# IRRMA picks four from area

The Iowa Rock 'n' Roll Music Association will be honoring four area rock 'n' rollers with induction into the Iowa Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame as one of the highlights of its 2020 Induction Weekend, September 5th and 6th.

Induction Weekend, September 5th and 6th.

Two individual performers, drummer Phil Christy, of Spencer; and singer-songwriter Alan Morphew, of Estherville, will both be recognized as individual artists. Connie Valens, of Okoboji, will be honored with the Spirit Award. Valens, the younger sister of rock 'n' roll legend Ritchie Valens, was only 8 years old in 1959, when a Clear Lake plane crash took her brother's life. She now lives in Okoboji, and works promoting



rock 'n' roll music in the region. Valens has also written a book about her brother's legacy.

The fourth honoree is *The Epicurians*, being recognized as a Minnesota border band.

Spencer's Christy, who grew up in Marathon, started his musical career in junior high school. "I was so young I couldn't drive. My mother had to drive us to the jobs," he explained after getting the award notice. Christy performed with *Vegas* and *Spectrum 70*, among others, and noted that he was part of the house band at Vern & Coila's, in West Okoboji, for a long time. He continues music now with the Praise Band at Hope Reformed Church.

IRRMA inducts musicians, bands, disc-jockeys, ballrooms and others who have significantly contributed to rock 'n' roll music in Iowa. Since incorporation, more than 300 entities have had the honor of being inducted. Inductees must have at least 25 years of experience in the music industry. A total of 30 awards will be made this year to individuals and groups from across Iowa and neighboring states.

There have been so many blue moons since we've heard from Stagerat Stan that we had to dig like a hound dog to find his mug shot in our digital archives. After explaining that he's been having trouble finding a warm place to winter, and hoping the warmth of summer



nights is not too distant, Stan said he's hopelessly devoted to keeping you up on the latest from points south. In his travels he has learned that rock 'n' roll is here to stay! (Here's hoping a recent trip to Columbia didn't get him in trouble at Customs...) What he has told us for sure, is that four musical performances are now locked in to the Okoboji Summer Theatre list this year — along with five non-musical shows. That's especially good news after underground currents about squeezing out one musical due to

scheduling concerns. The shows will be announced at Winter Games.

The theme song used until 1962 was *Sentimental Journey*, written by Les Brown, Bud Green, and Ben Homer. When Hugh Downs became the new host in 1962, the opening music changed to *Melodie au Crepuscule*, a jazzy piece by guitarist Django Reinhardt. In 1963 NBC used Errol Garner's *Misty*, played by trumpeter Bobby Hackett to close each day's program...

Thursday is Thesaurus Day. A thesaurus is a book listing words in groups of synonyms. The George and Ira Gershwin song, 'S Wonderful, 'S Marvelous', was introduced in the Broadway musical Funny Face. After waiting for two years to have an English translation of the French lyrics, Kitt recorded a mostly French version for her first RCA-LP, *That Bad Eartha*, and had a hit with the song and the LP. The song was used some 40 years later in commercials for Old Navy clothing stores...


One-time Iowan Phil Everly was born in Chicago on this day in 1939, and was one-half of a singing duo with his older brother, Don, in the late '50s and early '60s. They had big hits with Bye, Bye, Love, and All I Have To Do Is Dream. January 1960 was a particularly lucky month for the siblings, when their hit, Let It Be Me reached the top ten, then in 1962, when Crying in the Rain climbed to Number 6. The world outside is white, and some animals have also changed color for the season.

"It's cool to see how animals change their colors," said naturalist Ashley Hansen. "We as humans don't change our colors." Participants will also learn about some animals that hibernate to get through the chilly winter.

"We don't see animals much in the winter and although we don't see them, they're still around. They could be hiding; they could be hibernating," Hansen said.

Families will then get to take part in a relay about which animals adapt, hibernate or migrate and will also get to make a snowy owl pinecone craft to take home.

Family Nature Night is a free program for all ages held the fourth Friday of each month and has been a popular addition to the nature center's event line-up.

"I really like seeing some of our regulars and getting new families in and engaging with them," Kuhlman said. "We get older kids too --- third, fourth, fifth-graders --- and a good bal-

Each session has a different theme and offers activities that intrigue different ages. February's program will celebrate Leap Day with Leap Into Nature, and the educators are excited for March's Rock Kitchen theme.

"We have a lot of fun themes planned," Hansen said. Each Family Nature Night lasts approximately one hour and is limited to 60 participants, so please call 712-336-6352 to preregister your family and reserve your spot.

# Applicants Sought For Healthcare Scholarship & Loan Programs

Applications are now being accepted for the Bennie B. and Ernestine F. Shine Scholarship, Adam J. Anderson Scholarship, as well as the Cornwall Loan Program. All programs are designed to help area students pursue healthcare careers.

The Shine scholarship fund, administered by Spencer Hospital, annually awards funds to persons who have completed at least one semester of a nursing or allied health program, such as radiology, therapy programs (respiratory care, speech, physical or occupational), medical technology, laboratory tech, paramedic training, pharmacy, etc. These programs are not intended to fund individuals pursuing a degree in medicine, dentistry, physician assistant or veterinary science. The Anderson scholarship fund, administered by Spencer Hospital, annually awards funds to persons living in the Spencer area to pursue education & training to become certified EMS providers (EMT through Paramedic).

Ben Shine was a long-time trustee of the Spencer Hospital Board. His wife, Ernestine Shine, was active in the hospital auxiliary and served as president of that organization. The Shines recognized the importance of quality health care for their community and were actively involved in maintaining a quality and progressive hospital. One effort toward achieving this goal was the establishment of the Shine Scholarship.

The Ruth Cornwall Loan Program was created by Wilson Cornwall in memory of his wife, Ruth, who had received quality hospital care and later home care from Spencer Hospital during an extended illness. The Cornwall family wished to help local people interested in receiving healthcare education. Alow-interest loan program was created. 117 loans have been granted since 1977. During that time over \$122,825 has been loaned to area people involved in health education programs.

The Adam J. Anderson Scholarship was created by Duane Anderson of Webb and Marcia Anderson Taylor of Spencer in memory of their son Adam who died in January 2001 of cancer. Adam had worked as a volunteer on the Terril ambulance crew after graduating from Iowa Lakes Community College and later took a job as an EMT for Spencer Hospital. According to his mother, Adam's goal was to obtain his paramedic certification and he was accepted into paramedic school in August 2000; however, his illness had progressed so much he was unable to attend. The scholarship is intended to honor Adam's memory and his spirit, and to enable others to fulfill the dream to be of service to others as paramedics.

The application deadline for both the Shine & Anderson Scholarship and Cornwall Loan is March 31, 2020. Recipients will be notified of their award in April. 



Steven worked as a bricklayer for NW Iowa Masonry for many years.


He had a hand in constructing many of the schools and hospitals across the state of Iowa. In his spare time he enjoyed fishing and hunting with his dad, but never caught anything.

# Okoboji High School Announces J Term Public Presentation Night

From January 6th-16th, students at Okoboji High School are learning in a very different way. The school is in its third year of a J Term focused on Project Based Learning. Project-Based Learning or PBL, teaches through doing in a hands-on, immersive environment focused on a driving question and connecting students with the world outside the classroom. Over the course of these two weeks, each student has chosen one course on which to focus all of their time and energy. Courses focus on a wide range of topics including wilderness survival, mixed media sculpture, chemistry and physics, fitness and marketing, podcasting, robotics, and more. One class spent time hiking Black Elk Peak in South Dakota. One course dives deep into the world of counter-intelligence and is creating a number of escape rooms throughout the school while another is creating a student-run fashion show. One class will even be screening their own shortfilm festival at the Milford Pioneer Theatre! Most OHS seniors are spending the term completing on-site internships throughout the community. A common focus across all classes has been breaking down the walls that typically divide the school and the larger community in which it exists. 



"It's always fun to learn the names parents select for their babies which often come with a story of why the name was picked or it's simply because the family likes the name," Hasley said. In 2019, the baby names at Spencer Hospital reflected a mix of traditional and unique, with very few duplicate names.

Of the 124 baby boys born in 2019, the names range from Aksel to Wyatt. Wyatt also happened to be one of the more popular boy names for the year, with three babies named Wyatt which ties with the three babies named Lucas. Of the 120 baby girls born at Spencer Hospital, tied for the most popular names were Harper and Olivia at four each followed by Blakely. Several names were bestowed upon at least two babies, including Amelia, Evelyn, Finley, Layla and Mollie for girls, and Arthur, Bennett, Dax, Gabriel, Maverick and Remington for boys, among others.



# Iowa Cold Case to be Featured on Dateline

On January 17, at 8:00pm, Dateline NBC will air a two-hour program regarding the 1992 cold case murder of Corey Wieneke, in West Liberty, Iowa. Wieneke was found bludgeoned to death in his rural home in October of 1992. For twenty-seven years, no one was charged in relation to his death. In 2018, a friend of Corey's, Annette Cahill, was charged with First Degree Murder, after a woman came forward and said she heard Cahill tearfully confess to the

murder in late 1992 (when the witness was then nine years old). Cahill was convicted of Second Degree Murder in September of 2019, at her second trial, although there was no physical evidence linking her to the scene of the crime. She has appealed to the Iowa Supreme Court on the basis of the lack of evidence, and the court's failure to allow DNA testing of the hairs found in Wieneke's hand at his autopsy. The appeal is ongoing.

Cahill was represented by attorneys Clemens Erdahl and Elizabeth Araguas. After Erdahl's sudden death on October 2nd, she is now represented by only Araguas. Araguas is a 2007 graduate of Spirit Lake High School, and the daughter of Curt and Sandie Smith. Araguas sat for an interview with Dateline, which will comprise part of the episode on the case.

# Bill of Sale Required When Transferring Vehicle Titles

"Beginning March 1, 2020, the Dickinson County Treasurer's Office will require a bill of sale from customers when transferring titles for motor vehicles between private parties," says Dickinson County Treasurer Kris Rowley. "A bill of sale or purchase agreement is already required for vehicles purchased from a dealership. This now expands to people buying and selling motor vehicles in private party transactions."

A bill of sale should include the following information:

- Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) Year Make and Model of the vehicle
- •Seller's name and mailing address
- •Buyer's name and mailing address
- •Date of sale
- Purchase price • Signatures of both the buyer and the seller.

"A bill of sale provides information to my office on which car was sold, who it came from and who it went to as well as when the sale took place and what the price of the vehicle was. It ensures a smooth transfer of a vehicle and verifies the purchase price which is critical to Iowa's road fund," says Rowley. "Dickinson County will accept handwritten bills of sale, bills of sale from other counties as well as some other forms of proof of purchase price. The Dickinson County bill of sale form is available online and at the office. It can be found on the Dickinson County website on the Treasurer's Motor Vehicle page at https:// dickinsoncountyiowa.org/motor-vehicle/.'

Making a false statement of the purchase price is a fraudulent practice. Anyone doing so can be assessed a penalty of 75% of the amount of the One-Time Registration Fee that was not paid. This fee, previously known as Use Tax, is 5% of the sales or lease price of the motor vehicle.


