



He met up with the bus and indicated to her that she was to follow him while he salted the road and led her to safety. While this was happening, Amie was able to keep the students calm. Being late by this time, other drivers were able to pick up the students still waiting.

If you happen to see Amie, Kevin and other school bus drivers, give thanks, smile or even a handshake. Amie drives for Keshequa and represents hundreds of other drivers that show good judgment in avoiding terrible incidents.

One of the Most Exclusive Art Collections in the Country Found Here!

Did you know that Mount Morris is home to one of the most exclusive art collections in the country? The Genesee Valley Council on the Arts (GVCA), located on the Livingston County Campus, is the caretaker of over 200 pieces of WPA (Works Progress Administration) artwork, one of the largest collections in the nation.

The WPA was a New Deal agency created during FDR's administration, and employed millions of job-seekers to carry out public works projects, including the construction of public buildings and roads. In one project, Federal Project Number One, the WPA employed musicians, artists, writers, actors and directors in large arts, drama, media, and literacy projects. As a result of this initiative, artists were paid to create art which would hang in public buildings throughout the country. Several of these paintings were displayed in Livingston County office buildings and the Tuberculosis Sanitorium on Murray Hill, which was in operation from 1936–1971.

When the Sanitorium closed, most of the paintings in the building were stored away in the basement, where they remained for several years. The paintings were discovered and inventoried in 2001, and now reside in controlled storage at GVCA. The New Deal collection is exhibited on a rotating basis throughout the year. Since these works are over 80 years old, many are in disrepair; GVCA is working with conservators to restore these historic pieces of art.

Aside from the New Deal collection, GVCA administers the Decentralization Grant program for artists in Livingston and Monroe counties through the New York State Council on the Arts. GVCA also exhibits the work of local artists and holds several annual events, including a Member Show, the Genesee Valley Fare and Ware Festival and Artful Holidays.

GVCA is located at 4 Murray Hill Drive in Mount Morris and is open Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday from 11-4, Thursday from 11-7 and Saturday from 11-3. Stop up to see the gallery and check out a bit of history!



Flu Cases are Increasing Protect Yourself and Your Family


