

Jesse Belle Rittenhouse Honored at Dedication

Local Writer Leaves a Legacy



On Sunday, October 29, 2019, the Town of Mount Morris held a dedication ceremony to honor Tuscarora native Jesse Belle Rittenhouse. Thanks to local resident Terry Montgomery, who researched Rittenhouse and her contributions, a commemorative sign was sponsored by the Wm. Pomeroy Foundation and placed near McArthur Road, the location of her family's farm.

According to her autobiography, "My House of Life," Jesse Belle's love of literature was evident early as she walked miles to attend the local one room schoolhouse. Her recollection of Christmas at her grandfather's house in Tuscarora is a vivid picture of a bygone era.

After graduation, she briefly taught school, but soon began her literary career, reviewing books in both Rochester and Buffalo. She then became a reporter for the Rochester D & C. However, her real love was poetry. She went on to author four books which were: The Door of Dreams (1918), The Lifted Cup (1921), The Secret Bird (1930) and Moving Tide: New and Selected Lyrics (1939).

In 1914, Jesse helped found the Poetry Society of America and was its first secretary. Later she taught poetry at Rollins College and received the first Robert Frost Medal for her influence on modern poetry. She died in 1948.

Along with Assemblywoman Marjorie Byrnes and Supervisor DiPasquale, the Rittenhouse Family was in attendance to honor this important piece of the Town's history. Thanks to Ron Powell, an extensive family tree was presented to Jesse's remaining relatives.

The McArthur Family came to the United States around 1800 from Inverness, Scotland and landed in Connecticut. After first settling in the Mohawk Valley, they moved to Tuscarora, New York.

McArthur Road, now abandoned farmland, is an important part of the Jesse Belle Rittenhouse story. It is named for her grandfather, John McArthur, (Jesse's mother's father) and appears on early town maps.


John built a log cabin and a sawmill on the Keshequa Creek and became a farmer as well as a major contractor for the Genesee Valley Canal.

In 1868, Jesse's mother and father bought the farm, where they raised their family. However, most of the McArthur Family moved to Cheboygan, Michigan to expand their businesses in lumber and contracting.

Jesse Belle Rittenhouse joins other famous Town of Mount Morris natives who contributed to our rich American heritage. She is Positively Tuscarora!







Fraud Advisory: Inspector General Warns Public about New Twist to Social Security Phone Scams

The Inspector General of Social Security, Gail S. Ennis, is warning the public that telephone scammers may send faked documents by email to convince victims to comply with their demands. The Social Security Administration Office of the Inspector General (OIG) has received reports of victims who received emails with attached letters and reports that appeared to be from Social Security or Social Security OIG. The letters may use official letterhead and government "jargon" to convince victims they are legitimate; they may also contain misspellings and grammar mistakes.

This is the latest variation on Social Security phone scams, which continue to be widespread throughout the United States. Using robocalls or live callers, fraudsters pretend to be government employees and claim there is identity theft or another problem with one's Social Security number, account, or benefits. They may threaten arrest or other legal action, or may offer to increase benefits, protect assets, or resolve identity theft. They often demand payment via retail gift card, cash, wire transfer, internet currency such as Bitcoin, or pre-paid debit card.

Inspector General Ennis urges continued vigilance against all types of phone scams no matter what "proof" callers may offer. As we continue to increase public awareness of phone scams, criminals will come up with new ways to convince people of their legitimacy. Social Security will never:

- threaten you with arrest or other legal action unless you immediately pay a fine or fee;
- · promise a benefit increase or other assistance in exchange for payment;
- · require payment by retail gift card, cash, wire transfer, internet currency, or prepaid debit card; or
- · send official letters or reports containing personally identifiable information via email.

If there is ever a problem with your Social Security number or record, in most cases Social Security will mail you a letter. If you do need to submit payments to Social Security, the agency will send a letter with instructions and payment options. You should never pay a government fee or fine using retail gift cards, cash, internet currency, wire transfers, or pre-paid debit cards. The scammers ask for payment this way because it is very difficult to trace and recover.

If you receive a call or email that you believe to be suspicious, about a problem with your Social Security number or account, hang up or do not respond. We encourage the public to report Social Security phone scams using our dedicated online form, at https://oig.ssa.gov. Please share this information with your friends and family, to help spread awareness about phone scams.






