


Physical Fitness Class

In the past, most animal shelters would not allow adoptions at Christmas time. The concerns were valid ones – a busy holiday morning is not the calmest time to introduce a new animal into a home and some people simply did not want the gift of a new pet.

That has changed and now many shelters allow gift adoptions, last-minute adoptions, etc. Each shelter must have the policies they feel comfortable with.

We changed our policy from a "no-adoption the week before Christmas" policy years ago. We still did not allow gift adoptions; boyfriends/girlfriends were not allowed to adopt an animal for each other. The compromise was to have the potential recipient be part of the process. If the one to receive the gift was a teenager, we absolutely had to have permission from the parents; in fact, they had to be the ones to sign the adoption contract.

That policy remains in place. We still hesitate to have a new puppy or kitten be placed in a box and unwrapped on Christmas morning. We encourage parents to wrap a leash or collar to be unwrapped, and then the family can come the next day and pick up the new pet. From time to time, we have sent a letter to Santa Claus, asking if he will bring the new animal early Christmas Eve as he flies over this area on his way to the other side of the earth. He has always cooperated with us and the families have been very happy.

Our holiday policy is not meant to break hearts or to be difficult. It is in place to help the animals have as quiet a transition into their new home and family as possible, decrease the chance of an animal being returned to the shelter, and do our due diligence in making sure our shelter animals will never again be unwanted or neglected.

If parents want to adopt a family pet, we urge them to visit the shelter on the 14th during our special Santa event with police officer elves from 11-2. That will start the process and will help decrease the likelihood misunderstandings and hurt feelings will happen.

After all, 'tis the season for goodwill and that can extend to animals and their needs!





Scruggs is a familiar face around Caswell County, visiting homes of both friends and soonto-be friends, lending helping hands, and driving buses to pick up kids for church events. He also regularly speaks at the church's GYM meeting on Sunday evenings aimed at teenagers and young adults. After retiring as a rural postal carrier out of Yanceyville, Scruggs served as an elder at Covenant Reformed Baptist Church in Providence, NC (immediately south of Danville). Dr. John Car penter, the church's pastor, explains, "Elders are the human leaders of the church according to the Bible. Reformed churches follow the Biblical pattern of having both paid elders, that is pastors like me, and lay elders who together lead the church. Lay elders like Joe aren't paid but serve as a volunteer ministry." The church celebrated Scruggs completion of his second consecutive term and his life-time of evangelistic serve with a plaque and a commemorative book and other members spontaneously made cards and a poster. THEY LIVED HAPPILY EVER **AFTER**



What Are The Differences Between Guardianship And Power Of Attorney?

We receive calls every week from families caring for a loved one whose health is starting to deteriorate, asking about getting a Power of Attorney. Sadly, far too often in the case of those suffering from Alzheimer's or dementia, most had not done any estate planning documents prior to their worsening condition and by this point may have lost all capacity to sign legal documents! What can be done in instances where no estate planning was put in place ahead of time? The answer is often a guardianship.

By definition of the law, a guardianship is a legal relationship in which an entity or a person is named in a will or is appointed by the court to make decisions for another. One example would be in the case of minors and adults who have become incapable of taking care of their personal needs and can no longer make decisions on their

It is also referred to as a conservatorship on occasion, but the term "guardianship" is more frequently used. In the case of minors, the guardianship will apply until he or she is 18 years old. Any family member or close family friend can petition the court for guardianship or a government agency can petition for it.

This is also true in the case of incompetent adults, but the person or ward can select the person that he wants to be his guardian. The judge will take this into consideration before granting the guardianship. After the guardianship is obtained, the ward cannot revoke the guardianship. However, there are cases wherein temporary guardianship is given which can be terminated after achieving a certain purpose. Guardians make all decisions for and on behalf of their wards but must not benefit from transactions made for his ward.

A guardianship is meant to ensure that a minor or an incapacitated adult receives all the necessary care he needs. Every decision that a guardian makes on behalf of his ward must be for the benefit and well-being of his ward.

A power of attorney, on the other hand, is a written, legal document wherein an individual called "the principal" appoints another individual called "the agent" to act on his behalf; authorizing the agent to make transactions for the principal.

Usually, a power of attorney is made when a principal sees that he is becoming unable to handle some of his affairs. This is usually done when he becomes ill or has been in an accident, or when he goes out of town and there are financial transactions that have to be done in his absence. This type of planning should all be done with an eye towards planning for the future, and avoiding possible incapacity. It is a written agreement between the agent and the principal whose consent is necessary for the power of attorney to take effect. Should the principal see that the power of attorney is no longer needed, he can revoke or terminate it at any time.

The power of attorney documents produced by our firm are two separate documents: Durable (for financial matters) and Healthcare (for medical and health-related matters). A Living Will is typically paired with the Healthcare Power of Attorney to address end-of-life decisions. While these documents are very thorough, the only thing worse than not having a power of attorney is having one, but never actually having that conversation with your agent as to what your actual wishes would be if you were unable to communicate them yourself! You are ideally trying to create the situation where someone is not trying to decide end-of-life decisions for you, but to merely voice what they know you would want in those circumstances! The power of the agent is limited only to the content of the agreement, and should be done based on the client's own specific needs and situation both now and in the future.

While guardianship requires the guardian to report to the court and other agencies the financial dealings made for the ward to determine where the ward's money went, a power of attorney does not require the agent to account for every penny that he spent.

The best advice of course, is to plan ahead, as no one knows what the future holds! For those situations where time has run out in regards to planning and estate planning documents are no longer possible, a guardianship is the more expensive and time-consuming route, but is often the only answer.

What to Do When Medicare Tells You No

Dear Savvy Senior,

How do I go about appealing Medicare when they won't pay for something that they covered in the past?

Rejected Rhonda

Dear Rhonda,

If you disagree with a coverage or payment decision made by Medicare, you can appeal, and you'll be happy to know that around half of all appeals are successful, so it's definitely worth your time.

But before going that route, talk with the doctor, hospital and Medicare to see if you can spot the problem and resubmit the claim. Some denials are caused by simple billing code errors by the doctor's office or hospital. If, however, that doesn't fix the problem, here's how you appeal.

Original Medicare Appeals

If you have original Medicare, start with your quarterly Medicare Summary Notice (MSN). This statement will list all the services, supplies and equipment billed to Medicare for your medical treatment and will tell you why a claim was denied. You can also check your Medicare claims early online at MyMedicare.gov, or by calling Medicare at 800-633-4227.

There are five levels of appeals for original Medicare, although you can initiate a fast-track consideration for ongoing care, such as rehabilitation. Most people have to go through several levels to get a denial overturned.

You have 120 days after receiving the MSN to request a "redetermination" by a Medicare contractor, who reviews the claim. Circle the items you're disputing on the MSN, provide an explanation of why you believe the denial should be reversed, and include any supporting documents like a letter from the doctor or hospital explaining why the charge should be covered. Then send it to the address on the form.

You can also use the Medicare Redetermination Form. See CMS.gov/Medicare/CMS-Forms/CMS-Forms/downloads/CMS20027.pdf to download it or call 800-633-4227 to request a copy by mail.

The contractor will usually decide within

60 days after receiving your request. If your request is denied, you can request for "reconsideration" from a different claims reviewer and submit additional evidence.

A denial at this level ends the matter, unless the charges in dispute are at least \$160 in 2019. In that case, you can request a hearing with an administrative law judge. The hearing is usually held by videoconference or teleconference.

If you have to go to the next level, you can appeal to the Medicare Appeals Council. Then, for claims of at least \$1,630 in 2019, the final level of appeals is judicial review in U.S. District Court.

Advantage and Part D Appeals

If you're enrolled in a Medicare Advantage health plan or Part D prescription drug plan the appeals process is slightly different. With these plans you have only 60 days to initiate an appeal. And in both cases, you must start by appealing directly to the private insurance plan, rather than to Medicare.

If you think that your plan's refusal is jeopardizing your health, you can ask for a "fast decision," where a Part D insurer must respond within 24 hours, and Medicare Advantage health plan must provide an answer within 72 hours.

If you disagree with your plan's decision, you can file an appeal, which like original Medicare, has five levels. If you disagree with a decision made at any level, you can appeal to the next level.

Get Help

If you need some help contact your State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP), which has counselors that can help you understand the billing process and even file your appeal for you for free. SENIOR NEWS LINE

What We Need for Winter

There are three things we seniors need to get through a cold winter: flashlights, insulated mittens and space blankets.

Check your battery and flashlight supply and stock up on what you need. One of the big-box stores has small flashlights, about 4 inches long, for \$1, and they come with three AAA batteries. (At that price it's cheaper to buy new flashlights than the batteries that go in them.) While they won't light up your whole house (20 lumens), they are small enough to carry in a pocket and get you from room to room if the power goes out. Keep a few of them scattered around the house: kitchen counter, dining-room table, nightstand and right inside the front door, just in case. That way you won't have to feel your way across the room to find a light.

Look for insulated mittens instead of gloves. Mittens have the advantage of keeping your fingers together and holding in warmth. Knitted mittens won't keep you warm. Be sure they're not too big and that your wrist is covered.

Consider buying one (or more) of those thermal foil Mylar emergency space blankets. They look like large sheets of aluminum foil, folded down to a few inches. When opened, these blankets are said to hold in 90% of body heat. Right now you can get a pack of two for less than \$8 on Amazon, or check the sporting goods area of your local big box store. (Be sure to check the size.) Keep one in the glove compartment of your car.



group, comprised of more than fifty firefighters and volunteers from all over Person County, also works to help burn families to develop escape plans in case there might be another fire."

The Person County chapter of the Firefighters' Burned Children's Fund was formed in 2001. The group is a 501C3 organization and they do take donations straight from the public which are tax deductible.

BACON WRAPPED WATERCHESTNUTS



INGREDIENTS

- 1 Cup Brown Sugar Packed
- 2 Tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 2 Cups Ketchup
- 1 Pound Bacon Slices Cut in Thirds
- 2 (8 Ounce) Cans Waterchestnuts Drained

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Line a 9X13 inch baking dish with aluminum foil.

Combine brown sugar, Worcestershire sauce, and ketchup until smooth.

Wrap each water chestnut with a bacon piece, overlapping ends, then securing with a toothpick. Place in a prepared baking dish in a single layer. Bake in preheated oven for 20 minutes. Drain off excess grease.

Pour the sauce over chestnuts then arrange in a single layer. Place back in the oven and continue to bake another 50-60 minutes, or until bacon crisps
