READER'S Recipe



MOLASSES SHOO-FLY CAKE (Molasses Crumb Pie)

- | | |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| 3/4 cup flour | 1/4 teaspoon salt |
| 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar | 2 tablespoons shortening (Pastry below; use 1/2 recipe) |
| 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon | 1/2 cup molasses |
| 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves | 3/4 cup boiling water |
| 1/8 teaspoon ground ginger | 1-1/2 teaspoon baking soda |
| 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg | 1 egg yolk, well beaten |

Mix together the first seven ingredients. Cut in the shortening with pastry blender or two knives until mixture is crumbly. Set aside. Line a 9-in. pie pan with pastry. Combine four remaining ingredients. Alternate layers of crumbs and liquid mixture in the pastry shell, ending with crumbs. Bake at 450° F 10 min. Reduce heat to 350° F; bake about 20 min. longer, or until firm. *One 9-in pie*

PASTRY

|---------------------|--------------------------------|
| 3 cups sifted flour | 1 cup lard or other shortening |
| 1 teaspoon salt | 5 tablespoons cold water |

Sift the flour and salt together. Cut in the lard with pastry blender or two knives until pieces are the size of small peas. Gradually sprinkle water over mixture, mixing lightly with a fork after each addition; add only enough water to hold pastry together. Roll out on a floured surface and fit into pie pan. Don't stretch pastry when fitting into pan, as this will cause shrinkage in finished product. Use as directed in pie recipes. *Enough for two or three 1-crust pies or one 2-crust pie.*

The Guide To Choosing Groomsmen

Grooms-to-be face many decisions regarding their pending nuptials, but few may prove as delicate as choosing the groomsmen for the big day. 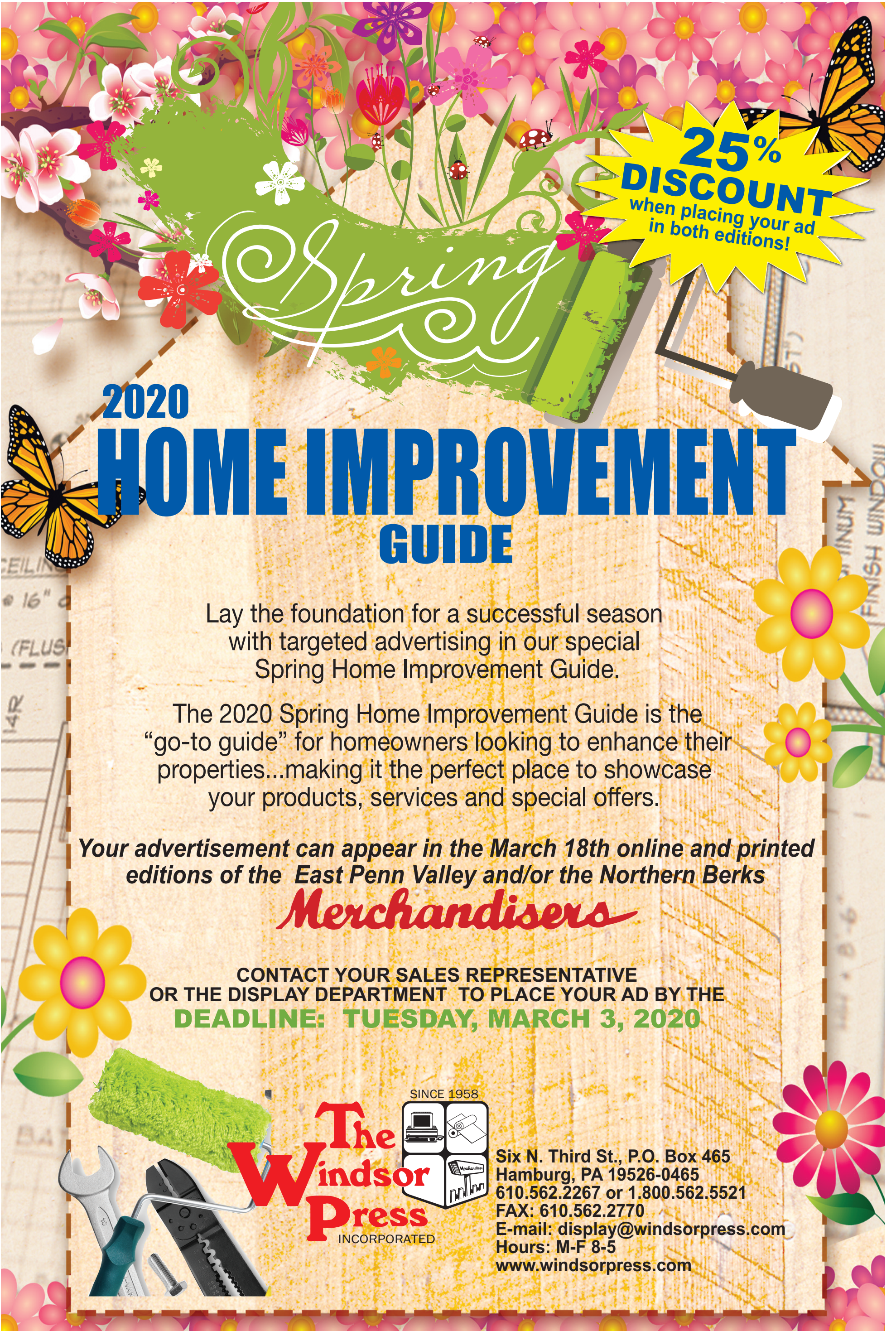

Master The Wedding With Save-The-Date Cards

Many couples' weddings take more than a year to plan. Couples want all of the special people in their lives to witness their vows, and giving guests advance notice can ensure as many loved ones as possible attend the ceremony.

To be certain that guests have ample notice to clear their schedules, many couples now turn to save-the-date cards, which announce weddings well in advance of the actual wedding day.

Save-the-date cards once were reserved only for weddings that required travel or special circumstances, such as destination weddings. But such cards have now become commonplace for all weddings. That's because many people plan vacations or business trips anywhere from four to six months in advance. Save-the-date cards require couples to assemble their guest lists well in advance of the wedding. The leading bridal resource The Knot notes that everyone who will get a wedding invitation should also receive a save-the-date card. There's no turning back once cards are sent, so

couples will need to be certain everyone they want to attend is getting advanced notice.

It's acceptable to mail save-the-date cards even if some wedding day details are still up in the air. Guests really only need to know the date and location of the wedding. Couples also can use the save-the-date card to direct invitees to a wedding website where guests can learn the details of the wedding as they unfold.

RSVP information does not need to be included on the save-the-date card.

Save-the-date cards are much less formal than invitations, so couples can have fun with them. They can showcase couples' clever personalities or funny quirks. Keep in mind it is in poor taste to mention gifts or registries on save-the-date cards. There will be plenty of time to direct guests to registries later on.

Couples are increasingly turning to save-the-date cards when planning their weddings to make sure busy friends and family will have enough time to make plans to attend their weddings.

Getting Here To There On Your Wedding Day

You've planned the date, met with the officiant, decided on what to wear, and booked the venue. But how are you going to arrive in style? Arranging wedding transportation can be tricky, even if it seems like it's a relatively minor detail. However, getting not only the bride and groom, as well as the rest of the bridal party and guests, from point A to point B and even point C is often a taller task than it seems. The wedding planning resource The Knot says couples should begin focusing on transportation between four and six months before their weddings. If the wedding will be held during prom or graduation season, couples may want to reserve vehicles even earlier due to high demand. While rented transportation is not necessary, it's a luxury many couples prefer, as it allows them to leave the driving to someone else. Generally speaking, hired cars will pick up the bride and groom separately before the ceremony; otherwise, they will arrive to the ceremony by other means and then utilize a limo or other vehicle afterward. The transportation will then take the married couple and typically members of the bridal party and immediate family to the reception venue. Depending on the head count and how many other people will be getting a lift, two or more vehicles may be necessary. And since the limos will leave after the reception drop off, some other form of transportation will be necessary to take the couple and whomever else rode to the reception back home (or to the airport). This may require dropping



off one or more personal cars at the reception venue in advance. Budget also will dictate if transportation is provided for other guests. The majority of guests will drive their own cars to the wedding. However, if the ceremony and reception site are far apart or if the journey is arduous and out of the way, some well-meaning couples will arrange for transport. Many times couples will have to opt for function over form when tasked with transporting a large number of people. Pricing out different options can yield the most cost-effective route, which very well may be a school or charter bus instead of several limousines. Couples can start the process by asking their reception venue for transportation recommendations. Or if there are hotel accommodations after the party, the hotel may have connections or offer shuttle services.

Wedding Registry Tips

items on their wedding registries, however, the couples' parents and other close relatives may be honored to purchase more expensive items, so couples should not feel embarrassed to include them on their lists.

- VARY THE PRICES OF ITEMS ON THE LIST. In addition to including more expensive items on the registry, make sure to include moderately priced and inexpensive items. This gives guests more options and ensures guests who might be spending a lot to travel to and from the wedding can still purchase gifts without digging too much deeper into their pockets. Periodically update your registries to remove items you have already received and to add items if many of the less expensive ones have already been purchased. This also makes things more convenient for guests.
