





## **Dear Mount Morris Community,**

I am pleased to share that this weekend, Governor Cuomo signed a bill stopping a State takeback of aid associated with the building project from 2000. Our bill, ending the state aid reduction, passed with bipartisan support from both the New York State Senate and Assembly. I am extremely grateful to Senator Gallivan and Assemblywoman Byrnes for both sponsoring and shepherding our bill through their respective chambers. To provide some background, I have included a community communication from last year that went out through our messaging system and also appeared in our June 2018 Bridges newsletter. It is great that this issue is behind us, and this new law will further strengthen our long-term fiscal outlook.

#### June 2018 Bridges Article: Important Financial Update

Some news outlets recently ran a story about a state aid reduction for the Mount Morris Central School District. This issue originated sixteen years ago and resurfaced in the 2012-2013 school year when the state held back \$236,220 in aid as part of the late filing of a Final Cost Report by the District associated with the completion of the capital project in 2000. This holdback of aid was the first in a series of scheduled holdbacks associated with the filing of this Final Cost Report in 2012.

I first learned of this issue when I was a candidate for the position of School Superintendent. My assessment of the situation and analysis of the circumstances was that the District's plan and financial outlook was strong despite the scheduled takeback of state aid. I knew things could only get better. In my first Bridges article, back in 2015, I provided an update on the 2000 Capital Project regarding the reduction in aid the District received associated with this project.

Within my first few weeks in the District, I was able to meet with Senator Young to discuss the state aid takeback. She was aware of our situation and indicated that this was something that had impacted numerous districts throughout the state. Over the years, Senator Young has helped pass state budgets that provide Mount Morris with state aid increases that are among the highest in the region and has secured reductions in the withholding of state aid for districts like ours. This support has helped offset the impact of the state aid takeback. The recent news story indicates that the Senate has again passed legislation to assist districts who have been impacted by these state aid takebacks.

Our financial position today is the strongest it has been in many years resulting in a 2018–19 tax levy increase of zero. We have been able to overcome this fiscal challenge, expand our programs and increase opportunities for our students. Below are some of our new and restored programs.

# PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

We all know that it can be difficult to fit physical activity into our busy lifestyles. It is important to make it a priority. Physical activity allows us to maintain a healthy lifestyle and reduce the risk of many preventable diseases such as heart disease, diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, obesity, osteoporosis in women, and some types of cancer such as colon, prostate and breast cancer. People who are in good physical condition tend to live longer, healthier lives than those who are not active.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that adults get at least 2 hours and 30 minutes (150 minutes) of moderate-intensity aerobic physical activity a week, as well as muscle strengthening activities on 2 or more days a week. It is best to spread your activity out during the week, this way you can break it up into smaller sections of time, making it easier to fit into your schedule.

Some ideas to increase physical actitivity include:

- Wake up 30 minutes earlier than you normally do and use the extra time to walk on your treadmill or take a brisk walk around your neighborhood.
- Make your household chores count by working fast enough to get your heart pumping when mopping floors, scrubbing the shower or vacuuming.
- Outdoor lawn work such as push mowing the lawn, raking, and gardening can also be physical activity.
- Be active while watching TV. Use hand weights, walk on the treadmill, use the stationary bike, or do a stretching routine.
- Get the whole family involved. Take family walks or hikes together. Play catch or go for a bike ride together.
- · Take the dog for a walk.
- Join a club or team. Hiking, dancing, or sports teams and clubs are great way to get physically active.
- Join your local fitness club and sign up for exercise classes.
- Take the stairs whenever possible.
- Start a lunchtime walking group with your co-workers.
- Schedule your workout or physical activities just like any other appointments that you might have and stick to it.

# A Focus on Prevention for National Diabetes Awareness Month

During National Diabetes Awareness Month, the Livingston County Department of Health is encouraging residents to learn their risks for prediabetes and type 2 diabetes, and to take preventive steps to potentially reduce their chances of developing the disease.

Statistics for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) show that one in four Americans (86 million people) have prediabetes, up from 79 million in 2010. Prediabetes is a condition in which a person's blood glucose is elevated, but not high enough for a diabetes diagnosis. Only 10 percent of those with prediabetes know they have it but with awareness and simple actions, people with prediabetes may prevent the onset of diabetes.

"The Livingston County Department of Health works with community partners to provide education on risk factors and to encourage screening regarding diabetes to improve the health of our residents", stated Jennifer Rodriquez, Public Health Director.

Lifestyle choices and family history help determine the ultimate risk for developing the disease. Several factors that could put a person at risk for type 2 diabetes include race, age, weight, and activity level. If a person is at risk, a diabetes screening conducted by a physician can confirm a diabetes or prediabetes diagnosis. Making some basic lifestyle changes that contribute to weight loss and healthy living can decrease the risk for type 2 diabetes. Among these are:

- Eat fruits and vegetables every day.
- Choose fish, lean meats and poultry without skin.
- Aim for whole grains with every meal.
- Be moderately active at least 30 minutes per day five days a week.
- Choose water to drink instead of beverages with added sugar.

# **Fall Prevention Awareness**

Among older adults, falls are the leading cause of injury deaths, unintentional injuries, and hospital admissions for trauma. Falls can take a serious toll on older adults' quality of life and independence.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends the following to significantly reduce the risk of falling:

- Speak Up Talk openly with your medical provider, family members and friends about falling or a fear of falling.
- Review Medications With your doctor, have your medications reviewed to identify any that cause dizziness. See whether taking vitamin D supplements is right for you to improve your bone, muscle, and nerve health.
- Check your footwear— Wear properly fitting, sturdy shoes with nonskid soles.
- Keep Moving Find activities and exercises that improve strength, mobility, and balance. Consider joining a falls prevention class in your community, such as Tai Chi, Bone Builders or other courses.
- Check Your Eyes Have your vision checked once a year and update your glasses as needed.
- Make Your Home Safe Most falls happen at home. Keep your floors clutter free, remove or secure small rugs, add grab bars to bathrooms, have handrails and lights installed near all staircases, and make sure your home is well-lit. Be careful of pets that get underfoot.


