

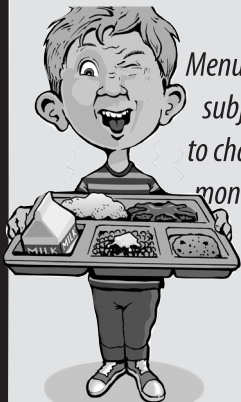

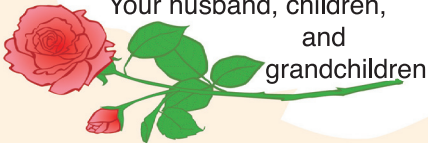

Legal Purchasing Age for Tobacco to be Raised to 21 Statewide

NYS Governor Andrew Cuomo recently signed Tobacco 21 into law. Beginning November 13, 2019, the legal age to buy tobacco, electronic cigarettes, and vaping devices will be raised to 21. New York State is now one of 17 states to approve raising the age. More than 20 Counties in New York have already made the move including Albany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Cortland, Essex, and Tompkins. This decision comes after much debate and concern regarding the safety of children and teens. According to the Surgeon General, 88% of adult smokers start using tobacco before the age of 18 and 90% of the people who buy cigarettes for underage children are between 18 and 20. "This is an important law that will help protect our children from the leading cause of preventable death, initiated by tobacco use" states Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director. The Livingston County Department of Health will continue to be responsible for monitoring and enforcing age restrictions on tobacco sales. October is Fire Prevention Month: 10 Home Fire Safety Tips

The U.S. Fire Administration reports that fires kill more than 4,000 Americans each year and approximately injure 20,000 more. U.S. fire departments respond to nearly 2 million fires each year, with three-quarters of them occurring in residences.

A home is often referred to as a safe haven. This month, make sure your home is protected from (and your family is prepared for) a fire. There is little time to think or act in the moment of a fire. This is why it is crucial to educate yourself and your family on fire safety and prevention.

Here are 10 simple tips to help you avoid fires and reduce the risk of injury should one occur:

- 1) Install smoke alarms in all levels of your home. Put them both inside and outside the bedroom. Make sure to test smoke alarms every month to ensure they are working properly. When you change your clock setting in the spring and fall, change your smoke detector batteries.
- 2) Create a fire escape plan with your family members and practice the plan semi-annually.
- 3) Avoid plugging several appliance cords into the same electrical outlet.
- 4) Use common sense while in the kitchen. Limit distractions while cooking and keep items that can catch on fire, such as wooden spoons or dish towels, away from your stove top.
- 5) Keep a fire extinguisher in the kitchen in case of emergency.
- 6) Store matches and lighters away from young children.
- 7) Never leave space heaters on when you are not in the room. Also, keep them at least three feet away from any items that can burn. Closely supervise children and pets while a space heater is in use.
- 8) If you live in an apartment building, know all of the building's fire escapes. Do not use the elevator in the event of a fire. Always take the stairs.
- 9) If you have a fireplace or wood burning stove, be sure to only use seasoned hardwood like oak, ash, or maple.
- 10) Clothes dryer vents often start fires in homes. Clean the lint filter each time you start a load of clothes to dry or after the drying cycle is complete. Make sure your exhaust duct is made from metal tubing and not plastic or foil. Clean the exhaust duct with a good quality dryer vent brush to prevent blockage and check for lint build up behind the dryer at least twice a year.

Following these simple tips could potentially save your life or the life of a loved one. Pass this list on to your friends and family and make this fire prevention month count! 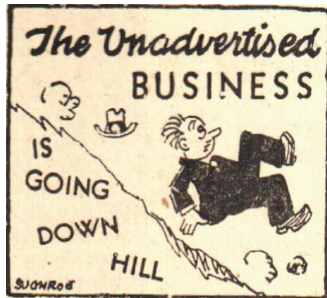

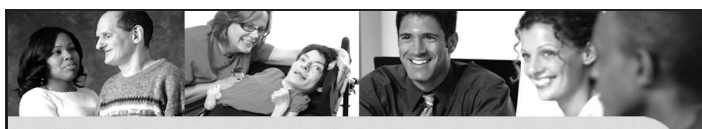

EARLY VOTING for 2019 General Election Beginning October 26th

Livingston County voters who want to cast their ballots early in the upcoming general election will be able to do so beginning **Saturday, October 26, 2019 and continuing through Sunday, November 3, 2019**. The Livingston County Board of Elections offers the following answers to the most common questions about early voting:

What is early voting?

Earlier this year, New York State passed election reform that requires election officials to provide early voting opportunities prior to Election Day on November 5, 2019. This is the first time early in-person voting will occur in New York State.

Who can vote early?

All registered voters can vote early.

When can I vote early?

To provide convenient early voting opportunities, the polls will be open on weekdays and weekends:

Saturday, October 26 • 9 am-2 pm.	Sunday, October 27 • 9 am-2 pm.	Monday, October 28 • 8 am-8 pm.
Tuesday, October 29 • 8 am-4 pm.	Wednesday, October 30 • 8 am-8 pm.	Thursday, October 31 • 8 am-4 pm.
Friday, November 1 • 8 am-4 pm.	Saturday, November 2 • 9 am-2 pm.	Sunday, November 3 • 9 am-2 pm.

Where can I vote early?

Livingston County voters can vote at the Livingston County Board of Elections, 6 Court Street, Room 104, Geneseo, NY 14454.

Is the early voting process different than voting on Election Day?

Early voting is the same as voting on Election Day. When you get to the early voting center, you will check in to vote, receive your ballot and vote as any other election. Once you vote early, you will not be eligible to vote on Election Day. Your vote will already have been cast.

When will early voting results be posted?

Early votes will be canvassed and reported after 9 pm on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Can I still vote by absentee ballot?

Yes. You may apply for and vote by absentee ballot if you are: (i) out of your home county, (ii) permanently or temporarily disabled, ill or are the primary caregiver for one or more people who are ill or physically disabled, (iii) a resident of a Veterans Hospital, (iv) detained in jail awaiting Grand Jury action or incarcerated for an offense other than a felony.
