History Matters

October 15 to October 30

The American Revolution essentially ended on October 19, 1781 when British General Charles Cornwallis surrendered his 8,000 British and Hessian troops to General George Washington in Yorktown, VA. Washington enveloped the general in Yorktown using American and French armies, and a large French fleet of warships to force the British to quit. Two years later, the Treaty of Paris was signed, and the hostilities in America were ended.

Thomas Edison lit the world when he invented the light-bulb October 21, 1879. On that day, he successfully tested his "electric incandescent lamp"—composed—in part—of a never-tested carbonized filament that remained aglow more than 14 hours. Inventors from around the world since 1835 had tried to successfully develop an electric light.

Panic selling overwhelmed the New York Stock Exchange on October 24, 1929, when traders dumped 13 million shares as stock prices began to tumble. Five days later—on "Black Tuesday" an additional 16 million shares were sold as prices continued to drop. These events were part of the reason for The Great Depression, which lasted until 1939.

The Wild West lived up to its reputation in Tombstone, Arizona, on October 26, 1881, when the Earp Brothers -- Wyatt, Virgil and Morgan -- and Doc Holliday-- confronted the outlaw Clanton clan in the gunfight at the O.K. Corral—a near legendary, but true tale--about a critical time in the American history.

Tombstone became a boomtown in 1877 after silver was discovered nearby; suddenly, miners seeking their fortunes were lured to the small community. Farmers and ranchers also saw an opening—and a market—for their produce and livestock, while criminals like the Clanton clan were on the lookout for Lady Luck to go their way. They rustled cattle, held up stagecoaches; maimed and murdered their victims. Tombstone had turned into one of the country's richest mining towns, but the people finally had their fill of the bad guys and hired the Earps to keep the peace. The gunfight at the O.K. Corral was an example of America's growing "pains."

The Mount Rushmore National Memorial, located in the Black Hills of Keystone, South Dakota, is one of the most ambitious public works ever undertaken. It was the masterpiece of American artist and sculptor, Gutzon Borglum: 14 years in the making to complete the sixty-foot granite faces of Presidents Washington, Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Lincoln, Borglum died just before the end of the project, but his son, Lincoln, finished it on October 31, 1941.

The Carving of Mount Rushmore by Rex Alan Smith is all about a truly "monumental" accomplishment that is a lesson in patriotism.

It is never too early to begin protecting pets from Halloween dangers. We urge owners to be diligent during the entire month, rather than just October 30th and 31st.

On November 1, 2000; I was teaching an early morning scripture study class to teenagers. We met from 6:00 - 6:45 a.m. One of the students told me that morning that she had heard in school that some students who dabbled in cult rituals frequented a place known as Satan's Bridge. We had always received more reports of missing black cats around Halloween, but that morning I went to the bridge and my Halloweens become even scarier. That day, there was the body of a black cat in the middle of the road. I will leave out the gory details, but suffice it to say that the injuries were deliberate.

Several years ago, I attended a local workshop about cult rituals. Some of the pictures and slides still haunt me, and when I wake up in the middle of the night with them on my mind, prayer is the only thing that erases them. There truly is an underworld culture of rituals and animal sacrifices.

Even without thinking of those horrible things, Halloween can be a scary time for pets. They can also become frightened by the costumes. We recommend that pet owners take the following precautions:

Keep your pets inside, away from all Halloween activities. The frequently-opened doors provide an opportunity for escape, especially if they feel threatened by the sight of costumes.

It may seem like a cute idea to dress dogs in costumes and have them go door-to-door with you. However, the dogs may not think it is such a good idea! Make sure all pets wear collars with identification tags, just in case.

Do not give in to the temptation to let your pets have candy. Candy can be harmful to them, and chocolate is toxic to dogs, cats, and ferrets. You can have special animal treats available for them.

If you use candles in jack-o-lanterns, make sure your pet stays away. Accidents can happen, and the candles can quickly burn or set fire to a pet's fur. Playful cats can become entangled in hanging decorations like streamers, and other decorations can be a choking hazard.

Every outside animal is at risk for being hurt by pranksters or cruel people, but black cats are especially at risk during this time of year. If you do have a black cat, the safest place for him for a couple of weeks before Halloween is right by your side.

If you do have an animal that is lost, be sure to call the Danville Area Humane Society at 799-0843 and all other shelters within a large radius. Be diligent; call all area veterinary clinics also, because members of the public routinely pick up strays and take them to veterinary clinics.

Halloween can be a scary time, but with extra awareness, pets can be protected.

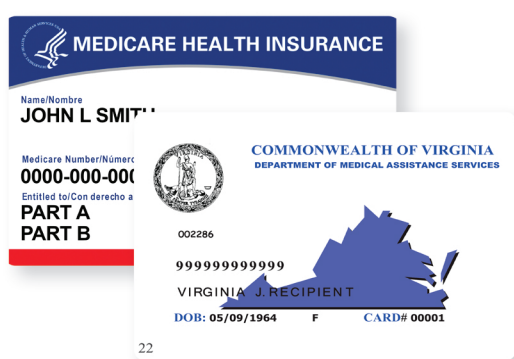

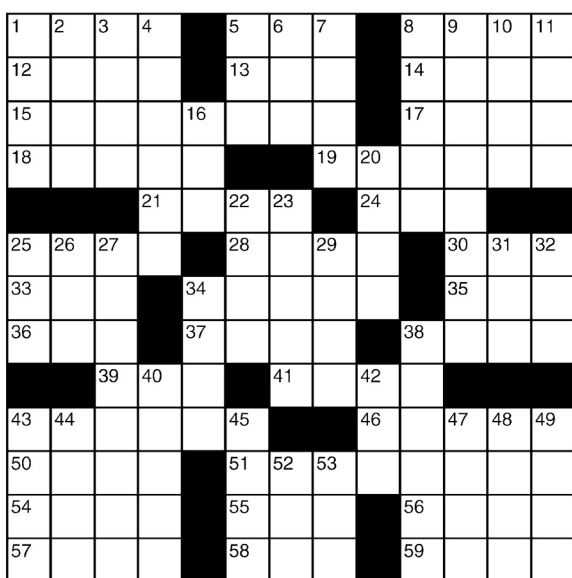

Kidney Stones, Some Supplements Don't Mix

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have been taking a multivitamin for years, and now one of my physicians wants me to take a vitamin that has NO vitamin D or calcium. He just removed kidney stones in two separate procedures. I can't find any vitamins like that. -- D.A.S.

ANSWER: I completely agree that people with kidney stones should avoid calcium supplements. The transiently high levels of calcium after taking one cause the kidney to excrete a lot of that calcium, and that can cause a calcium crystal to grow, eventually forming a stone. Calcium that comes from the diet, on the other hand, does not induce such a spike in blood levels. Also, part of the calcium bonds with oxalate, preventing that chemical -- a major part of many kidney stones -- from being absorbed. High dietary calcium reduces the risk of stones. The effect of vitamin D is not as clear. It seems that having low vitamin D is a risk for forming stones, so many experts will treat low vitamin D levels in people with kidney stones. I don't know your exact situation. It may be that your vitamin D level is normal or high, and you just don't need supplementation. The most recent studies have consistently shown that most of the vitamins in a multivitamin tablet (with the exception of vitamin D) do not improve health or prevent illness, so I don't recommend multivitamins anymore. I would encourage a healthy diet with plenty of fresh fruits and vegetables. Save your money on the vitamin tablets.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have been on tramadol for 10 years. I am worried that it is or will affect my brain, as it works by changing the way my brain treats pain. I am 76 years old and take two or three a day. I take it for my arthritis. -- M.K.

ANSWER: Tramadol is an opioid pain medication, similar to codeine and others. It may slow down breathing, especially in high doses. It works by blocking a pain receptor (the mu receptor) in the brain. The brain responds to this by inducing changes in the mu receptors, making them less sensitive, and in many cases reducing the effect of the dose over time, necessitating higher doses for the same effect. This is one of the reasons that opioids are not good long-term medication for pain, especially for chronic conditions like arthritis. In addition to that fundamental change in the brain, long-term opiate use increases risk of motor vehicle accidents for drivers, actually can increase sensitivity to pain, is likely to cause constipation and puts people at risk for accidental overdose. These risks increase with higher doses and at older ages; the manufacturer warns to use high doses only with extreme caution for those over 75.

Tramadol comes in a 50-mg dose, but there are extended-release forms up to 300 mg, and I'm not sure what dose you are taking and how worried to be about it. I suspect other medications may work better for you. The dose you took at age 65 may no longer be appropriate at age 75. I would at least consider an alternative. If so, work with your doctor to slowly reduce the tramadol dosage: Never suddenly discontinue.

Water Carriers

Everyday life was often depicted in paintings or figurines in the days when photographs were unknown. Familiar workers like firemen, soldiers, farmers or royalty were made from porcelain or metal. Several important factories, including the Royal Worcester company of England, Royal Dux, Zsol-

nay, Goldscheider, Hummel, Lladro and KPM, made water-carrier figures of porcelain. Others created bronze figures. They must have had a very important, very familiar job to have been subjects for so many makers.

Most people today do not realize that the water carrier was an important person. Water had to be scooped from a well, then walked to the center of the city or perhaps carried in a cart, where it was ladled into containers held by customers. There were no wells or piped-in water supplies.

The figures were very similar — usually a pair, a man and a woman, each holding a pouring jug and a large container of water. They were wearing the common clothes of the country. The woman often carried the water bottle on her head. Each figure was 10 to 15 inches tall, and most were glazed in appropriate colors. A pair of marked

Q. I am trying to identify a table I inherited from an aunt. The table has a paneled drawer, applied panels on the sides and a turned strestlelike base with a shelf. It had an inset leather top that was tattered, and there is an odd drawer hanging underneath. This piece was covered in black tar from years in a basement. I don't know what is. I think it was part of a home library. Can you help?

A. You have a ladies' work table, probably from the late Victorian era. Sewing or work tables originated in England about 1770 and were used in America after the Revolutionary War. Women gathered in a parlor and worked around a small table with a surface for writing, needlework or other activities. Early work tables were Sheraton or Empire and often made of mahogany. They had a drawer or two for storage. Later Victorian tables were heavily carved with turned scroll legs. Most had an extra storage compartment under the top — either a cloth sack or a compartment under the central drawer. Ladies' work tables auction for about \$225 to \$600.

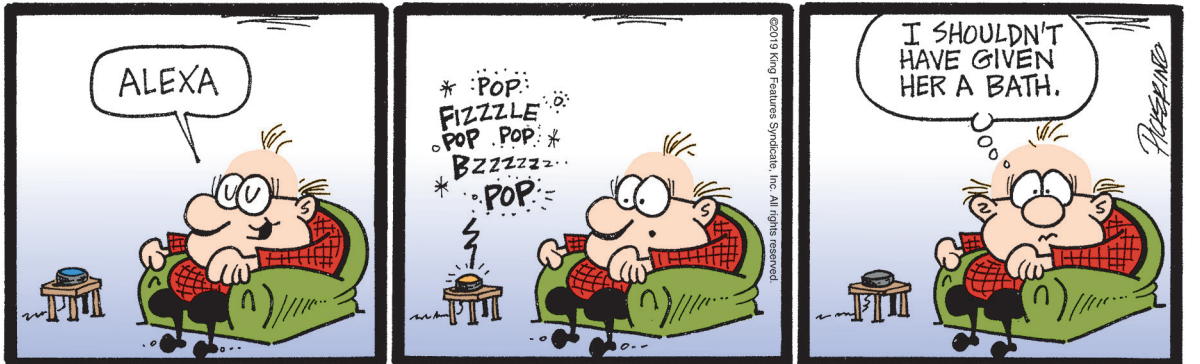

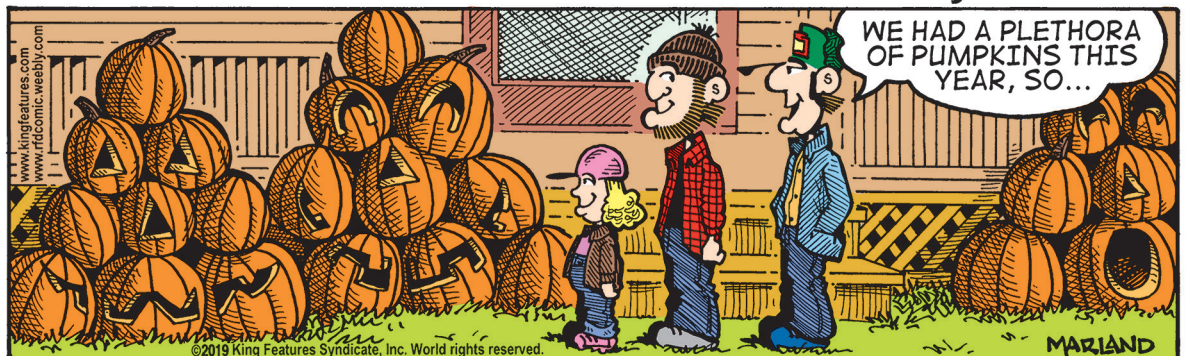

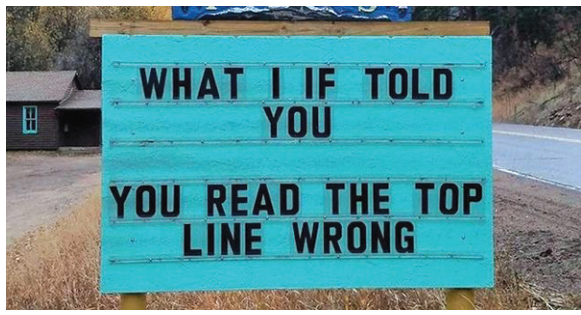

APPLE COBBLER

This easy apple cobbler recipe just takes a handful of ingredients. Serve warm with vanilla ice cream and a drizzle of caramel sauce.

INGREDIENTS

- For the apple filling
- 8 large Granny Smith apples
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- For the topping
- 2 cups flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 large eggs
- 2/3 cup melted butter

INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Peel and slice the apples into 1/4 inch thick slices.
- Add the apples to a large mixing bowl and toss with the 1/2 cup of sugar and cinnamon. Taste and add more sugar as needed if apples are very tart.
- Pour apples into a 9x13 baking dish and set aside.
- Stir together the flour, sugar, baking powder, salt, and eggs in a medium mixing bowl until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs.
- Pour the crumbs over the apples to cover.
- Drizzle the melted butter evenly over the crumb mixture.
- Bake for 45-60 minutes or until the topping is golden brown.
- Cool 10 minutes before serving.
