sensation' for a burst of color just prior to peony bloom. These raspberry-violet globes measure 3 to 4-inches across and are held high on 3-foot stems that rise above most newly emerging perennials. The bulbs are inexpensive, so it's affordable to create large displays. Plus, they multiply over time, so are a great choice for naturaliz-

Be sure to include some show stopping Globemaster alliums. These flowers are the size of bowling balls, on sturdy, three-foottall stems. Bloom time is the same as most peonies, which make excellent companions. The dried seed heads are striking when left in the garden and will usually last into early au-

though they will also grow ums you want to plant in tall stems. The spiky, violet-pink blossoms have a silvery sheen that adds to the stunning appearance. Plant the bulbs in flower beds, along pathways and in rock gardens where their late spring blooms can be admired close-up. Allow the dried seed heads to remain in the garden for months of added interest.

Plant the drumstick allium, Allium sphaerocephalon, amongst ornamental grasses or allow it to grow up through other perennials. The two-toned, raspberry and green flowers have long, slender stems and are a fabulous addition to early summer arrangements. Drumstick alliums will self-sow, so they're ideal for naturalizing.

Add an exotic look to the late spring garden with allium bulgaricum, also known as Nectaroscordum siculum or Sicilian honey garlic. The sprays of dangling, cream and burgundy florets have a look that's pressive, allium christophii completely different from has eight-inch diameter other alliums. • New England Aster (Symphyotrichum novaeangliae) Aster family: Purple blooms with a yellow center. They can grow to four feet or more, but there are many different cultivars that don't grow as tall and also produce blooms in different colors.

• Vernonia fasciculata (Ironweed) Aster family: This native grows up to seven feet tall, with vibrant, fuzzy, purple flower clusters at flowering, be sure to provide moist soil

• Sedum spp. (Stonecrop) Stonecrop family: Somehow this seems to be a favorite "mailbox garden" plant in my mauve flowers and watching ditions.

■ Joe-Pye Weed (Eupatorium purpureum) Aster family: This butterfly "magnet" can grow from five to seven feet tall. It's a great opportunity to observe butterflies at blooming plants provide eve level. Soft-looking, mauvepink flowers.

■ Zinnias (Zinnia spp.) Aster family: They're annuals, but I wanted to mention zinnias. They're bright, beautiful, bloom until frost, and provide a good nectar source for butterflies and hummingbirds.

While they may not be particularly sightly, the seed heads of some flowers are a great source of fall/winter food for birds. I learned this one year when I didn't get to cutting down the dead echinacea flower stalks and found goldfinches—six, eight, or even more at a time-coming to feed on them. Beautiful to watch!


