



DISTRICT NEEDS

Each year the City of New York requires each Community Board to submit a list of capital and expense requests in its respective district for review. For example, Bronx Community Board #10 can suggest to the city to renovate an existing park, create a new park or increase funding to the City Department of Transportation for road repair. If there is a city program that is successful and wish for it to have its funding increased, please let me know. An example of this is the Parks Department's tree and sidewalks program where high priority sidewalks damaged by a city tree are repaired. Please be advised that this process is now open, and you should submit your requests as soon as possible. If you are a Bronx Community Board #10 resident that wishes to suggest an item to be placed on our Fiscal Year 2020 District Needs Statement please contact me directly at (718) 892-1161 or via e-mail at bx10@cb.nyc.gov. Requests are prioritized. If your request does not make it to our final list in October, my office will still have it on record for future District Needs Statements. To be clear, our list to the City of New York is merely a recommendation to the City for what we feel the community needs in terms of municipal services.

NYC HUMAN RESOURCE ADMINISTRATION (HRA) REPRESENTATIVE AT CB #10

Every third Friday of the month, a NYC HRA/ Department of Social Services representative is available to take your questions and help you with social service benefit applications at our office at 3165 East Tremont Avenue, Bronx, NY 10461 from 10 A.M. to 3 P.M. While walk-ins are accepted, please call us at (718) 892-1161 to reserve your meeting with the NYC HRA representative. The NYC HRA/ Department of Social Services is the largest social services agency in the country serving nearly 3 million New Yorkers. Through the NYC HRA, eligible New Yorkers receive help from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and through the Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF) or cash assistance program. In addition to these programs, eligible New Yorkers can apply for a "One Shot Deal" and other related programs that help during unforeseen circumstances. For immediate help, please contact (718) 557-1399.






As a member of the New York City Council's Committee on Parks and Recreation. I was pleased to be able to help hold Parks accountable during an oversight hearing on September 26th. Many of our cherished parks are in visible disrepair, as many of you have so diligently illustrated in our **#ShameNYC** campaign. They need more maintenance than Parks is able to provide. Much of that has to do with Parks' rapidly diminishing budget, which for fiscal year 2019, totaled less than 1% of the city budget. This budget is clearly insufficient in meeting the maintenance demands of our city's 30,000 acres of developed park land, where maintenance problems, ranging from unkempt grass to dangerously worn playground equipment, are abound.

I believe, as I know you do, that our parks are our community centers. These parks, which comprise about 14% of our city's land, keep us active, social and happy. But when these civic centers of ours become dirty, poorly maintained or even pose risks to our health, they cease to be the great community centers they ought to be. At the hearing, I was able to represent your concerns and what specifically afflicts us in Bronx's 13th Council District. Rest assured, our troubles are not going unanswered.

I am fighting to bring better funding to Parks so we can enjoy safe and clean spaces. Make no mistake, I fully intend to work with Parks to resolve this issue, but I need your help to do so. The Department of Parks and Recreation and the administration of our city need to be continually shown what the consequences underfunding look like. While our of **#ShameNYC** effort has gained incredible traction. our work is not over vet. Continue to tag your photos of what is affecting you in your parks, tag them with **#ShameNYC**, and send them to me on Twitter and Facebook, email me at MGjonaj@council.nyc.gov, or even call my district office at (718) 931-1721.

DIRECTIONS

PREHEAT OVEN TO 350 DEGREES F (175 DEGREES C). COMBINE FLOUR, BAKING POWDER, BAKING SODA, CINNAMON, NUTMEG, GROUND CLOVES, AND SALT; SET ASIDE.


IN A MEDIUM BOWL, CREAM TOGETHER THE 1/2 CUP OF BUTTER AND WHITE SUGAR. ADD PUMPKIN, EGG, AND 1 TEASPOON VANILLA TO BUTTER MIXTURE, AND BEAT UNTIL CREAMY. MIX IN DRY INGREDIENTS. DROP ON COOKIE SHEET BY TABLESPOONFULS; FLATTEN SLIGHTLY.

BAKE FOR 15 TO 20 MINUTES IN THE PREHEATED OVEN. COOL COOKIES. THEN DRIZZLE GLAZE WITH FORK.

TO MAKE GLAZE: COMBINE CONFECTIONERS' SUGAR, MILK, 1 TABLESPOON MELTED BUTTER, AND 1 TEASPOON VANILLA. ADD MILK AS NEEDED, TO ACHIEVE DRIZZLING CONSISTENCY.




