For 39 years, Burn Brae Day Camp has enriched children's lives through the exploration of creative and performing arts, technology, science, sports, swimming and much more.

Burn Brae is located on a beautiful, spacious property in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, that is well shaded and has air-conditioned facilities. Door-to-door transportation is available throughout the counties of Montgomery, Bucks, Philadelphia and the Main Line.

The camp offers a unique

program for boys and girls ages 3 to 15. Parents may choose 2- through 11-week sessions, which can also be nonconsecutive. Burn Brae has a 5:1 camper-to-staff ratio. The staff consists of certified teachers and a full-time registered nurse.

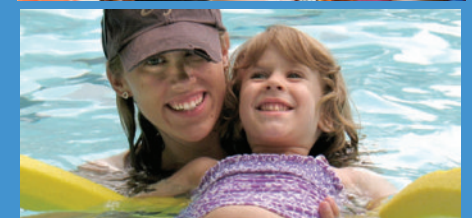

**WHALE CAMP****Campers on whale-watching excursions observe behaviors, collect global data**

It's a time for celebration. A new decade is upon us. The days are getting longer and the year will surely bring new and exciting things. At The Whale Camp, we are also celebrating.

The end of 2019 brought big news: The first right whale calf of the season was sighted with its mother off the coast of Georgia in December. This calf is the first for the 14-year-old mother, a Northern Right Whale known as #3560. She will not be the only one in parenting class, though, as several other pregnant individuals have been spotted.

The Northern Right Whales are a critically endangered population, with a little more than 400 left in the world, so each new baby counts.

Now, how does a group of whales in Georgia relate

to a summer camp on an island off the coast of New Brunswick, Canada? These right whales spend their winters in southern U.S. waters to birth their calves. As summer approaches, the whales begin to migrate north to their feeding grounds. And lucky for The Whale Camp, the Bay of Fundy happens to be one of the best eateries in the North Atlantic.

Many species congregate there in the summer to take advantage of the explosion of plankton and small fish, which are great food sources for humpbacks, fin whales, dolphins, porpoises, basking sharks, seals and of course, the right whales.

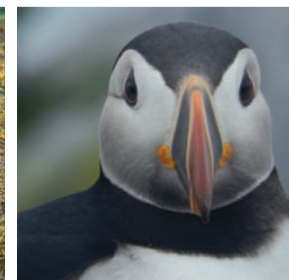

# Strategies to handle conflict, peer pressure at Peace Camp

Conflict is part of being alive and living with others.

During the Peace Camp at Gwynedd Friends, children learn strategies that help them address the issues of conflict and peer pressure. Our emphasis is on peace building: making a difference in the world by creating peaceful, safe friendships and communities and by

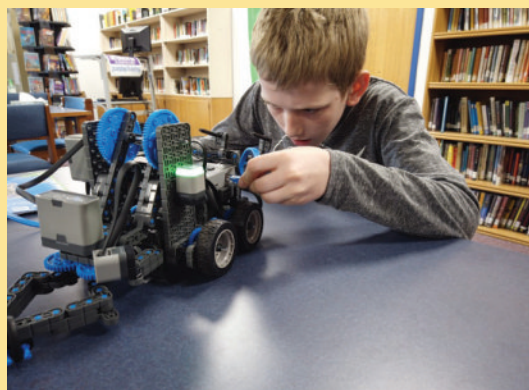

# Consider these factors before choosing summer camp

Adults often look back fondly on their childhood experiences at summer camp. Camps can provide the opportunity to form lifelong friendships and discover rewarding hobbies that can enrich campers' lives for decades to come.

Choosing a summer camp is no small task, as the options at families' disposal range from overnight camps to weekday afternoon camps to camps that specialize in certain programs, such as music or dance.
