
In order to help Brayden with his medical expenses, the Spirit Lake Kiwanis, the SLHS Key Club and the Spirit Lake Middle








OHS Debate in Team First Competition of Season

WEL-Life Gets Stamp of Approval by the Iowa DIA

The employees of WEL-Life at Spirit Lake strive to provide quality care with respect, dignity and kindness. Their efforts were recently given the stamp

of approval by the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals (DIA) following a recent on-site inspection.

The biennial survey resulted in an insufficiency-free report, which means that no deficien-

cies were found. WEL-Life was found to be in substantial compliance of all the rules and regulations required by the state.

'We train on the state's expectations and we have high expectations of the staff to continue following those rules and regulations," said Linda Breuker, director of healthcare services. Both staff and residents are involved in the survey process.

The employees provide stability to know and understand if someone isn't feeling quite right, according to Breuker. If someone is showing signs of illness or decline, employees report it to their supervisors.

'We have had residents who have lived here for 10 years,' Breuker said. "You get to know someone very well in 10 years." We know their families and they know us. Everyone working here enjoys their work and it shows!'

Johnson and Breuker have worked at the facility since March 2008 adding a tremendous knowledge base and experience in resident care. Between them, they have been present for 11 | championship and at worst a wild card spot.

WEL-Life at Spirit Lake has been serving the community since 1999. The facility continues to improve and evolve. New carpet was recently installed and more updates are planned.

Cousins Silences Critics, For Now

Minnesota Vikings quarterback Kirk Cousins was taking a lot of heat from fans, the press and even teammates after the Vikings stumbled through their first four games with a 2-2 record, including a 16-6 loss in Chicago to the Bears in which Minnesota could only muster a late touchdown to avoid a shutout. The Vikings have made Cousins one of the highest paid quarterbacks in the NFL with a guaranteed three-year contract worth \$84 million. Many people were not pleased with the production of Cousins and the Vikings QB last season, when they missed the playoffs, and the slow start to the 2019 season did not help silence the

Cousins owned the slow start this season, even publicly apologizing to teammate Adam Thielen for not playing well and missing him on several open routes in their loss at Green Bay. Since that 2-2 start Cousins has been on fire, leading the Vikings to three straight wins, including a huge divisional 42-30 win at Detroit on Sunday. Cousins was 24-34 with a season-high 337 yards and four touchdowns and no interceptions against the Lions. During the Vikings three game winning streak Cousins has thrown for over 300 yards in each victory, throwing for a total of 976 yards with 10 touchdowns and just one interception. Cousins is also spreading the ball out amongst his receivers, as four of them had at least four catches on Sunday, and Thielen would have been the fifth had he not injured his hamstring on his amazing first quarter TD reception. It has also helped Cousins that the offense has opened up a bit more than just relying on star running back Delvin Cook as they did in the first four games. Offensive coordinator Kevin Stafinski has done a great job the last three games of incorporating more play-action passes, which has given Cousins more time to throw the ball and opened things up for the receivers as defenses have to honor the dangerous Cook, who has rushed for 725 yards and 8 touchdowns so far

Minnesota currently sits in second place in the NFC North behind 6-1 Green Bay. After what should be a very winnable game on Thursday night against 1-6 Washington, the Vikings will hit the road for two crucial games against Kansas City and Dallas. With the NFC appearing loaded this year, Minnesota will probably have to go at least 10-6 to make the playoffs as a wild card. If Cousins can remain hot, the offensive line can keep blocking, the defense can tighten up more than they did on Sunday, and the receivers can stay happy, this Vikings team has the ability to make a run at Green Bay for the conference





Kiwanians Tour The Roof Garden

Nostalgia was in full bloom for Milford Kiwanians late this summer. A regular meeting of the service club was held at the new Roof Garden ballroom and the visit was thoroughly enjoyed by all. Milford Kiwanian Joe Simington arranged for the club to tour the structure and Paul Plumb, Marketing Director for the Arnolds Park Amusement Park graciously offered to be our host while he presented a program about this new stateof-the-art facility. The original Roof Garden was built in 1923 and quickly became known as a music and dancing mecca. It maintained this popularity for many types of music, from Swing to Big Band and Rock and Roll. 

- A On July 19, 2018, in spite of public concerns and opposition to a rush deal, the Okoboji School Board voted 3 to 2 to sell the old Okoboji Middle School to the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project (now known as Imagine Iowa Great Lakes) at a price that was substantially less (\$4.8 Million less) than the properties accessed value (per Dickinson County Assessor) and estimated commercial value.
- Was there more than one bidder on the property and or other interested buyers?
- A Yes. A higher bid was submitted, and other parties
- Was the old Okoboji Middle School property nationally advertised and marketed in an effort to maximize the sales price for the benefit of the school system and District Taxpayers?
- A No. Minimal advertising was done and no significant effort to market the old Okoboji Middle School was put forth by the School Board.
- Was the old Okoboji Middle School property appraised?
- A Yes. An appraisal was obtained by the School District on January 31, 2018
- What was the appraised value?
- 🛕 The appraised value stated on January 18, 2018 was \$1.1 guarantee of value).
- What was the assessed value at the time of the sale to Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project?
- A The assessed value according to records at the Dickinson County Assessor's website was \$5,867,000 (based on the January 1, 2017 assessment cycle).
- What criteria and methodology was used by the appraiser to establish the estimated fair market value (subsequently used as the sales
- A standard boilerplate "sales comparison approach" was used consisting of seven comparable non-local properties consisting of older schools, churches and office buildings. No consideration was given to the potential commercial value of the Okoboji Middle School due to its prime location in the heart of the Iowa Great Lakes tourism zone. Additionally, no consideration was given to local sales of commercial property in the Iowa Great Lakes area.

- Did the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project (Imagine Iowa Great Lakes) intend to develop the old Okoboji Middle School property?
- A No. Based on direct discussions with representatives of the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project (Imagine Iowa Great Lakes), and in spite of the Okoboji School Boards best efforts to convince the community otherwise, the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project (Imagine Iowa Great Lakes) had no interest in owning or developing the old school building. Their only interest was in a small portion of the property bordering the road which is needed to facilitate their beautification
- If the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project (Imagine Iowa Great Lakes) only had an interest in a small portion of the total property, what was going to be done with the school building and the balance of the
- A The property was going to be re-sold (flipped) to a group of local businessmen and developed with limited or no community input or control.
- Was the proceeds from the Iowa Great Lakes Beautification Project's sale of the unwanted portion of the property going to be returned to the Okoboji Community School District and applied to pay down the \$25 MILLION SCHOOL BOND DEBT?
- million (stated by the appraiser as an estimate and not a : 🛕 In spite of certain individuals and the School Boards best efforts to convince the community that the sales proceeds would be returned to the District, there was nothing in writing supporting that assertion, and no contractual obligation requiring that the proceeds be returned to the District so that those proceeds could be used to pay down the school bond debt.
 - What is the best way to sell the old Okoboji Middle School that ensures the highest price, development and use consistent with the desires of the local community, and placement of the property on the real estate tax rolls thereby benefiting the School District as well as City and County
 - A Local business leaders are proposing that a "Community Marketing Team" be put together to market the old Okoboji Middle School property. This team would be comprised of a cross section of local community members including:

- Three experienced members of the local business community
- A local Building/Planning & Zoning Official
- A representative from the Arnolds Park City Council
- A representative from the Board of Directors of the Okoboji Community School District
- A representative from the lowa Lakes Corridor A prime focus in identification of the above team members was to ensure a comprehensive representation of local interests, as well as the expertise necessary to ensure a successful outcome.
- A Has the concept and approach described above been discussed with the Superintendent of the Okoboji Schools and presented to the School Board?
- A Yes. This concept and approach were discussed in detail on several occasions with the Superintendent of the Okoboji Community Schools who committed to present the concept to the School Board for consideration and approval. After a considerable amount of time had passed with no response, a follow up inquiry was made whereby we were told by the Superintendent that the School Board decided not to entertain the request until after the November 5, 2019 election and the voters had
- Can the Community Marketing Team specify and control how the property can be used by
- A Yes. Utilizing existing local building codes and Arnolds Park City ordinances, as well as by defining restricted uses in the bid packages and sales contract, the Community Marketing Team has the power to ensure the property will be used in a manner consistent with the best interests of the community.
- Could the old Okoboji Middle School be turned into a casino and or adult entertainment club?
- A No. Development of the property into a casino would require a special county-wide vote and approval. Additionally, as described above, bid package rules and sales contract restrictions as defined by the Community Marking Team would prevent the property from being used for that purpose. Existing Arnolds Park City Zoning Regulations prohibit the establishment of any new adult entertainment clubs within city limits without a Board of Adjustment Special Exception Use Permit.



Friday is International Artists Day, which for RD suggests the song,



At the Okoboji Foundation, we know your agricultural roots extend into support of the community in which you live, and it is important to you as a farmer to meet your family's charitable and financial goals. Below are a few unique ways you can support causes and communities you care about as we near the end of the year. **GRAIN-** A gift of grain is a unique and under utilized way to make a charitable gift. For farm operators, gifting grain directly, rather than selling the grain and making a gift from the proceeds, may provide significant tax savings. Contributing grain allows you to avoid recognizing the sale of the commodity

as income, while the production costs may still be deductible. Reducing taxable income may provide advantages such as minimizing or eliminating selfemployment tax and reducing adjusted gross income. **IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER-** For farmers over age 70 ½, making charitable contributions from an IRA can provide similar tax advantages to a gift of grain. Distributions from an IRA directly to charity avoids federal and state income tax on transfers up to

\$100,000 and goes towards meeting your required minimum distribution (RMD). No need to worry if you don't itemize your federal tax return. Gifts of grain and the IRA charitable rollover are not deductible, but instead benefit from the avoidance of claiming the

Donor advised funds are a solution to this problem. Donor advised funds are like a charitable checkbook. Farmers can contribute cash, stock, grain or other assets to their donor advised fund, take advantage of maximum tax benefits, and distribute grants to causes they care about when needs arise. A donor advised fund can also help your family put charitable dollars aside for a rainy day when your farm may not be as profitable but your commitment to your community has not changed. National Drug Take Back Day

National Drug Take Back Day is October 26, and the Iowa State University Extension and Outreach office reminds everyone to safely dispose of unused or

expired medications. Most people who misuse prescription drugs get them from family, friends and ac-

quaintances. "You can make a difference

by keeping track of the medicine you have, by rethinking where

and how you keep your medications in your home, and by safely disposing of any unused medications," said Sue Boettcher, Human Sciences Program Coordinator with ISU Extension and Outreach. Additional tips provided by Boettcher include:

* Don't Share. Keep track of your legally prescribed controlled substances - that is, count your pills so you always know how much you should have and so you know when to take action if any go missing. With controlled substances, sharing is NOT caring. You could be putting your loved ones at risk, and unintentionally contribute to drug misuse, drug addiction, or a fatal drug overdose.

* Limit Access. Everyone knows to keep medicine "out of the reach of children" but once your children become teens, there's a good chance they can "reach" all medicines in your home and they know exactly where you keep what. Many people keep their medicine in easy to reach, easy to access cupboards, medicine cabinets, drawers, etc., so put your medicine somewhere that only you can easily find and access. Lock it up if you can. This will keep your medicine from unintentionally ending up in the wrong hands and just may save someone's life.

Where can you "take back" your unwanted/unused drugs? The Spirit Lake Police Department will be at the Spirit Lake Hy-Vee from 10:00am to 2:00pm on Saturday, October 26. There are also drop-off boxes available year-round at Lewis Family Drug, Hy-Vee Pharmacy and at the west entrance of the Dickinson County Courthouse.







Cookies & Cream Donuts

142 teaspoons white vinegar

1 cup all purpose flour 1/4 cup unsweetened dark cocoa powder

1/2 teaspoon baking soda Pinch of salt

1/2 cup granulated sugar 1/4 cup unsweetened applesauce 1/4 teaspoons vegetable oil 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 12 chocolate cookies, crushed

(such as Oreos) 1 can of vanilla frosting

Preheat oven to 350°F. Spray a 6-count donut pan with nonstick cooking spray. Pour the vinegar into a 42 cup measure. Add enough milk to come to the brim. Let sit until thick, 5-10 minutes. In a bowl, whisk the flour, cocoa powder, baking soda, and salt. In a large bowl, mix the sugar, applesauce, oil, and vanilla. Add the flour mixture


and mix until smooth. Add the milk mixture and mix for 1 minute more. Add half of the crushed cookies. Scoop the batter into the prepared donut pan, filling 3/4 full. Bake 10 to 15 minutes. Let cool before frosting. Microwave uncovered frosting for 5-second intervals, until soft. Frost each donut and sprinkle the remaining cookies.
