USDA announces funding for water district in Kendall

KENDALL – The U.S. Department of Agriculture has awarded \$672,000 in funding for a water project in the Town of Kendall.

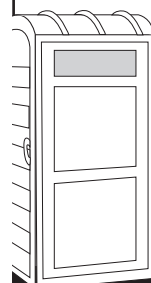
The USDA will provide a \$384,000 grant and a \$288,000 loan to create the West Kendall Road Water District #10.

This project will be located along Roosevelt Highway (Route 18) in an east-west direction and northerly along West Kendall Road. This will include replacing 6,500 linear feet of water main. This project will extend public water service to 19 residential users that currently do not have safe potable water, the USDA said.

Water-quality testing indicates a significant portion of the residents' individual wells have coliform bacteria, which the Health Department indicates does not meet standards and are a threat to the health of residents, according to the USDA.

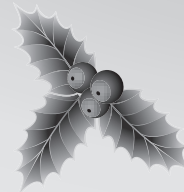

Wrapping gifts is a very old tradition

The holiday season is rife with tradition. One of the most recognizable traditions involves wrapping gifts. While the wrapping paper many gift givers use today is a relatively recent phenomenon, the tradition of wrapping gifts is centuries old, with some historians even suggesting it dates back to ancient times. The Children's Museum of Indianapolis® notes that many ancient cultures celebrated various holidays that included exchanging gifts, adding that it's very likely that, even in ancient times, gifts were wrapped to surprise their eventual recipients. Bojagi is a traditional Korean wrapping cloth that might have begun being used some time during the Three Kingdoms of Korea period, which began in 57 BC and ended in AD 668. The Japanese tradition of furoshiki, which can be traced back to the 17th century and possibly as far back as AD 710, involves using a traditional wrapping cloth to transport certain items, including gifts. As for the gift wrap familiar to today's holiday celebrants, that traces its origins to the early 1900s. The Children's Museum of Indianapolis® notes that Eli Hyman and Morris Silverman founded the first gift wrap company in the United States in 1903. Unfortunately for gift givers back then, adhesive tape had not yet been invented in 1903, and wouldn't be for another 27 years. ■

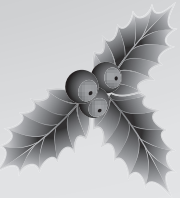

How to Time Holiday Shopping Right

The holiday season begins at the end of November and stretches into the first week of January. But this five-week stretch may not necessarily be the best time for everyone to shop. Consumers are no longer interested in retailers dictating their shopping schedules, and some people have grown accustomed to buying products when they want them — especially when price is of no concern.

Gift-Wrapping Tips and Tricks

Much of the focus of each holiday season is on gift-giving, but all those gifts will eventually need to be wrapped. Stacks of presents just waiting to be covered with paper and ribbon can overwhelm gift givers, prompting them to put off wrapping gifts until the last minute. Devote a bin or bins to wrapping supplies and tools. Having scissors, paper, tape, ribbon, and more in a designated spot will cut down on having to hunt and peck when it comes time to wrap. Martha Stewart suggests getting a rotary cutter to cut long straight or decorative edges on wrapping paper.

Wrap on a firm surface

Devote a table or counter to wrapping gifts. This will keep the paper taut and neat and make it easier to cut and position. You risk tearing the paper or puncturing it when working on carpeting or bedding.

Color- or pattern-code gifts

It's easy to visualize who gets what gift when each recipient has his or her own special wrapping paper. This is also a handy idea when wrapping gifts from Santa, as it will differentiate the Santa gifts from the ones being given by Mom and Dad.

With a few helpful pointers, wrapping gifts can be easy. And for those who prefer to skip the wrapping themselves, many malls and retailers offer complimentary wrapping for a small donation to charity. ■

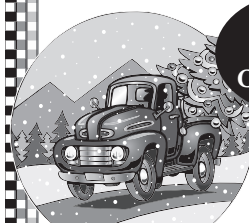

The best way to prevent & treat chapped lips

Chapped lips can be an unpleasant reminder that the weather is changing. Many different people experience chapped lips periodically, but they seem to be especially common when the air is dry and cold. The health and wellness resource Healthline.com says that, because the lips do not contain oil glands like other areas of the skin, they are more prone to drying out. Therefore, people need to take extra steps to keep their lips moist.

Stop licking your lips

The Mayo Clinic says that saliva evaporates quickly, which can leave lips drier than they were before you licked them. Flavored lip balms may entice you to lick your lips more.

Rely on sunscreen

Use a lip balm that contains sunscreen, which can help prevent the lips from damage caused by UV rays, further exacerbating dryness. UV rays are present all year long.

Protect your lips

If you know it's going to be cold and dry outside, apply a lubricating lip cream or balm before heading outdoors. Products containing petroleum, beeswax or coconut oil can help lock moisture in. Reapply often. Also, a scarf or balaclava can help block wind that dries out lips.

Use gentle skin care products

Some people are prone to allergic reactions from cosmetics or skin care products. Read the ingredients carefully and avoid those that have led to reactions in the past.

Drink more fluids

Be sure to drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration, which can dry out lips and skin.

Avoid mouth-breathing

Drawing air in through your mouth can further dry out the lips. Alleviate a stuffy nose so you can breathe through your nose more easily.

The Mayo Clinic recommends speaking with a doctor if chapped lips are chronic and not easily remedied, as this may be a symptom of an underlying condition. ■

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Women are somewhat more likely than men to experience other common symptoms, particularly **SHORTNESS OF BREATH, NAUSEA/VOMITING, AND BACK/JAW PAIN.**

SIGNS OF A STROKE

County budget would raise taxes 2.6%

Tax rate would actually drop 23 cents due to rising assessments

ALBION — The tentative budget for Orleans County would increase taxes by 2.63 percent, however, the tax rate would drop by 23 cents, from \$10.10 to \$9.87 per \$1,000 of assessed property.

Taxes are increasing but the rate is falling due to rising assessed values in the county, up 4.93 percent or by \$85.7 million – from \$1.74 billion in 2019 to \$1.82 billion in 2020. The overall budget includes \$71,711,638 in spending, which is up 1.0 percent from the \$71,031,480 in 2019.

There will be a public hearing on the budget at 6:30 p.m. on Dec. 2 at the Orleans County Legislative Chambers, 14016 Route 31 West, Suite 200, Albion. This is in the new addition of the County Administration Building.

Chuck Nesbitt, the county's chief administrative officer and budget officer, released the tentative budget on Nov. 14. This is his final one as the county's CAO. He leaving the position next month after 14 ½ years to take a job in the private sector.

Nesbitt said the budget meets a goal of county officials in keeping staying within the property tax cap, while maintaining services provided by 430 full- and part-time employees. The budget keeps school resource officers at Kendall and Lyndonville school districts. (Those districts reimburse the county for providing officers at the schools, which started in 2018.)

The county budget also invests in infrastructure and tourism growth, Nesbitt said in a budget message. The county is adding two full-time positions in the District Attorney's Office – a DA and a clerical position – to meet new duties as part of the state's criminal justice reform mandates. The county also is budgeting a \$150,000 increase in community college chargebacks.

The budget keeps the same level of funding in 2020 as 2019 for several agencies that provide services in the community: Cornell Cooperative Extension, \$240,000; Orleans Economic Development Agency, \$190,000; Soil & Water Conservation District, \$92,500; four public libraries, \$10,000 combined; Sportsmen's Federation, \$4,000; and Geneses-Orleans Regional Arts Council, \$3,000.

The fee for solid waste and recycling service will be \$212, which is the same as 2019. That cost is holding steady as the county transitioned to larger recycling totes this year, which are picked up every two weeks instead of weekly.

SHERIFF'S REPORT

In the month of October, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 1988 police incidents, including 795 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 167 for the New York State Police and 1026 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 599 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 433 of those calls emergency medical in nature and 7 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 80 automobile accidents, including 11 with injury and 37 car-deer collisions. Road patrol also made 77 service attempts and successfully served 32 subpoenas, civil, or court papers.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 121 incidents including 35 stray or loose animals, 2 animal bite complaints, 8 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 10 animals were taken into shelter on voluntary surrenders.

The Orleans County Jail processed in 71 inmates and handled 59 prisoner transports to court appearances, medical treatments, or other correctional facilities.

The right way to leave a job


