Lakes Area Farmers Market News

Located at Dickinson Co. Fairgrounds 15th Street & Peoria Avenue, Spirit Lake, IA 51360

Lakes Area Farmers Market in Spirit Lake is the place to shop for pumpkins. There are pumpkins for pie, like cinderella and small sugar. There are orange pumpkins, white pumpkins, yellow pumpkins, and even some light green ones. You will find all sizes from large for carving to very small for decorating. Some are warty, some are striped. Some pumpkins already have faces painted on them; some have fall scenes painted on; some can be personalized with your name or initial in decorative lettering. There are even pumpkin bags and pumpkin hats. There are also gourds in different sizes, shapes, and colors to display with your pumpkins. You can cook your pumpkins for pie, but you can also roast the seeds and eat them as a snack. Scoop out the seeds and place them in a bowl of water. Discard seeds that float and separate the pulp from the others. Place seeds in a strainer; rinse and pat dry. Place cleaned seeds on a cookie sheet with sides and bake at 250 degrees until dry, about 1 hour. Season the seeds with seasonings of your choice. You can use salt and pepper, finely grated hard cheese, brown sugar and cayenne pepper, or cocoa mix and cinnamon. Toss with your choice of seasoning and 2 tablespoons olive oil and roast at 350 degrees F, stirring occasionally, until golden brown and crisp, about 20 minutes. Roasted pumpkin seeds can be eaten alone as a snack, as a garnish on salads, or mixed with dried fruit and nuts for trail mix.

If you'd rather purchase your snacks, there is a selection of cookies, bars, brownies, and rolls at the Farmers Market. Local apples are available as well as homemade apple crisp and pie. Handmade crafts abound that make unique gifts. There are still 2 weeks to shop at Lakes Area Farmers Market on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 7:30 AM to 12:00 noon. We hope to see you there.




art studio and gallery tour; free for visitors, the Road Trip is a great way to spend a weekend with friends and family exploring the work of local artists.







was hard growing up in the depression. She picked corn by hand with her father before she went to school. She and her brother Don swore that when they grew up they wouldn't be cold or hungry again. Upon graduating high school she worked at Frank's Cafe and then Bjornstad Drug for 4 years where her future mother-in-law said "I want you to meet my son when he is home on leave." They met and fell in love in December of 1942. Ruth then rode a train, alone, from Iowa to Pyote, Texas to marry Bob

Barnard where he was stationed with the Air Force. They married on his birthday November 7, 1943.

After the war Ruth and Bob worked his Uncle George's farm in the '40s for 4 years near Gillett Grove and then moved to Monahans, Texas in 1951 where she worked as a long lines operator for Southern Bell while Bob was a roustabout in the oil fields. Later they moved to St. Louis and together worked for Wagner Electric until 1954 when they adopted a baby girl and returned to lowa. Ruth was a stay at home mom for the first couple of years in Petersen. In 1959 they moved to Spencer; she got a job at Stub's Ranch Kitchen as a waitress, then at Nelson's Children Shop and Women's Shop as a sales clerk. In 1967, they moved to Hartley where she worked at the Hartley Drugstore. After their daughter graduated high school Bob and Ruth headed west to Fort Collins, Colorado, where she worked for Forney's Factory in the shipping department. They retired back to Spirit Lake in 1980. She worked at Billie's Dress Shop and began modeling at their summer fashion shows. She modeled her wedding gown when she was in her '70s.

Ruth liked baking apple pies and butterscotch bars. After work she would come home and wash the floors, clean house, bake and put her hair up in rollers. No wonder she loved the fair and visited the fair on September 10, 2019, one last time at age 99. She loved to drink coffee and the color green. She was proud to be 100% Dane. She practiced chair and laughter yoga the last nine years of her life.

Ruth and Bob loved to dance to big band music of the '40s and would often dance at the Roof Garden and other dance halls throughout their lives. They kept on dancing until Bob got Parkinson's. Ruth kept him at home, taking care of him for 13 years. The last 7 months of his life were spent at Hilltop Care Center where she visited him

Ruth is survived by her daughter, Martha Helen Barnard, her sonin-law Chad Branham, her sister Naomi Adams and Naomi's children Ned Adams and Jean Ferneding as well as some cousins and many nieces and nephews. 



Twins Historic Season Continues

The Minnesota Twins have truly had a season for the record books as they set the Major League Baseball record for home runs on Sunday with a total of 307 team home runs, edging out the New York Yankees by one home run. 

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and Imagine Iowa Great Lakes began work this week to repair the

seawall at Arnolds Park. The project will stabilize the foundation of the sidewalk and ultimately serve as a platform for the beautification work led by Imagine Iowa Great Lakes.

The project intent is to stabilize the existing seawall by placing pervious lightweight foam concrete behind the seawall and constructing a sheet pile wall in front of the seawall to prevent scour. The existing sidewalk will be removed and replaced with a new ADA compliant concrete sidewalk. The project will enhance and maintain the beach feel of the area once completed.

"This project exemplifies how the State of Iowa and nonprofits can join together to more efficiently deliver

projects across the state," said DNR Director Kayla Lyon. "Public-private partnerships allow our Agency to further our dollars and our impact." When the engineering work is complete, the Imagine Iowa

Great Lakes team will install a wooden boardwalk adjacent to

West Lake Okoboji along with planting areas, brick pavers, a public art piece, and site furnishings that will enhance visitors' experience in the project area. "The Imagine team is grateful for the DNR's prompt attention

to this issue and the agency's collaborative spirit," said Michele Goodenow, Imagine Iowa Great Lakes executive director. "It's because of these partnerships that our region is able to flourish and continually grow our tourism industry."

Repair work on the seawall is being led by Graves Construction Company, Inc., and will be complete by the end of December.

a tribute to father, Phil
Emmetsburg's Main Street Community Theatre is welcoming back Emmetsburg native Gregory Eichelzer to the EMSCT stage where his performing career began

more than 35 years ago. Gregory graduated from Emmetsburg High School in 1992. His parents, Phil and Rita Jane Eichelzer, owned Eichelzer Pharmacy in Emmetsburg, and the Villager Store in West Bend, which is still in business with an old-fashioned soda fountain! Gregory and his dad used to perform at events like talent shows and the fair, and Gregory fell in love with performing. He sang songs like Rainbow Connection and Big Rock Candy Mountain while

Phil accompanied him on guitar or bass. Gregory was the youngest cast member in his first EMSCT production, Annie Get Your Gun, in 1981. (His mom dressed him in his footie pajamas for rehearsals,

knowing the effort would likely stretch well past his bedtime.) Eichelzer later entertained EMSCT audiences in productions that included Mame, Oklahoma, Annie, and Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat. After graduation in 1982, Greg went on to earn a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Niagara University, and performed in national tours of *Grease* and *Annie*, and international tours of Evita and Grease. Then, in 2007, he went back to school and changed careers. He is now a Clinical Educator at Cedars Sinai ED - Level 1

Trauma Center, in Los Angeles, but returned to singing for fun four years ago. He recently had a fundraising show, Songs For My Father, in Los Angeles, as a benefit for the Cedar Sinai Brain Tumor Center. Phil Eichelzer would have turned 75 this year. It has been 25 years since his passing from brain cancer, and because Phil loved music and the theatre, especially the EMSCT, Gregory decided to bring the one man, cabaret style show back home to Emmetsburg as a fund-raiser for the theatre in Phil's name for the benefit of the theatre, which is in need or roof repairs

(Johnson later performed the tenor solo featured in the Academy Award nominated instrumental theme for The Pink Panther motion picture.) The album was reissued worldwide as a stereo CD in 1996. The entire album is on YouTube...

RD apparently needs a stronger cup o' Joe. After seeing that today was listed as National Coffee Day, she was somewhat surprised to find the day was actually two daze earlier, on Sunday! RD's song was to have been Peggy Lee's very sexy and timeless rendition of, *Black Coffee*, written by Sonny Burke and Paul Francis Webster in 1948. ... Coffee was first recorded by Sarah Vaughan for Columbia

Records in 1949. k.d. lang used it in 1988 on *Shadowland*. But Peggy Lee owned it! **Irish actor-singer Richard Harris** was born on this day in 1930. Harris was best-known for spinning songwriter Jimmy Webb's compositions into gold. He recorded *MacArthur Park* in 1968, and *Didn't We*, which was first put on vinyl by James Darren a year earlier. Since then there have been many cover versions, including those by Frank Sinatra, Barbra Streisand; and Liz Callaway with Ann

Hampton Callaway, in a medley of the Webb songs for their 2001 live CD, Boom!...

Roger Williams was also born on this day — in 1924. Though born Louis Jacob Weertz in Omaha, Nebraska, Williams spent many years in Iowa, where he attended Drake University before recording 38 albums containing chart-topping hits such as *Autumn Leaves*, *Born Free*, and *The Impossible Dream*. In addition to his talents at the keyboard, Williams was also a Navy boxing champion. Throughout his career he played for nine presidential administrations and had a gold Steinway

& Sons grand piano model named in his honor. Editor's note #1: If you want to know how Williams learned to play the saxophone while at Drake, ask Spirit Lake's very own Audrey Allen. She has the story!

Wednesday will be Name Your Car Day. That brought The Rip Chords' Hey Little Cobra to mind. The Shelby Cobra sports car had been produced in both the United Kingdom and the United States since 1962. And it was just one year after the Cobra debuted that *The Rip Chords* named it their favorite sports car with a 45 rpm salute. RD was reminded about this some years ago when she spied a Shelby at the Clay County Fair, and wanted to drive it home...

October 2nd is also the day in 1953 that pianist Victor Borge opened his oneman show, Comedy in Music, at the John Golden Theatre in New York, to become the longest running one-man show in the history of that theatre. The show saw 849 performances before it closed in 1956. That feat put CIM in the Guinness Book...

Editor's note #2: When the Museum of Danish America, in Elkhorn, Iowa, needed just the right pianist to play at the dedication of Victor's Borge's first piano (after the family donated it to the museum), they called on Glenn Henriksen, who put on a show that included Borge's daughter, Janet Crowle, in a duet with "The Chopsticks Waltz..."

2 cups all-purpose flour 4 teaspoons baking powder Pinch of salt 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, chilled and cut into cubes 1 cup pecan pieces 1 extra-large egg 1/4 cup pure maple syrup

About 3 tablespoons milk

Preheat the oven to 425°F. Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a large bowl. Add the butter and mix with fingertips until resembles fine crumbs. Stir in the pecans.

In a separate bowl, beat egg, maple syrup and 1 tablespoon milk. Stir into the flour mixture to make a soft, coarse-looking dough. If the dough won't stick together, stir in 1 tablespoon milk. If the dough is very sticky, stir in 1 tablespoon of flour. Dump the dough onto a floured work surface and gently work with your hands for a few seconds. Put the dough ball onto a greased baking sheet. Pat out to 1 1/4 inches thick by 7 inches circle. Cut into 6 wedges, but do not separate. Bake for 18 to 20 minutes until light brown. Serve warm.





Dickinson County Endowment Fund Provides Senior Meals

My name is Angela Kofoot and I am the executive director of the Voluntary Action Center. VAC manages our local MEALS on Wheels program, a herculean effort undertaken by church coordinators, volunteer drivers, the Lakes Regional Hospital, the Accura Care Center in Milford, and countless others. We served almost 6,500 meals last year to residents of Dickinson County. That number will probably be at least 20% higher this year and is expected to continue to rise as our population ages. In fact, Dickinson County's population of people over the age of 60 is 30% higher than the national average.

As part of the Dickinson County Hunger Coalition and the Healthy Hometown program, we have been discussing food insecurity issues. I realized that we didn't really have a solution for our senior food insecure population. I knew that many Dickinson County residents could not even afford to start receiving Meals on Wheels.

Out of that, our first ever "Giving Tuesday" fundraiser on the first Tuesday after Thanksgiving was born. The money from this new Giving Tuesday fundraiser translated to over 1000 half price meals for our homebound neighbors this year.

I approached the Dickinson County Endowment Fund about adding to that fund. They have generously given us enough funds to provide over 800 free meals to our homebound neighbors seniors who used to be our teachers, our police officers, store clerks and farmers.

VAC wants to give a big THANK YOU to the DCEF for donating money toward this important cause.






