ON YOUR DEBT

Know Your Rights When Dealing with Debt Collectors

It's no secret that collection agencies, debt buyers, and other debt collectors don't always play fair. Most people who have been through a financial crunch and fallen behind on their bills have had at least one bad experience with a debt collector who lied, shouted at the debtor, made outrageous threats, or otherwise attempted to trick or bully him or her into compliance. Needless to say, dealing with debt collectors is never something people

What you may not know, is that federal law prohibits debt collectors from most of the tactics listed above, and many others as well.

Whether you're in a financial bind and debt collectors have become part of your dayto-day reality or you've received a demand out of the blue regarding a debt you don't recognize, it's important to know your rights

and how to assert them. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act

In addition to protecting consumers against dishonest and abusive practices, the FDCPA sets forth a system for alleged debtors to dispute debts they believe are not theirs, that they have already paid, or when balances appear to be inaccurate.

The first step toward disputing a debt under the FDCPA is a clear and concise letter, sent within 30 days of the initial notice from the debt collector. Medicare Minute "Post AEP Sign Up"

The Annual Enrollment Period (AEP) for 2020 ended on December 7th. This means that, except for a few exceptions, anyone who was on a Medicare prescription drug plan or Medicare Advantage Plan during 2019 will have to wait until next October to make changes to their plan. One such exception is for those who are on Medicare and receiving assistance from the state on their prescription drugs. If you are receiving state assistance on your prescriptions you can make changes any time during the year.

As we have stated before, AEP is only for those people who are already on Medicare and wish to enroll in or make changes to their prescription drug plan or Medicare Advantage Plan for 2020. AEP does not affect anyone who is getting Medicare for the first time in 2020 or is on Medicare and leaving employer coverage in the coming year. Medicare will give you a Special Election Period (SEP) for these situations.

If you are getting Medicare for the first time and not on employer insurance you will have 3 months to sign up for a Medicare plan. The 3 months begins the month after your Medicare becomes effective. If you are leaving employer coverage you will have 60 days to enroll. This time starts the day you leave your employer coverage. Although you will have a SEP for both these situations it's a good idea to have your Medicare plan in place before your SEP begins.

It is also important to remember that AEP does not affect Medicare supplements. You can enroll in or make changes to your Medicare supplement at any time during the year. Keep in mind that you may have to go through underwriting to make changes to your supplement. If you are getting Medicare for the first time or leaving employer coverage you can sign up for the supplement 6 months prior to your coverage starting.

WHY NOT BUDGET AND SAVE?

Dear Dave, I've never heard you talk about store layaway programs. With Christmas coming, 1 wanted to ask your opinion of using layaway for buying gifts.



Dear Meg, If you know me, you probably have a good idea what's coming next. I'm not a huge fan of layaway programs, because they're not the answer to a problem. I mean, Christmas comes at the same time every year. It's not like it snuck up on you. What's wrong with just saving up money for Christmas ahead of time?

Here's a good rule of thumb: if you don't have the money on hand, you can't afford it. Now, sometimes there are instances when certain popular items are on sale, and you can take advantage of them through layaway if you don't have enough cash at that very moment. I don't have a huge problem with this sort of thing, as long as it's not habitual behavior, and you're already saving money and living on a budget. Still, I would never, ever recommend using a layaway plan with fees attached.

It may be too late to budget for this Christmas, but I want you to make plans to start living on a written, monthly budget in January. Make it a resolution! Give every dollar a name, on paper, before the upcoming month begins. You can include Christmas spending in those monthly budgets, too. If you set aside a little bit each month from January until next December, you won't have to worry about layaways or Christmas

Remember, Christmas is about God and it's about love. There are many, many ways to bless people and make them happy without overextending







Some Things Are Beyond Repair!



Unfortunately, I am not a member of that union. Oh, I can tighten a screw and replace a lightbulb occasionally, but my skills are pretty limited as a handyman. However, I have learned a few things from the projects I have taken on through the years. One of the more valuable ones is

determining whether or not something is repairable.

Painfully, I recall a time shortly after we were married when our toilet would not shut off after the tank had refilled. This was one of the older types that had a float on the end of the rod that attached to the filling valve. I remembered someone saying that sometimes you have to replace the float. Thus, I promptly went to K-Mart and purchased a new float and installed it- - but the problem was not solved.

My next bright idea was to bend the rod to put more pressure on the shutoff valve. When I did, the corroded rod broke- - and I headed back to K-Mart. But even with a new float and rod the issue was not resolved. To make a long story short, I spent half the day and a lot more money than was necessary running to K-Mart trying to repair something that needed to be completely replaced from the start.

Perhaps, in principle, we are guilty of handling our spiritual lives the same way. Consider the man that we call, "The Rich Young Ruler." He came to Jesus and asked, "Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do to inherit eternal life?" (Matthew 19:16). He wanted to simply repair something, but his whole outlook on life needed be replaced.

Another case to contemplate is that of Nicodemus, the ruler of the Jews who came to Jesus by night. Nicodemus was impressed with Jesus and no doubt wanted to learn more about getting his life right with God. Jesus did not respond with a "quick-fix" reply. Instead He taught "Unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:1ff). Thus, it was not just a matter of repairing something; it was matter of starting over spiritually.

Christianity has never been a patchwork proposition. To the contrary, the Bible teaches: "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).



My fiancé has approximately \$40,000 in debt. I, on the other hand, will have my mortgage paid off in eighteen months. My car is paid for and I own my own business. We are preparing a prenuptial agreement, but will this protect me from any responsibility for the debts already incurred before the marriage? Charlotte

Muscle Shoals, AL

A dedicated matrimonial lawyer is expensive during a divorce but those attorneys who really know divorce work are invaluable. However, the only time to prepare a prenuptial agreement is before the marriage if a family owned property or business could be jeopardized or if there are

children by a previous marriage. Alabama does not recognize post-marriage agreements as valid.

A valid prenuptial agreement can solve just about any problem foreseen at the time. If you address those issues before marriage, you can resolve those issues regarding property and business interests, debts acquired before marriage, as well as inheritance questions.

But even inheritance questions become tricky if you have a pension through your employer that is governed

If you have a pension through your employer and covered by ERISA (a federal law regulating employee benefits), the prenuptial agreement might not be effective. For example, the plan administrator of a pension will distribute the proceeds from the pension plan under ERISA, and a prenuptial agreement is not considered in determining who the beneficiary is without a valid spousal ERISA waiver.

This recently happened and the trial judge followed the intent of the prenuptial agreement even though the federally governed plan could not do so. This case wound up in the Alabama Supreme Court which ruled that the trial judge had the authority to distribute the funds in the way he saw fit. A state prenuptial agreement does not overcome federal law, although the court was allowed to divide the proceeds under state law.

Again, a good matrimonial lawyer that works with and is familiar with prenuptial agreements and state and federal law regarding pensions would have saved these people a lot of time and trouble.

What repairs should a seller make before putting a house on the market?

This will be eliminating an objection all together, net you more money from the sale and shorten your time on market. Otherwise you've got to adjust the price accordingly. Again, fixer upper means fixer upper price.

Although every situation is different, making repairs or improvements prior to listing your home, especially visual items that buyers will notice right away, will help ensure a successful selling experience. -mr

superstar, Kawhi Leonard knew the importance of hard work. He knew the game wasn't about him; it was about the team. Mr. Leonard is one of my absolute favorite athletes. He rarely shows emotion. He never argues with the refs. And he's a beast when it comes to defense and rebounds.

Modern-day basketball is definitely an offensively orientated game. Maybe that's why your son's coach is so focused on his 'scorers.'

Regardless, I would turn your son's attention in the direction of Kawhi Leonard. Let him watch a few Clippers' (Leonard was traded

as a budding basketball in the offseason) games on television. He's an unselfish player who does all the little things right.

If your son hones his skills on the defensive side of the ball and outworks other players under the rim, maybe he'll finally get his chance to take a few shots. In the end, a team must outscore its opponent to win the game, but don't forget Kawhi's sage advice: "The board man gets paid."




