Talk to God - tell him how you feel and what you're


thinking about.

There is only one name we find salvation in and that is Jesus. Will you trust Him today?





Did you know that gardening in the winter and early spring here in lower Alabama has so many advantages? Not having the sweltering heat and humidity means less concern about pests, and the rainy and cloudy days are great for green vegetables such as asparagus, broccoli, celery, collards, mustard greens, lettuce, onions, spinach, and sweet peas, which thrive now. This is also a good time for beets, radishes and turnips. This is the time to plant them. Many of these are frost resistant but check your seed packets to be sure. You can even give seeds an earlier start indoors, gradually moving them into sunny areas



outdoors. Make sure your soil has some composted materials, like dead leaves and pine straw, and it drains well.



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


# **Good Samaritan?**

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
