





The county will accept ballots at the Board of Elections from Oct. 26 to Nov. 3. The county will have election inspectors on site and residents can vote as in any other election.

The county will have four election inspectors on duty – 2 Republicans and 2 Democrats – for early voting.

- Oct. 28 (Monday) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Oct. 29-30 (Tuesday and Wednesday) from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Oct. 31-Nov. 1 (Thursday and Friday) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Nov. 2-3 (Saturday and Sunday) from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The general election is Nov. 5 with polls in the 10 towns in Orleans County open from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.

In the month of September, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 1944 police incidents, including 698 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 198 for the New York State Police and 1048 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 574 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 454 of those calls emergency medical in nature and 2 drug overdoses

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 44 automobile accidents, including 11 with injury and 16 car-deer collisions. Road patrol also made 57 service attempts and successfully served 31 subpoenas, civil, or court papers.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 149 incidents including 46 stray or loose animals, 7 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 14 animals were taken into shelter on voluntary surrenders.

The Orleans County Jail processed in 83 inmates and handled 82 prisoner transports to court appearances, medical treatments, or other correctional facilities.

## **HEAP SEASON BEGINS NOVEMBER 12, 2019**



## **Utility Vehicles: What's the Difference?**

The terms "sport utility vehicle (SUV)" and "crossover" (also dubbed a compact sport utility vehicle, or CUV) are heard quite frequently and sometimes used interchangeably. It can be easy to blur the terms because of the subtle differences between these types of vehicles. But upon careful interpretation of these ultra-popular vehicles, the variations between them become more apparent. The frames of these vehicles can help people distinguish between them. Many car experts refer to SUVs as those vehicles that are equipped with the chassis of a truck, while crossovers are based on a car's platform. SUVs

rely on a "body on frame," which means the body is built separately from the frame of the vehicle and then assembled later on. Crossovers use "unibody" architecture, which means the body and frame are one piece. SUVs are classified as a light truck and have the towing and performance capabilities of a pickup truck. As a result, the wheelbase, floorplan, suspension, powertrain, and other SUV arrangements are similar to those of a pickup. Conversely, crossovers use the platform of a sedan and handle much more like traditional passenger cars, offering smooth rides and responsive handling. Crossovers are often smaller than SUVs and may not have the off-roading or towing capacities of SUVs. Another difference is the driveline. Most SUVs employ four-wheel drive systems, while crossovers have two-wheel drive systems.

Farmers in Orleans County who took a chance by planting crops later than usual are getting some nice warm weather to help the crops mature. Normally a hard frost has hit by now, which shuts down corn and soybeans. But the freezing temperatures have stayed away, allowing crops to mature. Farmers would like about two more weeks of warmth for the corn and soybeans to reach good yields and high guality, said Larry Meyer, director of the Farm Service Agency in Orleans and Monroe counties. In Orleans, there are usually about 125,000 acres planted each year with corn and soybeans. Meyer said the wet spring delayed planting with farmers deciding not to

plant 23,170 acres. There were about 90,000 acres that went unplanted in Orleans, Genesee, Niagara and Monroe counties, Meyer said. "There is still a lot of corn that is green," Meyer said today. "But most of the soybeans are drying down. Most are looking good."

Farmers who planted late will know in couple weeks if they have a quality crop with a good yield. "If we can get a couple more weeks without a killing frost, we'll catch up," Meyer said. "It could turn out OK for people who did plant."



## **Chocolate-Peanut Butter Terrine** with Sugared Peanuts

#### Serves 8

#### Terrine

11 ounces bittersweet chocolate,

- finely chopped
- 1 ounce unsalted butter
- 6 tablespoons creamy peanut butter
- 4 large egg yolks
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 3/4 cups whipping cream

#### Glaze

4 ounces bittersweet chocolate, finely chopped

2 1/2 ounces unsalted butter

2 teaspoons light corn syrup

#### **Sugared Peanuts**

1 large egg white

6 tablespoons granulated sugar

 $1 \frac{1}{2}$  cups unsalted peanuts

Spray an 8 1/2 x 4 1/2 x 2 3/4-inch loaf pan with nonstick spray. Line the sprayed pan with plastic wrap, allowing a 1 1/2-inch overhang on all sides.

In a stainless-steel bowl, combine the chocolate, butter, and peanut butter. Place the bowl over a pan of simmering water, making sure the bottom of the bowl does not touch the water. Heat, stirring occasionally, until the chocolate and butter melt. Remove from the heat and whisk until smooth.

Combine the egg yolks and sugar in the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the whip attachment and whip on high speed until thick, about 1 minute. Remove the bowl from the mixer stand. Using a wooden spoon, stir in the chocolate mixture in 3 equal additions. The mixture will be quite thick.

In a separate bowl, whisk the cream until it starts to thicken. Using a spatula, fold the cream into the chocolate mixture in 4 equal additions. Spread the batter in the prepared pan. Cover with the plastic wrap overhanging the sides and refrigerate until firm, at least 4 hours.

To unmold the terrine, fold back the plastic wrap and invert the pan onto a wire rack. Pull on a corner of the plastic wrap to release the terrine from the pan. Lift off the pan and carefully remove the plastic wrap. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and place the rack on it. Return the terrine to the refrigerator while you make the glaze.

To make the glaze, in a stainless-steel bowl, combine the chocolate, butter and corn syrup. Place the bowl over a pan of simmering water, making sure the bottom of the bowl does not touch the water, and heat, stirring occasionally, until the chocolate and butter melt. Remove from over the heat and whisk until smooth. The glaze should be pourable but not so thin that it will run off the terrine. If the glaze is too thin, let it sit at room temperature for about 30 minutes.

Slowly pour the glaze evenly over the top of the terrine, allowing it to stream evenly down the sides. With an offset spatula, spread the glaze to cover the terrine smoothly and completely. Refrigerate until the glaze is set, about 30 minutes.

To make the sugared peanuts, preheat the oven to 350 F. In a bowl, whisk the egg white until frothy. Whisk in the sugar. Add the peanuts and mix until they are evenly coated with the mixture. Spread the peanuts in a single layer on a rimmed baking sheet and place in the oven. Toast the nuts, stirring them every 5 minutes, until dry and golden brown, 15 to 20 minutes.

To serve, transfer the terrine to a serving platter and arrange the sugared peanuts on top. Cut the terrine with a hot, dry knife.
