







THANKSGIVING PROCLAMATION

-- By Abraham Lincoln, 16th President of the United States of America

It is the duty of nations as well as of men to own their dependence upon the overruling power of God; to confess their sins and transgressions in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon; and to recognize the sublime truth, announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations are blessed whose God is the Lord.

We know that by His divine law, nations, like individuals, are subjected to punishments and chastisements in this world. May we not justly fear that the awful calamity of civil war which now desolates the land may be a punishment inflicted upon us for our presumptuous sins, to the needful end of our national reformation as a whole people?

We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties. of heaven; we have been preserved these many years in peace and prosperity; we have grown in numbers, wealth and power as no other nation has ever grown.

But we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us, and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the God that made us.

It has seemed to me fit and proper that God should be solemnly, reverently and gratefully acknowledged, as with one heart and one voice, by the whole American people. I do therefore invite my fellow citizens in every part of the United States, and also those who are at sea and those who are sojourning in foreign lands, to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November as a day of Thanksgiving and praise to our beneficent Father Who dwelleth in the heavens.





- \cdot "In the week before Thanksgiving, have a leftovers day and get all those bits and pieces out of the refrigerator. It will make it easier to clean so you'll have room for the turkey and the sides." -- S.T. in South Carolina
- The night before your large sit-down dinner, put all the serving pieces on the table, and all the dinnerware in the dining room. You don't want to have one person trying to get plates and spoons when you are getting dinner on the table.
- "For easier cooking when making large holiday meals, simply choose two side dishes that can be oven-cooked in the same amount of time at an average temperature. I like one or two that can be cooked in the microwave as well." -- E.U. in Texas
- "For a delightful twist on cranberry jelly, slice and sprinkle with orange zest. Dress up your mashed potatoes with a sprinkling of chopped fresh chives." -- A Reader, via email
- Try this chef's trick for a juicy bird: After seasoning, cover the bird with cheesecloth or muslin secured with string. Baste over the cloth every 15 minutes. In the last 20 minutes, remove the cloth so that the skin can crisp.
- "You know what works really well to keep hot casseroles hot when waiting for other sides to finish? A cooler. Line it with a towel and set your casseroles inside. Then, when they're on the table, stick the cooler back in the kitchen. You can put the dirty casserole dishes back in the cooler after you pack away leftovers. Add some warm, soapy water, and they can even wait until the next day to get cleaned!" -- M.B. in Georgia
- P.S.G. from South Carolina writes: "For holiday gatherings that you host, delegate age-appropriate table tasks to your children: place setting, condiment delivery, refilling water glasses at scheduled intervals, etc. Children like to have a job, and they are better behaved when they have a focus and can make a contribution."
- Plan now for leftovers: Have small plastic containers and zip-top bags in case your guests or family would like to take some home. This is an especially smart thing to do if you are looking to eat healthier. Send Grandma home with a turkey plate and a big slice of chocolate cake! It's better to share.

Almost everyone who has ever loved and been loved by an animal will tell you that they not only believe, but know, that that animal is an emotional, sentient being. That has become clearer to a wider audience with all of the animal videos posted on-line.

We know that animals have emotions; however, it is difficult to gauge, or even know, how deep animals' emotions are. It is even hard for us to completely understand what another human is feeling because of our different spheres of reference. Since we cannot communicate orally with animals, and their natural behaviors and characteristics may not be like ours, we simply cannot know the depth of their emotions. Perhaps their happiness or their sadness isn't on the same level as ours. However, we do any animal a grave disservice when we assume that since we do not understand their emotions, the emotions do not exist.

I have seen tens of thousands of animals whose emotions have been so apparent that no one should mistake what they had just seen. There is space for only a few of the stories.

Many years ago, the police entered an empty house with a search warrant. They found drugs and other evidence of the house being used by many drug dealers. Chained in one of the rooms was a youngish female black and white pit bull. She had wounds all over her body which was disturbing enough. However, when her mouth was opened, the police officers were shocked to see that every single one of her teeth had been filed down to the gums. The look in her eyes told the story of abuse and defeat.

People walking on the Riverwalk found an emaciated ferret. The poor thing was covered with parasites and the relief she felt at being rescued was apparent. She quickly ate and drank water and then nestled into the bed of blankets and towels we gave her. Over the course of the next couple of days, we sensed a sadness in the

ferret that could not be mistaken. We found out the answer a couple of days later. Another walker on the Riverwalk brought another emaciated ferret to us. We put the new one in the same cage, thinking that surely it was not a coincidence that there had been two ferrets picked up. As soon as the first ferret saw the second ferret, we knew that we were seeing the reunion of two bonded friends. After the second one had eaten, they curled up together in the bed of towels.

I follow Esther the Wonder Pig on Facebook. Esther's human started a farm sanctuary and few years ago. Esther's turkey friend, Cornelius, is a major part of their Facebook saga. This one turkey is opening peoples' eyes to understanding that there is so little we humans understand about the emotional lives of animals.

A cat was brought to the shelter. They had not had him long; they had been given him by his former owner. He had never been separated from his brother before being given away. He became so depressed in his new home that they could not stand his sadness.

On and on the stories go of emotion - both sad ones and happy ones. I have witnessed too much at the shelter and with my own companion animals that there is no doubt in my mind and heart that animals have feelings and thoughts.



HOLLYWOOD — When "Avengers: Endgame" became the top-grossing film of all time, it showed old Hollywood how movie-going tastes have changed. Detractors consider "Endgame" merely a comic book movie, but Stephen McFeely, who co-wrote "Endgame" with Christopher Markus, asks, "Is 'The Silence of the Lambs' just a serial-killer movie, or 'Annie Hall' just a romantic comedy and 'The Godfather' a mob movie?"

Martin Scorsese and Francis Ford Coppola have been speaking out in opposition to big-budget comic book cinema. Scorsese admitted, "I don't see them. I tried, you know? But that's not cinema. It isn't the cinema of human beings trying to convey emotional, psychological experiences to another human being. It's something else, we shouldn't be invaded by it." He called on theater owners to "step up" to prevent Marvel movies from pushing narrative films out of theaters.

Coppola, while accepting an award in Italy, defended Scorsese's argument, "He's right because we expect to learn something from cinema, get enlightenment, knowledge and inspiration. Martin was being kind when he said 'It's not cinema.' He didn't say it's despicable, which I just say it is.

The other side has fired back, Markus defended his film with, "Not to pat ourselves on the back, but we snuck an hourlong movie about loss and grief into the biggest movie of all time." Taika Waititi, a writer/director for the Marvel Cinematic Universe added: "It's kind of a form of ignorance to say comic-book and graphic novels aren't art. They have life-changing stories of emotion, they're cinematic. No one is comparing 'Antman' to 'Citizen Kane,' however, as 'Doctor Strange' director Scott Derrickson tweeted, 'Nobody should dismiss movies they haven't seen!" The times they are a changing!







The Turkey Is Burning! and Other Disasters

I've had my share of Thanksgiving Day disasters over the years! Here are some secrets to saving your sanity and your Thanksgiving dinner:

HOW TO DEFROST A TURKEY

You'll need at least 24 to 48 hours (about five hours per pound) to thaw a frozen turkey in the refrigerator. If you need to do a quick thaw, place the wrapped, frozen turkey in your kitchen sink or a large container like an ice chest. Cover the turkey with cold water. Drain and refill the water every half-hour because as the bird thaws out, the water will get warmer. Using this method, the turkey will thaw at the rate of about a half-hour for each pound.

PREPARING THE BIRD FOR COOKING

Remove the giblet package (neck, livers, heart and gizzards) from inside the cavity of the bird AND check the neck cavity. Some manufacturers place the giblet package in the neck cavity and others place it inside the cavity closest to the legs.

Most turkeys come with the legs already trussed (crossed and secured with a metal or plastic bracket). If you're not going to stuff your bird, there's no need to truss the legs. Trussing an unstuffed bird hinders the hot oven air from circulating inside and around the legs. This means that the dark meat will take longer to cook, and the breast meat will cook faster and probably dry out before the legs ever get completely done.

THE TURKEY ISN'T DONE

Don't rely on the "pop-up" timer in the turkey, as it usually means that the breast is overcooked and the dark meat isn't done. If the dark meat isn't done, remove the wings and breast meat from the rest of the turkey, in one piece, if possible. Cover the breast and wing portion with foil and set it aside. Put the drumsticks and thigh portion of the turkey back into the oven to continue cooking until done. You can re-assemble the whole turkey and garnish it, or just cut it into serving portions and arrange it on a platter.

BURNT OFFERINGS

If the turkey begins to burn while it's roasting, flip the bird over immediately and continue to cook it. After the turkey is done, you can remove and discard any blackened skin and about half an inch of the meat below any burnt area. Slice the remaining breast meat, arrange it on a platter and ladle gravy over it.

If your vegetables or gravy burn on the bottom, carefully remove the layer that isn't burned into another pot or serving dish. DON'T SCRAPE THE BOTTOM OF THE PAN.

If the dinner rolls are burned on the bottom, just cut off as much as you can, butter them, and fold them in half to cover the missing ends. Whipped cream is the perfect "makeup" for desserts that aren't quite up to par. You can cut the top layer off a burnt pie and cover it with whipped

STUFFING SAVERS

If the stuffing/dressing is too wet, spread it out in a thin layer on a sheet pan so that it will dry quickly. Place it back into the oven for 5 to 7 minutes. If it's too dry, add more pan drippings or chicken broth to the mixture. If you don't have any more drippings or broth, you can combine a chicken bouillon cube (if you have one), along with a teaspoon of poultry seasoning, three tablespoons of butter and 1 cup of water. Cook the mixture in the microwave for 3 to 5 minutes or until it comes to a boil. Stir to combine and then add it, a little at a time, to the dressing until it's moist.

SOUPY MASHED POTATOES

You can add unseasoned dry breadcrumbs to soupy mashed potatoes to absorb any excess liquid.

GRAVY RESCUE TIPS

If the gravy is lumpy, pour it through a strainer into a new pan and bring it to a simmer, stirring gently. If it's too thin, mix a tablespoon of melted butter with a tablespoon of flour. Bring the gravy up to a boil and whisk in the butter mixture to thicken your gravy. If the gravy is too thick, add a little more chicken broth, pan drippings or a little water and butter to thin it out.

SOGGY PIE CRUST FIXES

Sometimes, the top crust on a pie will cook faster than the bottom crust. If your bottom crust is underdone, cover the top with foil so it doesn't burn and put your pie back in the oven at 425 to 450 degrees for about 12 minutes. Make sure to put it on the bottom rack so the underside gets the

Alternatively, you can scoop out the filling and top crust and just bake the bottom crust by itself. That way, when it's done you can pour the filling back in and make a crumb topping from the top crust. It may even look better this way if your top crust didn't turn out great the first time.

Hopefully, these tips will rescue you from any Thanksgiving Day disasters, but remember, it's about gathering together to give thanks with the people you love -- not the perfect meal! Have a blessed Thanksgiving!

2 Fit crust into ungreased 15x10x1-inch pan, pressing into corners. Fold extra crust even with edges of pan. Crust should come to top edge of pan, sealing any tears in crust.

3 In large bowl, using whisk, mix Pumpkin Pie Filling ingredients until well blended. Pour filling over crust; spread evenly. Bake 25 to 28 minutes or until filling is set.

4 Meanwhile, in medium bowl, using whisk, mix all Pecan Pie Filling ingredients except pecans until well blended. Stir in pecans. Carefully spoon over pumpkin pie filling, spreading evenly.

5 Bake 23 to 28 minutes or until deep golden brown and set in center. Cool completely in pan on cooling rack, about 11/2 hours. Refrigerate 1 hour before cutting into 4 rows by 4 rows. Top with whipped cream, if decired




