LADIES ON A MISSION: A POTATO FUNDRAISER FOR HAITI

They come from different churches and different walks of life. None had previous experience in foreign mission work. All work and save up their money to pay for their travel. In different ways, each finds joy and fulfillment during the trip, despite the less-than-luxurious travel and rooming arrangements, complete lack of electricity and running water and very primitive environment they work in. They are there to bless the people, but each expressed they themselves are the ones who are blessed the most by the joyful and grateful Haitian villagers. You can help by attending a Potato Fundraiser on February 3 in Sulphur Springs.

These women are seeking to raise money for villagers in Haiti. The Potato Fundraiser is one way that the four local women pull together to raise funds for their Haitian mission. It will be held at First Baptist Church on Monday February 3, 2020 starting at 11am. Baked potatoes with the trimmings as well as pulled pork sandwiches will be prepared and sold. The cost is \$6 per potato lunch or \$8 for potato with pulled pork sandwich. You can pre-order by calling First Baptist Church.

The four missionaries are people you probably already know. They are Cindy Lancaster, Gail Bain, Yvonne King and Sandy Mullens. Each Spring, they travel at their own expense to assist in Bohoc and other remote villages in Haiti, one of the poorest nations on the planet. They are among many groups sponsored by Amanda Picott and Psalm139LOVE, traveling to the mission fields in planes provided through Missionary Flights, International. Here is a bit about these women and the sponsoring organizations which arrange trips and transportation for thousands of missionaries like them each year.

Gail Bain is taking her twelfth trip to Haiti in February 2020. Sometimes she goes twice a year! "The Lord laid it on my heart to go and help, and Haiti is where he led me". Gail is a member of Shannon Oaks Church and says "my trips to Haiti have made me a better servant back here at home. In America, we may complain or grumble about our income or things we'd like to have. These people are just joyful and grateful for anything and everything!"

Sandy Mullens is a member of League Street Church of Christ and recently moved back to Sulphur Springs. She feels that the Vacation Bible School and the English they teach daily is one of the biggest ways the children are reached. "The kids are so happy when they receive anything, even a sticker on the back of their hand for doing a good job that day. And they sit so still and listen for hours, and are never disruptive or disrespectful."

Cindy Lancaster is a member of St. James Catholic Church and will be taking off soon for her fourth trip to Haiti. "Knowing these people humbles me, makes me more faithful and prayerful. And it makes me more frugal! When you're over there, any big problems you have seem like such small problems, compared with the challenges they face daily for basic needs."

Yvonne King, a member of First Baptist Church stated, "It makes me a better person. Since I'm now a Senior citizen, in the back of my mind all the time when we are working I think about the old people in the villages. They have no meds to take for the aches and pains of old age. Not even an aspirin! And no eyeglasses! No medical, dental or vision care is provided or even available in the villages, and if there was, they couldn't afford it. Many don't live long lives, most not past age 70. Yet for the most part, they are happy, loving and giving people."

The Potato Fundraiser is one way that the four local missionaries pull together to raise funds for the Haitian mission. It will be held at First Baptist Church on Monday February 3, 2020 starting at 11am. Baked potatoes with the trimmings as well as pulled pork sandwiches will be prepared and sold. The cost is \$6 per potato lunch or \$8 for potato with pulled pork sandwich. You can pre-order by calling First Baptist Church. Deliveries can be made that day with an order of two or more lunches. Funds from the Potato Fundraiser go toward the purchase of Food Baskets of staples for village families. Each "basket" or box weighs about 70 pounds and will last a family one month. "We'd like to have money to distribute lots of these baskets while we are there in February. This way, we see what the people receive and how our help can improve their lives." 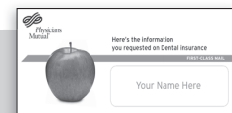

Heart disease is the leading cause of death for both American men and women. African American men are especially susceptible. So it's good news that **February is National Heart Month**, since it inspires us to examine one of the most pressing health concerns in the United States and to make positive changes to our lifestyles.

February also hosts Valentine's Day, which is all about affairs of the heart, *so it's a good match.*

Symptoms of a Heart Attack

- Uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain in the center of your chest. It lasts more than a few minutes or goes away and comes back.
- Pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.
- Shortness of breath with or without chest discomfort.
- Other signs such as breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea or lightheadedness.

As with men, women's most common heart attack symptom is chest pain or discomfort. But women are somewhat more likely than men to experience some of the other common symptoms, particularly shortness of breath, nausea/vomiting and back or jaw pain.

Symptoms of a Stroke

- Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden trouble seeing or blurred vision in one or both eyes
- Sudden trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden severe headache with no known cause

If you have any of these signs, call 9-1-1 and get to a hospital right away.

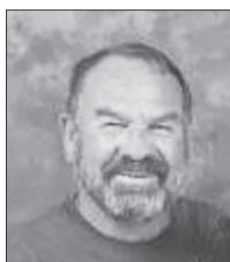
Garry Crowson

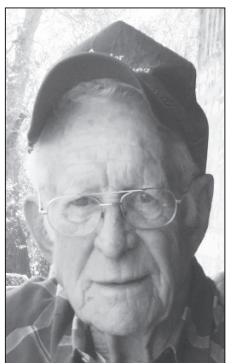

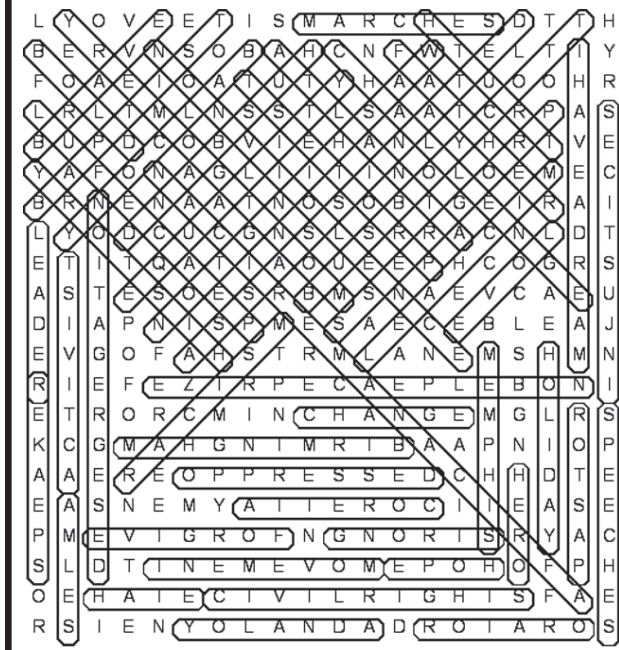

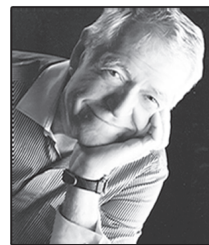

THE MENNONITE MIGRATION

Tumbleweed Smith



A pickup truck crowded with nearly a dozen Mennonites left El Paso in 1977. When it reached a hill west of Seminole there was a big sigh of relief and the driver, when he saw the valley below, told his passengers, "We are Home."

It had been a long journey scattered over several years and several countries. Throughout history in country after country the Mennonites had been promised special dispensations from the various governments regarding taxes, religious freedom and l.

and ownership. When those were removed the Mennonites became vagabonds looking for a home

Mennonites are followers of Menno Simons, a former Catholic who disagreed with the church's insistence on infant baptism. He thought baptism should come when a person was old enough to make decisions. He also believed in pacifism. Menno lived from 1496 to 1561 in the Netherlands. Mennonites were given exemption from military service if they used their skills to reclaim some low land on the coast. When that ended the Mennonites were without religious freedom. Some were persecuted. They fled to Poland, then Russia, the US, Canada, Mexico, Paraguay and other countries. Today Antarctica is the only continent without Mennonites. They are quick to point out that they are members of a religion. They are not an ethnic group.

Tina Siemens lives in Seminole. She and 550 other Mennonites got to Seminole in the seventies. Tina and her husband own a construction business and Tina is active in the community, serving on both the hospital and chamber of commerce boards of directors. In November of 2015 she was named Seminole's citizen of the year.

Tina has documented the Mennonite migration to Seminole in a book titled SEMINOLE (SOME PEOPLE NEVER GIVE UP). In researching material for her book, she collected every national story she could find about the frustrations and setbacks her group encountered in moving between Canada, Mexico and the US. There is no shortage of reporting on the subject. She has huge scrapbooks of write-ups in the New York Times, Houston Chronicle, Dallas Morning News and many other publications including the Seminole Sentinel, which covered the story in a professional manner. It is a story that captured the American public and the Mennonites found much support in their plight. Even after the group got to Seminole there were worries they would be deported. Border patrol buses lined up around the courthouse ready to haul them out of the country. But after congress passed a special bill especially for those 550 people they finally became US citizens in 1986 and have been productive members of Gaines County ever since. Because of their farming expertise they have made the county a leader in agriculture. Tina herself says it was a roller coaster for many years. "But you look back on those experiences and realize that's what makes us strong. We persevered, went through the hard times and learned lots of things. The struggle has made us appreciate being Americans. I truly can say from the bottom of my heart I am an American. I have achieved the American dream."

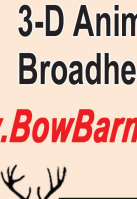
