Sidari connected with Grieco after reaching out to dancing department at Brockport State College. Grieco was the first Brockport student to work as an


in Japanese. "I'm very, very excited," she said at Gotta Dance last week.

DA says state's new bail reform puts public safety at risk

ALBION — Jan. 1 will bring significant changes to the local criminal justice system as local judges will no longer be able to put people in jail on bail for many felony

The state is taking away discretion for judges in setting bail in non-violent felonies, said Joe Cardone, Orleans County district attorney. Judges will be releasing most people facing felonies on their own recognizance, with an appearance ticket for an upcoming court date. Judges can hold people in jail if they are charged with murder, violating orders of protection, rape and child pornography. Some felonies, such as second-degree manslaughter, illegal drug possession and sales, even second-degree robbery and second-degree burglary won't have options for bail.

"We're concerned about the safety of the people in our county and their safety being compromised," Cardone told local officials last week during a meeting of the Orleans County Association of Municipalities. "Come Jan. 1, we will literally be opening the doors to our jail and releasing them. I don't understand the rationale. People being victimized will see the perpetrators on the streets." Cardone said he expects to see the jail population cut in half on Jan. 1. The county jail currently has a capacity for 82 inmates.

Cardone said the state has swung the pendulum from protecting victims of crimes to the accused. Not only are there significant legislative changes, but the state is pouring millions of dollars into public defender's offices, while offering no aid increases for the district attorney's offices. The local Crime Victim's Office is seeing its state funding cut from about \$98,000 annually to \$58,000.

Cardone, the county DA since March 1992, said the community will be alarmed next year to see people facing serious charges out in the community, outside of jail. "This is not anything the local law enforcement or District Attorney's Office is on favor of," Cardone said. "But it's something we have to deal with."

The DA said some time in jail can sometimes diffuse situations, often in the cases of domestic violence or drug addiction. The county jail staff will often work to connect people to treatment facilities, rather than just releasing them without help lined up.

"Unfortunately they may be sticking needles in their arms within minutes," Cardone said. "I fully expect our opioid overdoses will go dramatically up. Jail can be a great vehicle to get people help."

As part of the criminal justice reform, law enforcement officers also need to get the contact information for those charged with crimes, and guarantee they will be contacted with reminders about upcoming court dates wither by text, email, a phone call or through registered mail. If the person doesn't show up for court, a judge needs assurance the person was contacted before issuing a warrant for an arrest. Those charged with crimes also have a right to return to the alleged crime scene, where a house may have been broken into or a person sexually assaulted.

The State Legislature and Gov. Cuomo approved the changes as part of the state budget adoption. Cardone said there weren't any hearings about the criminal justice changes, and the state didn't provide more funding for law enforcement, district attorney's offices or probation.

"I'm very concerned," Cardone said about the impending changes. "This will forever change the landscape of our society." The county estimates it will cost the DA's Office and Probation each an additional \$180,000 annually to meet the new requirements, and that will be paid for by local taxpayers. Cardone's office faces changes in the discovery statutes. DA's currently have 45 days to turn over all documents and body cam video. That will be reduced to 15 days. That includes lab results.

The DA's Office also needs to provide the defense a list of witnesses and confidential informants, including their addresses. Cardone said that will discourage people from coming forward as witnesses or informants. The DA said he will seek orders of protection for people who are informants or witnesses.

He said he worries if all the information isn't provided to the defense by 15 days from an arrest, the defense attorneys will seek to dismiss the cases. Some of the information, such as lab results, are outside

the DA's and law enforcement's control. The new laws also allow a bail hearing every 30 days, for those who are in jail. If people aren't in jail, then may head out of state, or to Canada or Mexico. The county typically pays to have three to five people extradited from outside to the area to appear in court in Orleans County. Cardone expects that number will rise now that fewer people will be held in jail. "We can't absorb that cost," he said about extraditions.

The county also will need to create a pretrial agency "to make sure we're not keeping people in jail who shouldn't be in jail." Cardone said the state hasn't provided any standards for the pretrial agency. "You add all this together and we have a great amount of concern over this," Cardone said.

District attorneys and law enforcement officials from throughout the state have expressed their concerns to public safety over the new regulations. But Cardone said the state isn't backing off. "It's a train that's not going to get stopped in my opinion," Cardone said. "There is not much chance of stopping this before Jan. 1."

Dale Root says he would bring needed change to Shelby Highway Department

Editor:

Shelby voters, Nov. 5 is around the corner and I would like to remind you how important your voice and vote are for our small town of Shelby. I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself in case you do not know me.

I am Dale S. Root, the Republican and Conservative endorsed candidate running for Shelby Highway Superintendent. I am a 40-year resident of Shelby. Husband to Helen, father to Kathy, Jess and Joe. Proud grandfather of Haylie, Lexi, Major, Barrett and Owen.

With my wife, we are co-owners of Dale S. Root Trucking LLC and Dale S. Root Farms LLC, two vertically integrated businesses that my daughter Jessica and son Joe will be taking over at the end of this year.

I will be retiring and stepping down from the day-to-day operation. I have sound business experience in budgeting, labor management, a good knowledge of machinery and truck maintenance. I know I will be able to give the Town of Shelby a new and much-needed perspective as the highway superintendent. As a business owner, I know what it takes to do more and work with less.

A few issues I have come across that I would like to see changed:

- Repair a fractured relationship between the highway superintendent and the Town Board. When elected, I will work together with the Town Board to analyze issues and create a plausible plan.
- The Town of Shelby should incorporate the use of our local Iroquois Job Corps, and the Sheriff's Prison worker program. Both of these programs are free and come with supervision, which will free up town personnel to do much needed service on the water districts, road and machinery maintenance, etc. Individuals from these programs would be able to mow and maintain the cemeteries along with roadside cleanup.
- Water meter reading issue. We as taxpayers are paying the town twice to read the meters. Each water district has a \$6.75 per meter fee allocated for meter reading that is paid to the appointed water supervisor (highway superintendent), but the meters are read by a town employee at the hourly wage of \$25.78. At times, two employees are on the job at the superintendent's orders. This costs the taxpayer the meter fee of \$6.75 (that goes to the water supervisor) plus the two employees' hourly wage. I would work with the town employees to find a fair solution.
- The town purchased a \$30,000 GPS system four years ago to map all the water districts, main valves and hydrants so in case the need arises. This would give fire personnel, town employees, or contractors have precise coordinates. Currently, this system is not being used. It is sitting idle in the highway building. It would be a good resource to have all junctions, fire hydrants, valves marked out for local fire companies and highway workers.
- I will opt out of the pension program saving the town \$4,000 in annual contributions.

These are a few things I have discovered in a short period of time, mostly from reading the budgets. These are really not Town Board issues. They represent some of the mismanagement of the current highway superintendent.

We need to save tax payer money – there is plenty to work with within the annual budget.

I would like to enterprise some aspects of the town's jobs to see how much is spent. One thing would be to corral compensated overtime hours. In the month of July, basically no one was working as they were all awarded vacation days at the same time. So if you wonder why little was fixed on the roads – you now know.

Currently there are 4 full-time employees and 2 part-time employees. Within the last few weeks there has been a budget request for another part-time employee to mow – I do not believe we need 3. The current part-time employees are used for mowing. On days that are not suitable for mowing they are still allowed to come in, given hours for other odd jobs that are made up for them taking work away from the 4 full-time employees.

In the last 9 months the people that live on East Shelby Road have had three water main ruptures due to the line not being bedded on sand. The current superintendent was the lead inspector on the line. This is not the area to try and cut funds to save money. Do the job right the first time.

As a business owner for 35-plus years, I have learned how important it is to be well organized, and available to all. You cannot expect your workers to excel in the job if the tools and ideas are not put in place.

I will be accessible to all Shelby residents, day or night, that have concerns or issues they may see. I will respond to the issues once I have received all the facts and take action in a timely manner.

On the farm we need to "make hay when the sun shines," I do not see where "hay" was made while the sun shined in the Town of Shelby this year. Change can be scary, but change is also good.

I ask for your vote and support on Nov. 5.

My name is Ed Pillard. I am not a resident of Shelby. In fact, my wonderful wife, Jan, and I live in Vero Beach, Fla. For the last 10 years, Jan and I have been friends of Dale and Helen Root. I want to tell you how we became friends because I think those reasons are the same reasons that you should vote for Dale.

To start, I'd like to tell you a little about myself so you know that we probably share many of the same morals and ideals, and to show that I have some experience in understanding and evaluating people. I am the son of a school teacher. I was brought up as a small child in Nichols, NY and Morrisville, NY. My family then moved to Elmira, NY where I attended middle and high school. After only a few days of residence, Dale and Helen had befriended all of the guards in the community to the point that they had a better relationship with the guards than any of the permanent residents, including me. A lesson taught by the character of Dale and Helen.

Next, Helen starts making her outstanding apple crisp, and she and Dale make sure the guards are supplied regularly. Please understand that the guards were never in any position to do any favors for the Roots. They already had free access to the property because of their lease with us. So, the nice things the Roots were doing for the guards were not for personal benefit. They were doing them because of the great people they are. I was getting feedback from the guards telling me that the Roots were the best people that have ever rented in our community.

Then comes Thanksgiving. The Roots cooked Thanksgiving dinner for the guards and made sure that at least two of the daily shifts are fed. The stories of this kindness on their part continued. It wasn't just the apple crisp and Thanksgiving dinner. It was just the way they treated and respected others. It was pretty obvious they were special people I wanted to get to know.

After the first time we rented our property to the Roots, I got a call from the house cleaner that we had hired to clean our property after each rental. She asked "What do you want me to do?". I was surprised by this because she had done this cleaning work for us several times before. The question came because the Roots had left the place so clean, dusted, vacuumed, laundry done, beds changed, dishwasher even emptied, that she had nothing to do. That cost me \$150 for nothing because the Roots treated my property like their own. Just like I imagine Dale will treat your roads. I never arranged for a cleaner again after the Roots were in the property. Nor did I ever ask them for a security deposit to cover damage. My property was always in better shape when they left than when the came

Jan and I rented to the Roots for 3 years until I sold the property. I was the most unpopular person in the community when the staff found out that I wouldn't be renting to the Roots anymore.

Another example of Dale's kindness was that as a little boy in Nichols, NY, I would walk past a John Deere dealer on Main Street every day. There were small metal models of the tractors for sale in the storefront window. I could never afford to buy one, but I never forgot them. I mentioned this memory to Dale and Helen once. Dale asked me if I would like one of those models now. I laughed and said no but thanked him. The next time they visited Vero Beach, Dale brought me a the best John Deere baseball cap ever. I wear it all the time. This was well after I had sold my property. He did this because that's who he is.

Over the last several years, Jan and I have seen the Roots about once a year. Dale and I text or call probably about once a month. To call us best friends would be a misrepresentation. But, the reason for that is because of our physical separation. If we were a resident of Shelby, Dale and Helen would be our best friends. They have exhibited nothing more than the best of human character with the highest values and ethics I have seen in my 70 years of life.

I can't imagine that anyone would be more committed to do a great job for you as Highway Superintendent than Dale with Helen's support. And don't you believe that Helen's support doesn't matter.

I believe in Dale as a great person, with the character, values and ethics that you need from your elected officials. You can't go wrong supporting him and voting for him. You can count on him.

Did You Know?

Brief breaks during the work day can dramatically improve one's ability to focus on a task. A 2011 study published in the journal Cognition found that brief mental breaks can improve focus on a prolonged task. The study's authors tested participants' ability to focus on a repetitive computerized task for 50 minutes under various conditions. The control group performed the task without breaks or diversions. The switch group and nonswitch group memorized four digits before performing the task and were directed to respond if they saw one of the digits on the screen while performing the task. The switch group was the only group to be presented with the digits twice during the experiment, and both groups were tested on their memory of the digits at the end of the task. Most participants' performance declined considerably over the course of the 50-minute task. However, the performance of those in the switch group did not decline at all, as the two brief breaks to respond to the digits allowed them to maintain their focus throughout the experiment. The researchers behind the study concluded that the switch group's performance was steady because the brain is built to detect and respond to change, and its performance will actually suffer if it must maintain prolonged attention on a single task without taking a break. Professionals with a lot on their plates may see their performance improve by taking frequent mental breaks throughout the workday.






