## COCONUT CASHEW BRITTLE

## Ingredients

- 2 tablespons plus 1 cup butter, divided
- 2 cups cashew halves
- 2 cups sweetened shredded coconut
- 2 cups sugar
- $\quad 1$ cup light corn syrup
- $1 / 2$ cup plus 1 teaspoon water, divided
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- $1-1 / 2$ teaspoons baking soda


## Directions

1. Butter two $15 \times 10 \times 1-i n$. pans with 1 tablespoon butter each; set aside.
2. Combine cashews and coconut on a third $15 \times 10 \times 1$-in. baking pan. Bake at $350^{\circ}$ for $8-10$ minutes or until golden brown, stirring occasionally.
3. In a large heavy saucepan, combine the sugar, corn syrup and 1/2 cup water. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture comes to a boil. Add remaining butter; cook and stir until butter is melted. Continue cooking, without stirring, until a candy thermometer reads $300^{\circ}$ (hard-crack stage).
4. Meanwhile, combine the vanilla, baking soda and remaining water. Remove saucepan from the heat; add cashews and coconut. Add baking soda mixture; stir until light and foamy. Quickly pour onto prepared baking sheets. Spread with a buttered metal spatula to $1 / 4$-in. thickness. Cool before breaking into pieces. Store in an airtight container.

## LIME-IN-THE-COCONUT ALMOND BARK

## Ingredients

- 1 package (10 to 12 ounces) white baking chips
- 4 teaspoons shortening
- 2 to 4 drops green food coloring, optional
- $\quad 1 / 2$ cup sweetened shredded coconut, toasted
- $1 / 2$ cup chopped almonds, toasted
- 4 teaspoons grated lime zest



## Directions

1. Line a $9-i n$. square baking pan with foil; set aside. In a microwave, melt chips and shortening; stir until smooth. Stir in food coloring if desired. Stir in the coconut, almonds and lime zest. Spread into prepared pan. Chill until firm, 10-15 minutes.
2. Break into small pieces. Store in an airtight container at room temperature.

 PECANS
## Ingredients

- 35 saltines
- 1 cup butter, cubed
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 cups (12 ounces) semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup chopped pecans,
 toasted

1. Preheat oven to $350^{\circ}$. Line a $15 \times 10 \times 1$-in. baking pan with foil; grease foil. Arrange saltines in a single layer on foil.
2. In a large heavy saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Stir in brown sugar. Bring to a boil; cook and stir 3-4 minutes or until sugar is dissolved. Spread evenly over crackers.
3. Bake 8-10 minutes or until bubbly. Immediately sprinkle with chocolate chips. Allow chips to soften for a few minutes, then spread over top. Sprinkle with pecans. Cool slightly.
4. Refrigerate, uncovered, 1 hour or until set. Break into pieces. Store in an airtight container.

## POLAR BEAR PAWS

## Ingredients

- 1 (11 ounce) bag Kraft Caramel Bits or squares
- 3 tablespoons heavy whipping cream
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 cup peanuts, roasted and/or cocktail
- 12 ounces vanilla almond bark or white melting wafers


## Directions

1. Line a large cookie sheet with Silpat mats (or parchment paper) and grease it with butter. Set aside.

2. Melt caramels with butter and cream in the microwave in 30 second increments, stirring, and repeating until smooth.
3. Mix in the peanuts and then let it sit in the bowl to cool for about 15 minutes, stirring every few minutes.
4. Spoon onto the mats in tablespoon size mounds. Place in the fridge for 30-60 minutes until set.
5. Place chocolate in a bowl and melt in the microwave on low in 30 second increments and stir until melted and smooth. Dip caramel cluster in the chocolate and use a fork to remove it. Holding it over the bowl, tap the fork on the edge to let any excess chocolate drip back down.


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Place cluster back on the parchment lined pan and repeat with remaining clusters.
6. Put the pan back in the fridge for 30-60 mintues until chocolate is set. Remove and package up.

## BUTTERSCOTCH SQUARES

## Ingredients

- 2 cups brown sugar
- $\quad 3 / 4$ cup heavy whipping cream
- 6 tablespoons butter
- $1 / 2$ teaspoon vanilla
- $1 / 4$ teaspoon salt
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 16 ounces melting chocolate for dipping such as Candiquik or almond bark


## Directions

## 1. Line a $9 \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ pan with foil and spray with

 cooking spray.Place brown sugar, cream, and butter in a saucepan over medium-high heat. Stir until melted. Bring to a rolling boil, then reduce heat to low and place a candy thermometer in the pot.
3. mixture reaches 2360, about 7-8 minutes. Turn off heat and stir in vanilla and salt. Whisk in powdered sugar. Pour into prepared pan and allow to set at room temperature (a few hours, but this can be done the day ahead).
4. large kitchen knife and cut the square into quarters. From here, use small cuts to cut them into small squares.

Be sure to use small but swift cuts. The candy is fragile and is prone to flaking and breaking, so a quick cut will make the candy stay together.
6. Melt chocolate according to package directions and dip each square, tapping off excess. Place on a wax paper lined cookie sheet and chill to set.

## Hello Gardeners!

We are so proud of-and thankful for-all you folks who showed up for Ozark's Make a Difference Day, cleaning up gardens and landscaping around public buildings and churches. It's always wonderful to work together in community work; the rain only dampened things a little bit. Many thanks especially for Sardis Baptist church who fed everyone so well.


December is upon us, and already we've gotten through some freezing temperatures. And now to get our fruit trees and cold sensitive plants through the winter. Mulching with pine straw or wood chips can help retain moisture, but to protect against several hours of below freezing temperatures in the Wiregrass area, cover your sensitive plants with a breathable cover like a sheet or frost cloth. Plastic is not recommended; it will cause freeze burn on the leaves.

The SOW app says you can plant ONE thing in December: STRAWBERRIES
