


### HOLLYWOOD by Tony Rizzo

HOLLYWOOD - When Warner Brothers produced "Joker," the top-grossing R-rated film of all time, they were certain it was a one-shot film with no sequels. Even the producers admit, "Joker was not set up to have any sequels, so no sequels were in development." But after a month in release and well over \$1 billion in box-office receipts, you'd better believe they're talking sequels. That clever guy, Bradley Cooper, pro-duced the film with Todd Phillips (who wrote and directed) and Emma Tillinger Koskoff. Joaquin Phoenix, who is sure to receive his fourth Oscar nomination for his performance as the Joker, just began shooting an untitled Mike Mills project film, shrouded in secrecy, with Gaby Hoffmann.

In 1976, producer Leonard Goldberg (and Aaron Spelling) built the TV series "Charlie's Angels" around Kate Jackson, then cast Jaclyn Smith and finally an unknown unpolished actress/model, Farrah Fawcett. The three stars spent as much time in front of full-length mirrors on the set as they did with their scripts. The show hit big and ran for five years. In 2000, a film version was made with Drew Barrymore (also one of the producers with Leonard Goldberg), Cameron Diaz and Lucy Liu as the "Angels" with **Bill Murray** as Bosley, Sam Rockwell, Tim Curry and John Forsythe (as "Charlie"). The film cost \$93 million and earned \$264 million. That prompted a sequel in 2003 with Barrymore, Diaz and Liu, along with Crispin Glover, Bernie Mac as Bosley, Demi Moore, Justin Theroux, Shia LaBeouf and John Forsythe (as "Charlie" again). The sequel cost \$120 million and grossed \$259 million. Fast-forward to last month, when the new "Charlie's Angels" (without Leonard Goldberg as a producer) opened with Kristen Stewart, Naomi Scott and Ella Balinska. Kristen Stewart became a star because of "The

Twilight Saga" (2008-2012), however, her next 10 films, mostly low-budget, were box-office failures. **Elizabeth Banks** wrote/co-produced and directed the film, in addition to playing Bosley (the wife of John Bosley, played by **Patrick Stewart**). Since John Forsythe has passed away, the voice of Charlie is by **Robert Clotworthy**. Unfortunately Kristen Stewart and this no-star cast couldn't sell tickets and

Your Best Christmas Gift? By Dr. Glenn Mollette

The average American will spend \$920 on Christmas gifts this year reaching a total of more than \$1 trillion in holiday spending. Eight percent said they would spend nothing, and three percent said they were unsure. Twenty-nine percent expected their gift spending to be between \$100 and \$499 according to stats from Investopedia.

In 2001, the average American planned to spend \$1,052 - the highest ever. Following the financial crash in 2008, planned holiday shopping dropped to \$417 in 2009 - less than half of what people planned to spend in 2018 according to the National Retail Federation.

Americans have been spending more on holiday gifts every year since 2008 (except 2012); although the holiday spending is still not back on the prerecession trend, it seems to be headed in that direction - possibly thanks to lower unemployment, stronger growth, and higher confidence in the economy.

I can't find a stat for the number of people who receive stuff on Christmas they really don't want or need. Often these gifts are from people who can't afford to buy Christmas gifts. The average American racked up \$1,018 in credit card debt in 2018 according to a CNBC report. Most of these Americans spent the last year trying to pay off that debt. Why do people do such crazy stuff?

It's good that we want to give. Giving makes us feel good, but it won't make you feel good when you are still paying for it in July.

Think about ways to give that you can afford or that might be more meaningful.

How about make lunch or share your evening meal with someone? Offer babysitting for a night as a gift. Write a letter of recommendation for an unemployed friend. Write someone a note and let them know what they have meant to you over the years. Offer an hour or even an evening of your time to a friend or family member to chat over a snack. Relieve a relative who spends hours and days at the nursing home. Go and take their place for a day to help out. You might be thinking - "I'd rather just send or give them a gift." Exactly, because time is our most precious gift and asset.







#### Windsor Chair

The Windsor chair was introduced in England in the late 17th century, and it was about 50 years later, around 1730, that the first American Windsor chairs were made in Philadelphia. The American makers created differ-

ent styles of Windsors. They all had a shaped wooden seat made of a single thick piece of wood, spindles used for a back and perhaps arms. There were splayed legs that were inserted into holes in the seat. The Windsor gradually changed into a captain's chair with no spindles and a low back. Windsors were made of several types of wood chosen for properties like strength for the legs, pliability for the top of the back, and easy carveability for the seat. Then they were painted a single dark color. If there is a hole in the seat, the chair probably was converted to a potty chair. Rocking chairs can be early chairs with added rockers or 18th century chairs made with original rockers. You can tell by the way they are attached.

There are tips to telling the age

and origin of an authentic chair. An English chair will have a splat in the back and may use cabriole legs. It has a lower back than an American chair. Older American chair seats are about 18 inches from the floor: later ones are lower, about 16 to 17 inches. The number of spindles in the back is a good gauge of age: The more there are, the older the chair. Nine spindles is a very old chair. The chairs are named for the shape of the back. This is a birdcage Windsor with rockers that may have been added. It was made in the early 19th century in Massachusetts. The auction estimate at a James Julia sale was \$500 to \$700.

Holiday Eggnog

Rich, creamy -- and safe, because it starts with cooked eggs.

- 12 large eggs
- 11/4 cups sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 quarts whole milk
- 1 cup dark rum (optional)
- 2 tablespoons vanilla extract

l teaspoon ground nutmeg plus additional for sprinkling

1 cup heavy or whipping cream

1. In heavy 4-quart saucepan, with wire whisk, beat eggs, sugar and salt until blended. Gradually stir in 1 quart milk and cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until custard thickens and coats the back of a spoon well, about 25 minutes (mixture should be about 160 F, but do not boil or it will curdle). 2. Pour custard into large bowl; stir in rum, if using, vanilla extract, 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg and remaining 1 quart milk. Cover and refrigerate until well chilled, at least 3 hours. 3. In small bowl, with mixer at medium speed, beat heavy or whipping cream until soft peaks form. With wire whisk, gently fold whipped cream into custard mixture.





\* Be sure to eat a hearty breakfast before heading out to the airport. 


