HOLLYWOOD — Meryl Streep's next films are HBO Max's "Let Them All Talk," for director Steven Soderbergh, with Candice Bergen, Dianne Wiest and Lucas Hedges, and Netflix's "The Prom," a film version of the Broadway musical. Her co-stars are Nicole Kidman, Andrew Rannells and Kerry Washington.

During the Golden Age of Hollywood, studio moguls ran megastudios and actors were under exclusive contracts to appear just in their films. But today, for a superstar to remain on top they have to produce films for themselves and others. There are eight superstars who have been successful producing films that grossed well over \$200 million each.

George Clooney says he'd rather produce than act, and his most successful production was "Argo," a Best Picture Oscar winner that grossed \$232 million. His next producing project is Netflix's "Good Morning Midnight," with **Felicity Jones** and **Kyle Chandler**.

Kevin Costner produced and starred in "Dances With Wolves," a Best Picture Oscar winner that grossed \$424 million. He returned two years later with "The Bodyguard," which grossed \$411 million, and then "Water World" (\$241 million). Costner is currently producing the third season of "Yellowstone" for the Paramount Network.

Tom Cruise's "Mission: Impossible" franchise films are always high grossers. The totals for the six films so far: 1. \$458 million, 2. \$546 million, 3. \$398 million, 4. \$695 million, 5. \$683 million and 6. \$791 million. In addition, Cruise also produced "Vanilla Sky" (\$203 million), "The Others" (\$210 million), "Last Summer" (\$457 million) and "Jack Reacher" (\$218 million). "Top Gun" is due June 26, and "Mission: Impossible" 7 and 8 are due in 2021 and 2022.

Leonardo DiCaprio produced and starred in "The Aviator" (\$214 million) and "The Wolf of Wall Street" (\$393 million). Clint Eastwood won a best director Oscar for "Million Dollar





Baby," which grossed \$217 million, and directed "Gran Torino" (\$270 million), "American Sniper" (\$547 million) and "Sully" (\$241 million).

Mel Gibson scored big producing 'Braveheart" (\$210 million) and "The Passion of the Christ" (\$622 million). He's now producing "The Passion of the Christ: Resurrection" for 2021. Brad Pitt produced "The Departed" (\$291 million), "Eat, Pray, Love" (\$206 million) and "World War Z" (\$540 million). His next is "Blonde," with Ana de Armas and Adrien Brody.

But believe it or not, Bradley Cooper crushed them all with "Silver Lining Playbook" (\$236 million), "American Hustle" (\$251 million), "American Sniper" (\$547 million), "A Star Is Born" (\$425 million) and a slam dunk with "Joker," at over \$1.2 billion, which he'll share with director Todd Phillips and co-producer Emma Tillinger Koskoff. Cooper is currently producing the World War II drama "Atlantic Wall," an untitled Hulk Hogan biopic with Chris Hemsworth, and one with himself as Leonard Bernstein in a biopic. With grosses like that, who needs to act?

Answering Your Safety & Security Questions

Question: I get a lot of calls and emails from companies selling security systems, so how do I choose the best one?

Chances are, you are receiving phone calls, emails, texts, or mailers from companies selling security systems.

Usually these contacts are from out of town, out of state companies making random robo calls and electronic contacts. While there are good companies out there, it's hard to know for sure unless you do some digging into their business.

A good place to start is the Better Business Bureau. Check online at bbb.org Do they have an A+ Rating, or do they have so many unresolved complaints that they have a D or F Rating ?



Also verify with your State Security Business Licensing Agencies that the security companies contacting you are operating legally within your state.

Also when considering your security system provider, keep in mind that the initial installation of the system is only the beginning. Will the service technicians be local and able to service your system promptly and long into the future? How long will it take to get a response if you need service ? And how often will the security company increase their prices and your monthly rates ? Asking a lot of questions before you choose a security provider may save you from future frustrations.

We are always thrilled when a stray dog or cat comes to the shelter and when we scan it, we discover a microchip. This is the best proof of ownership that can be provided. It is becoming more common for people to pick up strays and decide to keep them. A microchip provides the best chance that a lost animal can be reunited with a home.

When the Danville Area Humane Society first took over operation of the city animal shelter in 1984, the popular method of proving ownership in cats and dogs was tattooing. Unbelievably, the owner's Social Security number was tattooed on the inner part of one of a dog's or cat's back legs! Can you imagine that in today's world?

A lot has changed since 1984, except for the reality that millions of lost dogs and cats enter shelters each year, and relatively few are returned to the owner, unless that owner has been diligent about providing an easy way home for the animal. In Virginia, shelters and rescue groups are required by law to make a reasonable effort to contact owners within 48 hours of an animal's arrival in their facility, if the animal has some form of identification on it.

State and local dog license laws are supposed to help return lost dogs to their owner, but very few localities require the licensing of cats. In addition, collars and tags can easily get lost. What, then, can an owner do to increase the odds that their beloved missing pet can be found and returned home?

We keep a lost and found registry of animals, but that system has weaknesses. What an owner describes to us may not be what we see in an animal.

A microchip the size of a grain of rice can be the proof of ownership that is needed to reunite you with your beloved pet.

The advantages are numerous. The process is quick and no more painful than a vaccination. The chip does not get lost, and a simple procedure with a scanner alerts a shelter that a microchip has been inserted. The owner's name and address can be registered on a national or regional database.

We strongly urge everyone to protect your pet by having your dog or cat microchipped and to register the chip with your current contact information.

chicken stock to Dutch oven. Stir consistently. Cook until the potatoes and carrots are fork tender. Reduce heat to medium-low and add back chicken.

Melt butter in 3-quart saucepan over medium-low heat. Whisk in flour until smooth and then slowly pour in milk, whisking constantly. Remove from heat and add salt and pepper. Pour into Dutch oven with chicken and vegetables. Add in English peas, stirring til well-combined. Pour into a 9x13 baking dish and set aside.

Prepare Southern Buttermilk Biscuits and place on top of chicken pot pie mixture in baking dish. Sprinkle with freshly ground black pepper on top of biscuits.

Bake 12-15 minutes until biscuits are golden brown and cooked through.

Remove from oven and allow to rest for about 3 minutes. Serve warm.

- Southern Buttermilk Biscuits
- 2 cups self-rising flour + more for flouring board
- 1/4 cup vegetable shortening
- 3/4 cup buttermik

Instructions

Preheat oven to 475° F. Lightly coat rimmed baking sheet or cast iron skillet with vegetable shortening. Set aside

Add flour to a large mixing bowl. Cut in shortening with a pastry blender, two forks, or knives until wellcombined. Slowly pour in buttermilk and stir gently until just combined. Do not overmix.

Pour biscuit dough onto a floured pastry cloth, paper towels, or dough board. Gently pat or roll to about 1/2-inch thick. Cut out biscuits using about a 2-inch biscuit cutter. Place biscuits into skillet or on baking sheet pan, leaving about an inch between biscuits to allow them to rise and cook fully. Place in preheated oven and bake about 10-12 minutes. Remove from oven and serve.
