HOLLYWOOD — Lucille Ball, who died in 1989, will be the subject of an Amazon film written by the great Aaron Sorkin and starring two-time Oscar-winning actress Cate Blanchett as Lucy. He's upcoming in "Inherit the Viper," with **Bruce Dern**; "The Long Ride Home," directed and starring James Franco, with Timothy Hutton, Courtney Love and Ashton Kutcher; "Valley of the Gods," with John Malkovich, John Rhys-Davies and Keir Dullea; and "Gut Instinct" with Jim Gaffigan and Stephen McHattie. Hartnett will next be directed by Guy Ritchie in "Cash Truck," starring Scott Eastwood and Jeffrey Donovan.

Donovan, who disappeared after









PIEDMONT PETS

Many years ago, our cat adoption policy was changed to require cats adopted from us to be kept strictly inside. We received criticism about it, but now most shelters require the same thing for the cats in their shelter.

However, many, many shelters in Virginia now treat cats as if they were wildlife. They either do not accept them or they believe that cats should be sterilized and put back on the streets. We simply do not agree. We believe cats deserve the same protections as dogs (and all other companion animals, by the way).

It is vital to keep cats inside. Outside cats face many dangers, and their life expectancy is 1-5 years. A cat kept strictly inside has an average life expectancy of 12-20 years.

Contact with other cats outside leads to the risk of disease transmission. Feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency are transmitted from cat to cat and, once contracted, result in the eventual death of the animal.

Dogs and other wild animals pose a threat to cats; the very real danger is one of exposure to rabies. Outdoor cats can suffer torn ears, cut eyes, abscesses, and other injuries requiring veterinary treatment.

Indoor cats are not generally exposed to fleas, ticks, ear mites, or other parasites that can cause anemia, skin irritations, allergic reactions, and even death.

Outdoor cats are at risk to be poisoned. Neighbors may deliberately poison cats they view as nuisances, but accidental poisonings also occur. Chemically treated lawns, bait left out to kill rats or mice, and antifreeze can all be deadly dangers.

It is a myth that cats are "streetwise." Cats are intelligent and alert, but they stand very little chance against traffic.

It is almost impossible to list all of the hazards faced by cats that are allowed to go outside; we have hundreds of pictures of ones that have been injured, killed, tortured, or have become sick.





SURVEY WORK BEGINS FOR PROPOSED HISTORIC DISTRICT

Schoolfield will be getting more foot traffic in the neighborhood over the next coming months. This February through the summer, historic surveyors will be photographing and documenting buildings within the former Dan River Mills village, which has recently been deemed eligible as a state and nationally recognized historic district.

Last December, Virginia's Department of Historic Resources determined that the Schoolfield Historic District is eligible for listing on the Virginia Landmarks Register and the National Register of Historic Places. This is purely an honorary designation that places no restrictions on property owners beyond current local zoning. The designation will help to promote awareness and appreciation of the neighborhood and its history.

The history of Schoolfield is tied to Dan River Mills, which founded the village for its textile workers in 1903. Until 1951 when the City of Danville annexed the Schoolfield, Dan River owned and controlled the village. Schoolfield includes 840 homes, churches, an industrial site, executive offices, a commercial area as well as two previously listed properties, the former Welfare Building (https://www.dhr.virginia.gov/historic-registers/108-5065-0083/) and the Schoolfield School Complex (https://www.dhr.virginia.gov/historic-registers/108-5065-0081/)

The Danville Office of Economic Development and the Industrial Development Authority of Danville, VA have hired Storied Capital, Hill Studio, and Burton Consulting to complete a building-by-building survey of these areas, which is the first step in pursuing the National Register listing. The field survey involves documenting the exterior of the buildings with photographs and field notes. This documentation will take place from the public sidewalks and alleyways. Interior access to houses is not necessary. Field documentation will take place over the winter and spring of 2020.

When complete, all survey information will be available to the public at the City offices and at the archives of the Virginia Department of Historic Resources. If residents have questions about the survey or historic information related to properties within the district, they may contact Renee Burton, burtotr@danvilleva.gov.

Properties that are considered contributing to the district will be eligible for the state and federal historic rehabilitation tax credit programs. These tax credits assist with redevelopment costs of historic buildings. More information on the Historic Registers and the Tax Incentives is available on the Virginia Department of Historic Resources website at www.dhr.virginia.gov.

To learn more about this survey process, the public is welcome to attend a community meeting on February 7th from 5:30 pm until 7 pm at 917 West Main Street, the historic Welfare Building in Schoolfield. The meeting will begin with refreshments, followed by an overview presentation about the survey at 6 pm and public Q&A. Registration is not required, but RSVPs are welcome. 




and it makes me feel good."

Long-Term Care: A Nursing Home Is Just One Option!

When we think of long-term care, most of us immediately think of the nursing home. While that is still the overwhelming option that most folks utilize, it is not the only option to think about. Which means, you should be thinking of long-term care options a lot sooner in the process!

Most folks have very little idea of the options that are available when planning for long-term care. I have many clients that do not come to see our firm until a parent or loved one is already in skilled care (rehab) or custodial care (nursing home). Yet, when I hear about what has been going on previously, the family missed opportunities for care because they simply did not know possible alternatives even existed!

Whenever we finish a document execution for clients, we always urge them to return if and when someone's health begins to deteriorate. Why? Because we want folks to know the options available to them and in many cases, these options can delay or even alleviate the need for nursing home care. At the very least, we can put off nursing home care as a last resort. We also warn them against any steps that they might take that could jeopardize eligibility for long-term care coverage later.

Caregivers

Often the first step folks might take is to hire extra help for the home. This could be in the form of just a sitter or an experienced nurse that sits with elders either as their primary occupation or on the side. No matter, if you or your family hires the person, you just became an employer, and they just became your employee. It is now your responsibility to comply with all tax laws (deductions) applicable to all employers. I have seen many folks make the huge mistake of hiring a sitter and paying them in cash. Not only will that potentially get you in trouble with the IRS, it will jeopardize future eligibility for long-term care coverage under Medicaid.

Further, if you hire an employee, you have to have a written and signed personal services contract between you and that sitter. This is a requirement under the medicaid regulations. If you do not, Medicaid will treat all the money you have spent on caregivers as if you just simply gave that money away! It's harsh, but that is the rule at this time. We help folks set up a proper caregiver agreement so as to be in compliance with all the laws and avoid this unexpected and unwelcome issue.

Note that, if you hire a sitter through an agency, the agreement and tax compliance is not required, as the caregiver is an employee of that agency and not your family.

So, if you are thinking of hiring a caregiver or sitter to help care for an aging loved one, do your due diligence and put the right plan in place.

Community Based Care

Community based care (CBC) through Virginia Medicaid is a program virtually no one knows exists! Once eligible, CBC will provide a caregiver in the home for up to forty hours a week. In many cases, this is enough help so that the family can put a plan in place that will keep the elder out of the nursing home for a period of time, perhaps even eliminating the need for nursing home care!

The criteria and eligibility requirements are virtually identical to nursing home Medicaid. Just think, this may be the help that you need that will allow your spouse or parent to remain in the home as long as medically possible! Plus, it's cheaper for Medicaid to help you keep your loved one at home than it is to pay for nursing home care, so it is a win-win for all concerned.

Private Homes

Scattered throughout Southside Virginia are private homes that have been licensed by the state to provide care for up to eight elders. There are also homes that do not accept Medicaid but still provide lower costs than a traditional nursing home. Families often opt for this type of care so as to keep their loved one in a home environment. Once again, few know of this option unless they have direct contact with one. Assisted Living

At times, an elder will need help but they still do not meet the criteria for either CBC or nursing home care. In that case, many families look to assisted living facilities for help. These facilities are predominantly private pay, which means that there is no Medicaid coverage available to help pay the costs. The one benefit that is helpful here is if the elder is a qualifying veteran. If so, he or she may be eligible for Veteran's Aid and Attendance. In these cases, most assisted living facilities can help with the application for benefits.

The key to remember is that there are options available and pitfalls to avoid. If you see a loved one's health deteriorating, please contact a qualified and certified Elder Law Attorney to discuss the options available for your family.

What Are the 2020 **Income Tax Filing** Requirements for **Retirees?**

Dear Savvy Senior,

What are the IRS income tax filing requirements for seniors this year? I didn't file a tax return last year because my 2018 income was below the filing requirements, but I got a part-time job late last year in 2019, so I'm wondering if I need to file this vear.

Semi-Retired

Dear Semi.

Whether or not you are required to file a federal income tax return this year depends not only on how much you earned last year (in 2019), but also the source of that income, as well as your age and your filing status.

Here's a rundown of this tax season's IRS tax filing requirement thresholds. For most people, this is pretty straightforward. If your 2019 gross income - which includes all taxable income, not counting your Social Security benefits, unless you are married and filing separately - was below the threshold for your filing status and age, you may not have to file. But if it's over, you will.

Single: \$12,200 (\$13,850 if you're 65 or older by Jan. 1, 2020).

Married filing jointly: \$24,400 (\$25,700 if you or your spouse is 65 or older; or \$27,000 if you're both over 65).

Married filing separately: \$12,200 at any

Head of household: \$18,350 (\$20,000 if age 65 or older).

Qualifying widow(er) with dependent child: \$24,400 (\$25,700 if age 65 or older).

To get a detailed breakdown on federal filing requirements, along with information on taxable and nontaxable income, call the IRS at 800-829-3676 and ask them to mail you a free copy of the "Tax Guide for Seniors" (publication 554) or see IRS.gov/ pub/irs-pdf/p554.pdf.

Check Here Too

There are, however, some other financial situations that can require you to file a tax return, even if your gross income falls below the IRS filing requirements. For example, if you earned more than \$400 from self-employment in 2019, owe any special taxes like an alternative minimum tax, or get premium tax credits because you, your spouse or a dependent is enrolled

in a Health Insurance Marketplace

(Obamacare) plan, you'll need to file.

You'll also need to file if you're receiving Social Security benefits, and one-half of your benefits plus your other gross income and any taxexempt interest exceeds \$25,000, or \$32,000 if you're married and filing jointly.

To figure all this out, the IRS offers an interactive tax assistant tool on their website that asks a series of questions that will help you determine if you're required to file, or if you should file because you're due a refund. It takes less than 15 minutes to complete.

You can access this tool at IRS.gov/ help/ita - click on "Do I Need to File a Tax Return?" Or, you can get assistance over the phone by calling the IRS helpline at 800-829-1040. You can also get face-to-face help at a Taxpayer Assistance Center. See IRS. gov/localcontacts or call 800-829-1040 to locate a center near you.

Check Your State

Even if you're not required to file a federal tax return this year, don't assume that you're also excused from filing state income taxes. The rules for your state might be very different. Check with your state tax agency before concluding that you're entirely in the clear. For links to state tax agencies see Taxadmin.org/state-taxagencies.

Tax Preparation Help

If you find that you do need to file a tax return this year, you can get help through the Tax Counseling for the Elderly (or TCE) program. Sponsored by the IRS, TEC provides free tax preparation and counseling to middle and low-income taxpayers, age 60 and older. Call 800-906-9887 or visit IRS.treasury.gov/freetaxprep to locate a service near you.

Also check with AARP, a participant in the TCE program that provides free tax preparation at more than 4,800 sites nationwide. To locate an AARP Tax-Aide site call 888-227-7669 or visit AARP.org/findtaxhelp. You don't have to be an AARP member to use this service.

WASHINGTON, DC, Jan 31 -- "Beyond a medical diagnosis of disease, the aches and pains of growing old can be worrisome. But the growing numbers of patients who have actually been diagnosed with dementia, including Alzheimer's Disease, can cause concern among America's aging population at large," says Dan Weber, president of the Association of Mature American Citizens [AMAC].

Most of the time, forgetfulness is just that: forgetfulness, as Weber describes it. In fact, neuroscientist and author Daniel J. Levitin points out that we've got a lot more to think about with each passing year.

Levitin puts it this way: "older adults have to search through more memories than do younger adults to find the fact or piece of information they're looking for. Your brain becomes crowded with memories and information. It's not that you can't remember — you can — it's just that there is so much more information to sort through. A 2014 study found that this 'crowdedness' effect also shows up in computer simulations of human memory systems."

The German physician Alois Alzheimer was the first scientist to describe the disease that bears his name in 1906. But it wasn't until the '70s and '80s that Alzheimer's began to be recognized as something of a scourge.

"Indeed," says Weber, "Nearly six million Americans suffer from Alzheimer's Disease and, as the Alzheimer's Association predicts, that number is poised rise to some 14 million over the next three decades."

The question is, when is a lapse of memory just part of life and when is it a sign of the impending onset of Alzheimer's Disease? According to the National Institute on Aging, "Forgetfulness can be a normal part of aging. As people get older, changes occur in all parts of the body, including the brain. As a result, some people may notice that it takes longer to learn new things, they don't remember information as well as they did, or they lose things like their glasses. These usually are signs of mild forgetfulness, not serious memory problems, like Alzheimer's disease."

But the Alzheimer's Association says that if your forgetfulness is disrupting your life, it may be time to see a doctor. In an online paper entitled, 10 Early Signs and Symptoms of Alzheimer's, the association describes the differences between forgetfulness and disease.

The paper explains that age-related lapses include:

- Making occasional errors when managing finances or household bills
- Sometimes forgetting names or appointments but remembering them
- Occasionally needing help to use microwave settings or to record a TV show
- Getting confused about the day of the week but figuring it out later
- Sometimes having trouble finding the right word
- Misplacing things from time to time and retracing steps to find them
- Making a bad decision or mistake once in a while, like neglecting to change the oil in the car
- Sometimes feeling uninterested in family or social obligations
- Developing very specific ways of doing things and becoming irritable when a routine is disrupted

- The Alzheimer's paper suggests that signs of the disease as we grow older include:
- Memory loss that disrupts daily life
- Challenges in planning
- or solving problems




