Her husband died seven years ago, and that year there was only one tree that displayed the benevolent work her family had done in his name.

"It was special, and it was exactly what we needed that year," she said.

The next year, she started back decorating multiple trees, each with a theme close to her and her family's hearts.

The number of trees increased. And increased. But Ashlev never had a number of trees in mind. In fact, she's not sure how she wound up with 60 this year, the most ever.

"I'd just have an idea or I'd see some little something that I liked and I'd build a theme around it with a tree," she said, joking that

her emoji tree fills the niche for humor and is of great interest to many young visitors.

The range of themes is vast. There's a movie tree, a red bird tree, a western tree, a jungle tree and a sentimental patriotic tree with family military photos.

There's a tree that features the Wizard of Oz and an ice tree with all wintry ornaments. There's a snowman tree, a candy and gingerbread tree, a laundry tree with Santa's clothing, and an Alabama Crimson Tide

There is no Auburn tree, although she insists she acknowledges that Auburn is a part of Alabama.

"I just don't have a need for an Auburn tree," she joked.

She has a Santa tree,

and her favorite of the themed trees, the Bethlehem tree.

"I'm not specifically celebrating the birthday of Christ necessarily, as we don't know exactly when it was," she said. "I celebrate that every day of my life – his birth, death and resurrection."

Every room of her sprawling home has trees.

"No part of my house is off limits to my trees, even my bathrooms," she said.

She begins decorating the week before Halloween. Along with her helper, Gary Rhodes, who brings in all the Christmas trees and their individually stored ornaments, she begins the process of assembling her own personal Christmas village.







"Gary does all the mechanics of getting the trees together and I have a lot of furniture that has to move out of my house to accommodate them," she said. "We pretty much have it down now. I've made a joke that I may have 75 next year, but really, who knows?"

Ashley said her fascination with trees really stepped up about 20 years ago when she and Charlie would travel and see trees she really

liked.

"We'd just buy it and load it up," she said.

She said for her children, Freddie, Billy and Alyssa, her Christmas indulgence is just part of their family life. Her two daughtersin-law jumped right in with the family tradition and assist with the decorating as their work schedules allow.

"My kids and their families love it, too, and their co-workers and friends have always attended parties here and it just seems to make people happy," she said.

Her favorite tree, the revolving family tree, has a special place in her bedroom and is topped with her wedding picture. Below are photos of her family and special family keepsakes.

The trees in her bedroom are the only ones she ever turns off, she said, adding that the



others simply stay on for simplicity sake.

"Sometimes at night I put on my pajamas and just gaze at them," she said. "It's such a peaceful time."

The transformation of her home at Christmas is about interaction with people, and not to show off, she insists.

"I just like to see people smile and enjoy things in life," she said. "Oh, I could choose to go other ways and I know this is a lot of work for a short period of time but it's not the length of time that's important, it's the memories you collect."

Ashley's friend and Atlas Church of Christ preacher Miles Stutts said that in his mind, "Mrs. Lucy is

Christmastime."

"I've never known anyone love Christmas like she does and carry out such a passion for seeing other people happy," Stutts said. "She's so giving and loving. She's truly one of a kind."



INGREDIENTS:

- 1 (3 to 4 pound) center cut pork loin
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 1 tsp dried rosemary
- salt and pepper, to taste

- 10 slices bacon, uncooked
- 1/4 cup whole cranberry sauce
- 1 Tbsp dijon mustard
- 2 Tbsp orange juice
- 1 tsp orange zest

DIRECTIONS:

Combine brown sugar, garlic powder, rosemary, salt and pepper.

Season pork loin with brown sugar mixture on all sides.

Wrap bacon around pork loin and place in slow cooker.

Mix together cranberry sauce, dijon mustard, orange juice and orange zest. Pour over pork loin.

Cover and cook on LOW 2-1/2 to 3 hours, until internal temperature is 145°F.

Remove pork from slow cooker and place on an oven safe baking sheet. Place under oven broiler for 2 to 3 minutes to crisp up bacon.



FILLING:

- 2 cups shredded extra sharp cheddar cheese
- 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup mayo
- 1/4 tsp garlic powder
- 1/4 tsp cayenne pepper
- 1/4 tsp onion powder

PASTRY CUPS:

- 9 ounces of cream cheese, softened
- 1 stick butter, softened
- 3 cups of self-rising flour

- 1-4oz jar diced pimento, drained
- Salt/pepper to taste
- Mix all ingredients with a stand mixer until well blended
- Use as filling in the homemade pastry cups

DIRECTIONS:

Mix in stand mixture to form dough. Sprinkle board with flour, pinch into quarter size balls and roll flat. Press into sprayed mini muffin pan and bake at 350 until golden brown, about 10 minutes.

Fill cups with pimento cheese mixture and top with red pepper jelly. Place in oven until cheese is melted. Let cool and serve!

INGREDIENTS:

- 6 assorted apples
- 6 eggs
- 4 quarts of broken yeast rolls
- ½ quart of heavy cream
- 1 cup milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 Tbsp ground cinnamon
- ½ tsp ground nutmeg
- 1 Tbsp salt
- 1 cup brown sugar

DIRECTIONS:

Heat oven to 350, prepare baking pan with parchment paper and coat with cooking spray (or butter).

Peel and dice apples, then take half and season with brown sugar, cinnamon, and salt. Place seasoned apples in the over for about 15 minutes to soften.

Combine all ingredients, except for the eggs and seasoned apples, in a mixing bowl. When mixture is thoroughly mixed add eggs and mix until just combined.

Take half of the batter and cover the bottom of the pan with it. Distribute half of the baked apples on top of the batter and then add the rest of the batter on top. Distribute the remaining seasoned apples on top of the batter and bake in the oven for about 35 minutes.

CARAMEL SAUCE:

- 1 ½ cup unsalted butter
- 3 cups light brown sugar, packed tight
- 4 Tbsp water
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 Tbsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp salt

DIRECTIONS:

Add butter, brown sugar, salt, and water to a small saucepan over medium-high heat. Stir mixture until just combined. Heat mixture without stirring until sugar melts completely (very hot!)

When sugar has completely melted add heavy cream. Caution: heavy cream will boil vigorously. Be Careful. Stir in slowly until cream is fully incorporated. Remove from heat. Caramel will thicken as it cools.

FILLING:

- 1 pound peeled, medium-size shrimp (50/60)
- 3 cups chicken broth
- ½ tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp ground red pepper
- 1 cup uncooked regular grits

- ½ cup butter
- 3 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 red bell pepper, diced
- 1 cup fine, dry breadcrumbs
- 1 cup chopped green onions
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 325. Devein shrimp, if desired.

Bring broth and next 2 ingredients to a boil in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Whisk in grits, and return to a boil; reduce heat to low, and stir in butter. Cover and simmer, stirring occasionally, 10 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat.

Stir together eggs and next 4 ingredients in a large bowl. Gradually stir about one-fourth of hot grits mixture into egg mixture; add egg mixture to remaining hot grits mixture, stirring constantly. Stir in shrimp until blended. Pour grits mixture into a lightly greased 11x7 inch baking dish.

Bake at 325 for 55 minutes to 1 hour or until mixture is set. Let stand 10 minutes.






- 8 oz. cream cheese, room temperature

Lovely jewelry, impressive art, table décor for every occasion, charming apparel - oh, and you can also get wedding invitations, fine stationery, office supplies and furniture, and business machines under the same roof.

Locals who walk down Court Street are used to seeing the downtown mainstay business, PSI Printers & Stationers.

What may surprise some longtime residents is the variety of merchandise inside that has nothing to do with outfitting an office.

"We have such a wonderful department store atmosphere with all this space," said PSI's Sandra Johnson. She said the company, still family owned and has been in Florence since 1933, has seen downtown bloom with returning

businesses and with the University of North Alabama thriving.

"We thought: why not bring in apparel? Why not bring in gifts?" she said.

With printing part of its business, PSI already catered to special occasion invitations like for weddings and anniversaries. But when the merchandise was extended to include items for home décor, apparel, and unique gifts, PSI grew its customer base beyond what locals expect to find there.

"Most of the locals in town . . . think of us as office supplies," Johnson said. "We have more out-of-town customers – repeat customers - from literally all over the nation that are here for Shindig or ShoalsFest or Arts Alive, or one of our

festivals, and we're the place that they want to come visit.

"We're so thrilled to be doing this, because we are this little gem in the area that most of the locals don't even know about."

She said out-of-town visitors tell her they love PSI because it's so unique and because "we have a little bit of everything."

"This industry . . . printing and office supplies . . . has evolved," she said. "Then, you have the internet in particular, and of course you have the big box stores, (but) those didn't really phase us that much, but the internet has. We have been going to these (industry) meetings for years - my dad and my mom went before us - and we have seen so many mom and pop businesses like ours close. And we're one of just a few, really, in the nation, who are still thriving. We have reinvented ourselves over the years. And we've got such a great team. It's such a family affair. We all work really hard, and it works."
