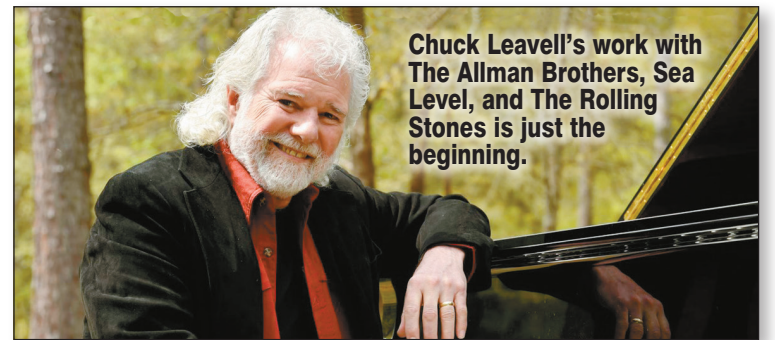

At a Different Level

Local Appearance Accentuates Chuck Leavell's Excellence in Musicianship and Conservation Work

FLORENCE— Chuck Leavell decided he wanted to make a living performing and recording music at age 13 after seeing Ray Charles in concert. That decision became a reality when he made his way to Muscle Shoals at age 15 and played on a recording of Freddie North's soul classic "Don't



Chuck Leavell's work with The Allman Brothers, Sea Level, and The Rolling Stones is just the beginning.

Take Her, She's All I Got." Leavell moved to Macon, Georgia in 1970 where he worked his way through the ranks at Capricorn Records while touring with Dr. John, country legend Kitty Wells, The Marshall Tucker Band and others. In 1972 at just 20 years old, Leavell was asked to join the Allman Brothers Band. The first album he recorded with the band was *Brothers*

and *Sisters*, which included the classics "Ramblin' Man" and "Jessica." The album hit number one on Billboard's Pop charts, and Leavell recorded several more albums with them before the Allmans temporarily disbanded in 1976. Emerging from the break-up of the Allman Brothers Band, Leavell formed the rock/

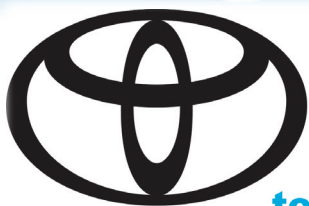

jazz/blues fusion group Sea Level with Allman's drummer, Jaimoe. The band toured relentlessly during the late '70s and released five critically acclaimed albums. Leavell caught the attention of the late rock 'n' roll impresario, Bill Graham, and keyboardist, Ian Stewart, the original "sixth" Rolling Stone. In 1982 he was invited to assume a significant

keyboardist/vocalist/musical director role for the Stones that continues today. Guitarist Keith Richards said, "Without the continuity that Leavell brings to us, the Stones would not be the Stones."

The record-breaking 2005-2007 Rolling Stones "A Bigger Bang" tour marked Leavell's 25th year with the band. The 147-show tour proved yet again that the Stones are the world's greatest rock 'n' roll band.

Leavell released his first seasonal album in

1999 entitled, *What's in that Bag?* on Capricorn Records. It has become a holiday favorite and it continues to rate highly every year in Christmas CD sales.

Leavell's next release, *Southscape* has been described as southern jazz.

He continued recording with various artists growing his credits to include artists such as David Gilmore, John Mayer, Dr. John, Eric Clapton (Unplugged), Train, The Black Crowes, George Harrison, Blues Traveller, Chuck Berry, Aretha Franklin, Don McLean, Miranda Lambert, Martina McBride, Lady Antebellum, the Allman Betts Band, and many other legends.

In addition to recording with other artists, Leavell has released six albums of his own.

Most recently, he completed the Rolling Stones 2019 "No Filter" U.S. tour, marking his 37th year with the Stones.

accomplishments as a conservationist and tree farmer are as impressive as his musicianship. The American Tree Farm System selected Chuck and Rose Lane as the National Outstanding Tree Farmers of the Year in 1999. Additionally, Leavell has been cited by



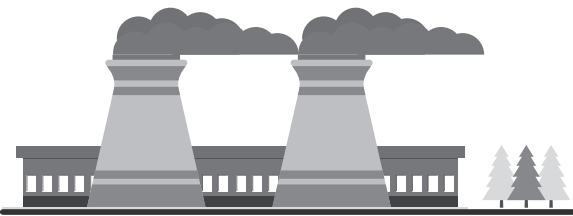

SNAP Can Be an Asset or a Drain

US Secretary of Agriculture, Sonny Perdue, announced last week that more able-bodied recipients of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) would begin the transition towards self-sufficiency. This should have been celebrated far and wide as a step toward a more prosperous and industrious society. However, that is not the case.

Sound reasoning and economic benefits notwithstanding, those on the political left insist ANY reduction in SNAP funding causes major trauma to the soul of this nation. Some of the descriptors used by the left were, "cruel," "lacking empathy," and "uncaring." Complete hogwash.

Math Vote is Not New

Editor:

The Alabama State School Board is scheduled to vote on revised "new" math standards on December 12. We're all aware of how Common Core math standards have failed us. The recently released math scores have Alabama at dead last.

Eagle Forum of Alabama has done a side-by-side comparison of the new (K-8) 2019 Alabama Math Standards and they are almost identical to Common Core. We have also provided in-depth reviews of the K-8 and 9-12 standards. In both cases the recommendation is to quickly abandon the proposed math standards.

The proposed new K-8 math standards are almost identical to the Common Core-standards which we have been using since their

implementation in 2012. We now have the national test scores that prove they were a failure and which pulled us down to last place in the U.S. math rankings. The proposed 9-12 standards are even worse than Common Core. They are poorly written and experimental at best.

"There are good standards already written that have been tested and proven, and that is what we must adopt," according to Eagle Forum's President, Eunie Smith. "It's time that our education department begin utilizing non-Common Core math consultants and standards writers, non-Common Core materials, and non-Common Core teacher trainers. We will never get away from Common Core if we keep listening to the same advocates who promote

and endorse this failing initiative," she added.

Eagle Forum is urging citizens to contact their Alabama Board of Education members and the governor. Ask them to vote "No" on December 12. The public is welcome to attend the meeting at 10am in the auditorium of the Gordon Persons Building in Montgomery. Those who would like to speak must call Nora Thorington at 334-694-4903. Let's be done with this chapter and move on to proven non-Common Core, classic math standards to enable all students to succeed.

NBC NIGHTLY NEWS RECENTLY AIRED A DRAMATIC SEGMENT on the potential security risks associated with smart TVs. Supposedly, hackers can get into your TV and turn on the camera and microphone to spy on you. The last time NBC aired a segment on this turned out to be mostly bogus because, for someone to spy on you through your TV, the spy would have to have physical access to your TV to install some software that would allow the spy to activate your microphone on the TV to listen to you. Ignoring the fact that most older (and newer) TVs didn't have microphones

or cameras, the hackers would have to be awfully determined to go through all that when they could simply plant a microphone or camera in a houseplant somewhere.

The news report I saw referenced a warning from the FBI that reads, "Many (smart TVs) have microphones for those of us who are too lazy to actually pick up the remote. Just shout at your set that you want to change the channel or turn up the volume and you are good to go. A number of the newer TV's also have built-in cameras (that can

be used to chat with grandma). Hackers can take control of your unsecured TV. At the low end of the risk spectrum, they can change channels, play with the volume, and show your kids inappropriate videos. In a worst-case scenario, they can turn on your bedroom TV's camera."

This is very scary, but is it likely to happen? Well, not as far as I can tell. I searched far and wide to find a story of this actually happening. The closest thing I found was a class-action lawsuit brought against Visio. In the suit, Vizio customers alleged

their televisions recorded their viewing habits — including what, when, and where they'd been watching — and then sold the data to advertisers, who used the data to target consumers with ads on other devices. This is a goofy lawsuit because who doesn't know that "someone" out there always knows what you watch and when you watch? Things like Netflix and Amazon would not work unless the company knew what you watched. But that's beside the point for this article. Some newer TVs do have remotes that have a microphone and camera that certainly presents a small risk. But so does the microphone in your phone, computer, Alexa, and so forth.

I've not been able to find a single instance of an individual being victimized by their TV spying on them. This kind of

spying is possible, of course. I would be wary if some creepy person gifted me a free TV for my bedroom. If you have a tech-savvy evil ex you might want to raise your skeptical antenna.

Prime TV-buying season is upon us. Don't let the scaremongers take your joy from you. Buy that TV you've been eyeing while the getting is good, but keep in mind that there is a very small risk as is the case with all our internet-connected toys.

not staunchly adhere to those principles. The result is rampant abuse and ever-increasing red-ink. The longer a person is out of the workforce, the harder it is to re-enter, and the more comfortable he/she becomes outside of employment. And people are getting more and more comfortable.

The unemployment rate was 4% in the year 2000 and just over 17 million Americans were receiving Food Stamp (SNAP) benefits. Today, with all the economic expansion underway, the unemployment rate is 3.6%, a 50-year low. However, 36 million Americans are now on the SNAP program. The reinstated requirements realign with what Congress intended: assistance through challenges and difficulty, not a permanent lifestyle.

Unfortunately, some who cannot take care of themselves and earn a living will need that support permanently. Our obligation as a prosperous and compassionate society should override any other concerns. However, some people who only need assistance temporarily or don't need it all will milk the system

at any opportunity.

The latest U.S. Department of Labor figures show that there are 7.0 million job openings. Most of those openings require skills or knowledge that many in the aforementioned 3.6% will not have. However, they have options available for no-cost training and support materials (boots, uniforms, transit subsidies, etc.)

The USDA ruling promotes work for able-bodied adults 18-49 without dependents. It does not apply to children and their parents, those over 50 years old including the elderly, those with a disability, or pregnant women.

A long-standing SNAP statute limits these adults to three months of benefits in a three-year period – unless they work or participate in work training for at least 20 hours per week. There are also numerous ways for individuals to extend their SNAP benefits by working, preparing for work, and/or volunteering. So, compassion is still all over the legislation.

"Americans are generous people who believe it is their responsibility to help their fellow citizens when they encounter a difficult stretch. Government can be a powerful force for good, but government

dependency has never been the American dream. We need to encourage people by giving them a helping hand, but not allowing it to become an indefinitely giving hand," Perdue said during last week's announcement.

There are so many options open for bright people who are not looking for excuses to be lazy. Social trends that exacerbate irresponsibility, tear down the family unit, and increase dependence on social subsistence programs are another issue. They also should be addressed. We can eliminate a lot of the hopelessness that permeates many minds with responsible family planning, affordable childcare, and fair wages. This would alleviate much of the societal unrest we now experience.

Who wouldn't want more productive, resourceful, and responsible generations as the future of America? That's easy. What groups benefit from having the chaos?

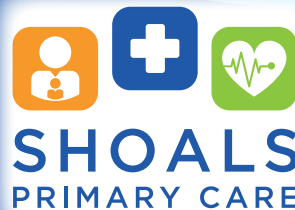

Cash them in, and depending on what Baby Step you're on, put it toward your emergency fund, your debt snowball, retirement, your mortgage—just be proactive, and do something better with the money!

We have two preschool kids, and I'm a stay-at-home mom. My husband brings home about \$2,500 a month, and our mortgage payment is \$1,000 a month. Recently, we've had to tap into our savings in order to pay the bills. Should I go back to work? There are a couple of reputable daycare centers near us, but I'm just not sure if this is the right thing to do.

Dear Tammy,
Being a full-time mom is a wonderful thing. And honestly, I can't blame you

for wanting to stay home with your children when they're so young.

The biggest problem I see is that 40 percent of your husband's paycheck is going toward your mortgage. That's way too much! A house payment should never be more than 25 percent of your take-home pay.

I know trying to live on the \$1,500 that's left is hard, especially with two babies in the house. But it doesn't sound like a lot of fat can be trimmed right now. One of you might consider taking on a part-time job nights or weekends for a while, or he could look into enhancing his education. Either one of these would help get your income up. Selling the house is an option, too. But I'm not a fan of that one except in the most extreme circumstances.

Right now, I'm viewing this as a math problem with three components. The components are income, house payment, and lifestyle. You and your husband need to sit down, and have a serious heart-to-heart talk about things. There will have to be some sacrifices in order to make things better, but only the two of you together can determine exactly what's best for your family.

Cash them in, and depending on what Baby Step you're on, put it toward your emergency fund, your debt snowball, retirement, your mortgage—just be proactive, and do something *better* with the money!

These 7 Factors Determine Car Insurance Premiums

You pay one amount for car insurance, your spouse pays another, and your neighbor pays still another amount. What gives? Most insurance companies look at a number of key factors to calculate how much you'll end up paying for your car insurance.

Taking a closer look at seven of these factors that affect your car insurance premiums can clear things up — and some of them also come with bonus suggestions for keeping the costs down.

Your policy and deductibles

It's a given that you will choose your car insurance deductible and decide whether to add additional coverage that isn't necessarily required by the laws in your state. The specifics of your policy and deductibles play a major role in your monthly payment.

Generally, choosing a higher deductible means a lower monthly payment; choosing a lower deductible means a higher monthly payment. Additional coverage gives you added insurance protection, depending on the claim, but will also add to your monthly costs.

Also, consider that many insurers will offer discounts if you use them for multiple products, such as auto and home insurance.

What you drive Car insurance providers often develop vehicle safety ratings by collecting a large amount of data from customer claims and analyzing industry safety reports, and they offer discounts to customers who drive safer vehicles.

The opposite can apply for dangerous, flashy rides. Some insurers increase premiums for cars more susceptible to damage, occupant injury, or theft, and they lower rates for those that fare better than the norm on those measures.

Driving vehicles that rate highly in terms of driver protection and passenger protection, like recent model year Toyota 4Runners, mean discounts on insurance. And while two-door Honda Civics are one of the country's most popular vehicles, their lower-than-average safety ratings and desirability to car thieves make them more expensive to insure.

So before you head down to the dealership, do some research. Does the vehicle that has caught your eye have strong safety ratings? Is this specific model often stolen? Knowing the answers to a few simple questions can go a long way in keeping your rates low.

How often, and how far, you drive

People who use their car for business and long-distance commuting normally pay more than those who drive less. The more miles you drive in a year, the higher the chances of a crash - regardless of how safe a driver you are.

Consider joining a car or van pool, riding your bike, or taking public transportation to work. If you reduce your total annual driving mileage enough, you may lower your premiums.

Where you live

Generally, due to higher rates of vandalism, theft, and crashes, urban drivers pay more for car insurance than do those in small towns or rural areas.

Your driving record

Drivers who cause crashes generally must pay more than those who have gone crash-free for several years.

If you've been crash-free for a long period of time, don't get complacent. Remain vigilant and maintain your good driving habits.

And even though you can't rewrite your driving history, having a crash on your record can be an important reminder always to drive with caution and care. As time goes on, the effect of past crashes on your premiums will decrease.

Your credit history

It has been shown certain credit information can be predictive of future insurance claims. Where applicable, many insurance companies use credit history to help determine the cost of car insurance. Maintaining good credit can have a positive impact on the cost of your car insurance.

Your age, sex, and marital status

Crash rates are higher for all drivers under age 25, especially single males. Insurance prices in most states reflect these differences.

If you're a student, you might also be in line for a discount. Most car insurers provide discounts to student-drivers who maintain good grades.

In some states, younger drivers are also able to take driver safety courses that will lower premiums. Overall, it doesn't hurt — and might very well help — to ask about discounts. 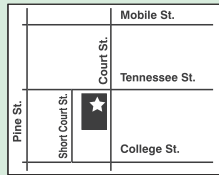

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE PULLED OVER BY A POLICE OFFICER

You will always need to produce your driver's license, proof of insurance and car registration. I keep mine above the sun visor because I do not want to try and find those documents in the glove box or console. We give away plastic sleeves that advertise our law firm that are made to hold auto registration and proof of insurance. Call or come by and we'll give you one.

First, acknowledge that you see the blue lights by putting on your signal to indicate that you are pulling over. Slow down. Find a safe place for both you and the officer. Stay in the car.

The next idea is to turn off the engine and roll down the window. Keep your hands on the steering wheel where the officer can see them. Put yourself in the officer's place a little. Officers get hurt in these situations and helping them feel safe is the best thing to do in an uncomfortable situation. Remember you're going to need your driver's license, proof of insurance and your car registration. Keep them handy.

I advise that you're always polite, always address the police officer as "officer" or sir or ma'am. If an attorney has to go to court, it's always best if the officer has no reason to truly remember your client. Some of the most difficult situations I have dealt with are situations where my clients felt the need to curse or insult a police officer. Those cases rarely go well later. Whether you plan or fighting the ticket or not, be polite.

Everything you say to an officer is admissible in court. Sometimes just saying you're sorry helps. If you don't plan on fighting your ticket, apologize and promise to pay more attention. The side of the road is not the place to argue a charge. If you want to contest the ticket, you can do so in court in front of the judge.

When all is said and done, take the time to put your documents away before re-entering traffic. If you are upset, take a minute to calm yourself. Take a few deep breaths and relax. When you are ready, turn on your signal and merge back into traffic.

Medicare Minute

"Prescription Drug Plans 3"

Last week we discussed prescription drug plan premiums, deductibles and coinsurance. This week we will continue to look at Medicare prescription drug plans by looking at copays, formularies and provider networks. When choosing a prescription drug plan these six things are very important to consider.

A copay is a fixed amount you pay for each individual prescription. Copays can vary depending on the tier of your prescription. Typically the lower the tier, the lower the copay. A tier 1 drug usually has a lower copay than a tier 2 drug, tier 2 drugs have a lower copay than tier 3, etc. Because different plans may categorize drugs in different tiers it's a good idea to know how your plan treats your prescriptions.

The prescription drug plan's formulary will tell you two important things. First, it will tell you if the prescription you are taking is covered under the plan. Second, it will tell you the tier of the prescription. Knowing the tier of your prescription is important in determining the copay. For example, Plan A may list your prescription as a tier 2 whereas, Plan B may have it as a tier 3. This should tell you that Plan A will have a lower copay on your prescription than Plan B. It will also tell you if your drug will fall in the deductible phase of the plan.

The plan's provider network is a list of pharmacies that accepts the plan. All pharmacies do not accept all plans so if you have a particular pharmacy you would like to use check to make sure they accept your plan. You can do this by simply asking your pharmacist. Also, pharmacies are listed as "preferred" and "standard" under some plans. In this case a "preferred" pharmacy may have lower copays than a "standard" pharmacy.

Friday from 9am-5pm. The museum previously operated from the Leighton Library since its Gala Opening on May 7, 1954. The artifacts on display came primarily from the collection of Frank King with many additions provided by Horace Holland. Jimmy King, grandson of Frank King, was instrumental in the

renovation of the museum. "The museum has been an asset to our community, and we wanted to protect the contents," said Jimmy King. "I think people will be surprised at the rich history we have preserved not only for Leighton, but for North Alabama." The museum collection boasts a variety of Leighton history to include local Native American pieces, LaGrange College artifacts, Civil War and World War I memorabilia, and numerous items that tell the story of the early days of Leighton. The exhibit

is filled with photographs and information panels to tell the story as patrons walk through the museum. "There is not another museum like this in North Alabama," says Debbie Bradford, curator of the museum. "The information we have secured from the ancestors has made the contents come to life. The Open House is open to everyone and entrance to the Leighton Museum is free to the public. The Leighton Public Library will also be open during this event."
