





Metallic Postcard

Postcards are among the most popular inexpensive collectibles today, perhaps because they are easy to find. But they require time and searching to create a special collection. Postcards are wanted for the postmark, the stamp, the message or the picture on the front, and they can be framed and hung or displayed in scrapbooks.



This postcard, with a divided back for the address and a message, is printed in metallic gold. The Thanksgiving turkey is a raised metal addition. It's rare and by an unknown maker.

Although an English postcard was mailed as early as 1840, the first U.S. postcard wasn't printed until 1873. The earliest picture postcards mailed in the U.S. probably were cards sold at the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago in 1893. A printed stamp was used on early postal cards by the U.S. Post Office. A rectangular stamp was glued onto a souvenir postage card, bought and mailed by tourists. The required postage changed 21 times between 1872 and 2000, going from 1 cent to 21 cents. Today it is 35 cents.

Collectors also can date a card from its design. The "divided back" era began in 1907. "Linen" cards that had texturized paper for better color printing were popular from 1931 to 1959. "Chrome" era postcards featuring Kodachrome photographs started in 1939. The craze for collecting postcards began in 1946, and there were

clubs, stores, sales and research for collectors buying postcards.

This unusual card, featuring the side of an attached metal turkey, seems great for a Thanksgiving message, but the raised turkey would not allow it to go in the mail. It's part of a group of cards that have strange attached or moving parts known as "mechanicals." It also has a divided back, suggesting a date as early as 1907. The postcard has an old price tag of \$20.

I bought a green Thanksgiv-• ing plate at an auction and am curious to see its value. A colonial couple is pictured on the front, and underneath it says: "Speak for yourself, John." There are four other scenes around the border. The back of the platter has a picture of pilgrims, and underneath it says: "Pilgrim Exiles" and "Colonial Times by Crown Ducal, England." Can you help?

• Crown Ducal is used on some A pieces of porcelain made by A.G. Richardson and Co., Ltd., of Tunstall and Cobridge, England, beginning in 1916. The Colonial Times series was made in the early 1930s. It includes 12 different designs and was made in several colors, including blue, brown, green, mulberry and pink. Plates were made with scalloped or smooth edges. A square plate also was made. Colonial Times plates sell for \$25 to \$50.





LLE NAMED AMONG TOP DIGITAL CITIES

CENTER FOR DIGITAL GOVERNMENT



The City of Danville has been named by the Center for Digital Government as one of the top cities with populations up to 75,000 for its use of technology.

In its 2019 Digital Cities Survey, the center ranked Danville second in its population size group - directly behind the City of Weston, Fla. Now in its 19th year, the annual survey recognizes cities making smart investments in technologies from infrastructure and citizen engagement to data storage and cybersecurity.

"We are honored to be recognized as a Digital Cities Survey winner," Inez Rodenburg, Director of Information Technology for the City of Danville, said Tuesday. "This prestigious award recognizes the advancements in technology the City has made over the past year."

In that time, the City's information technology team has completed several projects, including new crime dashboards for police, a branded mobile app, a metrics dashboard for performance management and interdepartmental collaboration, and an upgraded VoIP communications system.

Citizen-centric practices have focused on improving government experience through connected applications, mobility, and open data. The City provides a portfolio of applications to help build citizen engagement, including GIS-based story maps, the Danville VA mobile app, the City's budget visualization tool, the City's Social Media Hub, and the City's Geographic Data Hub.

Currently, the staff is working on setting up a one-stop-shop permitting portal for residents that will integrate with its enterprise resource planning system, as well as researching smart city opportunities such as camera analytics to publish downtown's real-time parking availability to the public.

Rodenburg said the technology enhancements lean on effective collaboration with other organizations.

"Through successful collaboration efforts with Smart Cville, Averett University, and the Southern Piedmont Technology Council, the City has been able to leverage resources and ideas to help foster technology advancements," Rodenburg said.

Teri Takai, executive director for the Center for Digital Government, said this year's Digital Cities winners are working to make their communities more secure, user-friendly, efficient, and

"Their efforts are making technology a driver of better, smarter, more responsive government," Takai said.

The survey honors cities in five population classifications: 500,000 or more, 250,000 to 499,999; 125,000 to 249,999; 75,000 to 124,999 and fewer than 75,000. The City of Norfolk ranked first in cities with populations of 125,000 to 249,999. The City of Lynchburg ranked first in the group with populations of 75,000 to 124,999.

The cities of Alexandria and Virginia Beach also were ranked in the top-10 in their population sizes.

The top-10 ranked cities will be honored Thursday at an awards dinner during the National League of Cities' annual conference in San Antonio, Texas.

Or if you think you're not quite ready to land a job, go online to myseco.militaryonesource.mil. Click on career exploration, education and training, and employment readiness. Do not miss the list of coaching packages further down the page. They have everything to get you ready, some very specialized: health care coaching package, cybersecurity coaching package, K-12 education coaching package and more.

If you want to advance your career, there is a scholarship program with funds up to \$4,000 in tuition assistance.

When Holidays are Hard Tips for coping with a food-centric season

uring the holidays, no matter where you turn, you find food, food and more food. From vendor treats filling the office breakroom to celebratory dinners with family and friends, virtually everything and everyone seems to be focused on food. For someone working to overcome an eating disorder, it makes the season anything but festive.

Eating disorders affect 20 million females and 10 million males in the United States and can be diagnosed in boys and girls 7 years old and sometimes even younger.

Eating disorders are not a lifestyle choice; they are mental health disorders similar to depression, bipolar disease or schizophrenia. It is not an individual choice to develop an eating disorder, but rather severe underlying pathological factors which drive individuals to take part in self-destructive behaviors associated with eating disorders.

Genetic, environmental and social factors all play a role in the development of an eating disorder. Interpersonal issues, past trauma, low self-esteem, abuse, co-occurring mental health disorders, substance abuse disorders and unhealthy family and personal relationships can all contribute to the environmental and social factors associated with eating disorders.

Even for someone who is well into a successful recovery program, the holidays can trigger unwanted thoughts and comments surrounding food. Whether you are actively treating your eating disorder or suspect you may have one, you can take steps to make this holiday season more comfortable with these tips from eating disorder expert and licensed therapist Dawn Delgado, director of clinical development at Center for Discovery.

- 1. Always have a safe plan. If you plan on attending a holiday party or gathering, you may want to consult with your dietitian to have a plan beforehand, especially if you feel you may be inclined to binge. If you feel triggered to binge, or if you feel pressured by another individual, create an escape plan, which may mean having a friend accompany you to the party or even come pick you up. Your plan may also involve finding a safe place at the party where you can be alone to gather your thoughts until you feel comfortable re-engaging with others.
- 2. Be prepared to say "no." Many individuals, with good intentions, will push food your way. They will want you to try their favorite dessert or their new recipe without understanding your struggle. Know that it is OK to say "no" and to take care of yourself in these situations. You can choose to clarify why you are saying "no," but do not feel obligated to do so. Also give yourself permission to decline joining holiday office parties, family parties or other holiday-themed get-togethers if your recovery could be compromised, or plan to bring a supportive friend.
- 3. Know your triggers before you engage in social situations. Understanding your triggers and learning how to use coping skills to control them at holiday functions can help keep negative thoughts and self-sabotaging at bay. If there are certain topics of conversation that trigger you then avoid those topics or change the conversation when those topics arise. Be honest with yourself, be honest with others, recognize your emotions and learn to take control of your scenarios.

These simple steps can help you rediscover your natural intuition about food and hunger. These tips can be used all in one meal or you can choose one tip at a time to focus on. When you feel you have mastered one, try a new one. Over time, eating mindfully can become second nature.

 1. Practice mindfulness: Start by eating one meal a day in a slower, more aware manner.
- 2. Hunger check: Before eating, check in with yourself to determine how hungry you are. Are you hungry enough for a meal or just a snack?
- 3. Emotional check: What are you feeling? Are you happy, content, stressed, bored or something different?

 4. Senses check: What type of food are you hungry for? Do you want savory, sweet or salty? Do you want
- something hot or cold?


 5. Time check: Do you have time to sit and savor? Or are you crunched for time?
- **6. Time crunch**: Planning to nourish your body is an act of mindfulness. Taking the time to grab some food or packing food to eat on the go is being mindful that your body needs fuel.
- Focus: Concentrate on the meal in front of you. Avoid doing other activities while you eat such as working, talking on the phone, watching TV, driving or reading.
- 8. Savor: While eating, notice the colors, smells, flavors and textures of the food.
- 9. Food awareness: Notice your reaction to the food you are eating. What do you like, what don't you like? If you are enjoying your food, savor it. If you don't like your food, choose something more appealing.
- 10. Patience and grace: Mindful eating is a practice that takes time to learn and develop. Since there is no judgment in mindful eating, give yourself grace and patience as you learn.

Watching someone you care for battle an eating disorder can be emotionally challenging, but your love and support can make a big difference during the stressful holiday season with these tips from the experts at Center for Discovery:

- If you're uncertain how you can help, just ask then be prepared to listen without judgment
- to listen without judgment.

 Make it clear you are willing to be a sounding board or assist your loved one in getting to a safe place if he or she is triggered during an event.
- Woice concerns privately. Public comments about weight, body shape or food choices can only exacerbate the angst your loved one is feeling, and when you put him or her on the defensive, he or she is less likely to be receptive to your genuine concern.





Easy Potato Rolls

Ingredients

2 packages (1/4 ounce each) active dry yeast

1-1/3 cups warm water (110° to 115°), divided

1 cup warm mashed potatoes (without added milk and butter)

2/3 cup sugar

2/3 cup shortening

2 large eggs, room temperature

2-1/2 teaspoons salt

6 to 6-1/2 cups all-purpose flour

Directions

In a small bowl, dissolve yeast in 2/3 cup warm water. In a large bowl, combine mashed potatoes, sugar, shortening, eggs, salt, remaining 2/3 cup water, yeast mixture and 2 cups flour; beat until smooth. Stir in enough remaining flour to form a soft dough.

Do not knead. Shape into a ball; place in a greased bowl, turning once to grease the top. Cover and let rise in a warm place until doubled, about 1 hour.

Punch down dough; divide into thirds. Divide and shape 1 portion into 15 balls; place in a greased 9-in. round baking pan. Cover with a kitchen towel. Repeat with remaining dough. Let rise in a warm place until doubled, about 30 minutes. Preheat oven to 375°.

Bake rolls until golden brown, 20-25 minutes. Remove from pans to wire racks. Serve warm.
