HOLLYWOOD — The Oscars are over, and the winners have to go back to work. Joaquin Phoenix, best actor for the "Joker," which has already earned over \$1 billion (against a \$70 million cost), is finishing his next project, "C'mon, C'mon," an \$8.3 million budgeted film co-starring Gaby Hoffmann and Woody Norman.

Renee Zellweger, best actress for portraying Judy Garland in "Judy," has not announced a new project. Liza Minnelli, Judy Garland's daughter, responded after remaining silent about the film: "I hope (Zellweger) had a good time making it." Renee's take on that was, "I do know that representatives of the family and the estate have seen the film, so that makes me smile. My hope is it'll be recognized as an expression of affection and adoration, and sort of a proclamation of her importance."

Brad Pitt, best supporting actor winner for "Once Upon a Time in Hollywood," has no new acting projects yet, but he's in the midst of releasing four films as a producer. "Kajillionaire," a crime drama starring Evan Rachel Wood, Richard Jenkins, Debra Winger and Gina Rodriguez, premiered Jan. 25 at Sundance. "Minari," which follows a Korean family's move from the West Coast to Arkansas, also premiered at Sundance. On the docket are "Irresistible," a political comedy written and directed by John Stewart, and starring Steve Carell and Rose Byrne, opening in theaters May 29, and "Blonde," starring Ana de Armas and Adrian Brody, which will be available through Netflix.

Laura Dern, best supporting actress winner for "Marriage Story," has "Jurassic World 3," with Chris Pratt, Bryce Dallas Howard, Sam Neill and **Jeff Goldblum**, opening June 11, 2021.

Bong Joon-ho, who won Oscars for writing, directing and best picture for "Parasite" (which cost \$11 million and took in \$176 million before winning the Oscars), is set to adapt and produce, with Adam McKay, an HBO

PIEDMONT PETS

By Paulette Dean In 1964, Ruth Harrison, a British

woman, wrote Animal Machines that was an expose on the livestock and poultry farming practices of that time. The public became very concerned and even horrified, and the British government appointed a committee to examine the welfare of animals used on farms and for the food industry.

committee presented The their findings a year later in an 85 page document coined "The Brambell Report" after the chief author, Roger Brambell.

A list of Five Freedoms of Animals was included in the report. At first, the Five Freedoms were written for farm animals. With the growing demand from the public for more humanely-raised food, the American Humane Association established their American Humane Certified program, which, according to their website, is "the first-ever U.S. farm animal welfare certification effort, which now covers more than a billion animals".

Although the standards of the Five Freedoms may have begun as a gold standard for the food industry, they have now been widely adopted as the gold standard of treatment for all animals by welfare organizations, including but not limited to the American Veterinary Medical Association, the World Organization for Animal Health and the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

The Five Freedoms are: 1. Freedom from Hunger and Thirst: by ready access to fresh water and a diet to

maintain full health and vigor.

2. Freedom from Discomfort: by providing an appropriate environment, including shelter and a comfortable resting area.

3. Freedom from Pain, Injury, or Disease: by prevention or rapid diagnosis and treatment.

Freedom to Express Normal Behavior: by providing sufficient space, proper facilities and company of the animal's own kind.

5. Freedom from Fear and Distress: by ensuring conditions and treatment which avoid mental suffering.

Many years ago, the Board of Directors of the Danville Area Humane Society adopted these Five Freedoms as a guideline for all its policies and procedures. If an idea that is considered "progressive" does not protect this philosophy, it is not put into place for our shelter animals or for animals outside of the shelter realm.







Partially wireless & wired cameras use WiFi for wireless video transmission and require a wire to be run to a power source, usually a 110 AC electrical outlet. Wired camera systems usually use Coax or Cat 5e wire run from the cameras to the on-site recorder to provide both continuous video transmission and power for the cameras.

Why Those Fabulous 50's Are A Good Time To Start Thinking About... Long Term Care!

Sure, it seems crazy to start thinking about a possible future when you're infirmed and need long-term health care if you're only in your 50's. You're young, or relatively young, and healthy. But that's the point. You don't want to someday be unable to take care of yourself and wish that you had done some pre-planning. If you're in your 50's, and you're notthinking about long-term care, these are some reasons you should be considering it, such as:

(1.) You have plenty of time. That's why planning for long-term care now is a good idea. If you wait to plan for long-term care in your 60's, 70's or beyond, you're going to find that certain strategies aren't available (or practical) any longer. There are generally three approaches people take to long-term care, which are:

(a.) Private Pay: That is, no insurance, no government help – just you. You could research how much you'd likely spend if you became chronically ill and save for it. But that really isn't realistic for most people. The problem with private pay is that people often find themselves needing that money 10 to 15 years into their retirement just to make it. So people who are intent upon self-funding might find themselves without options later on after they begin paying a bill of over \$8000.00 per month!

(b.) Medicaid: Not Medicare, which won't pay for long-term care. "But Medicaid was created to do just that," experts say. For persons with typically less than \$150,000 to \$500,000 in retirement assets, Medicaid may make more sense. But experts always advise talking to an elder law attorney, who can guide you through the ins and outs of Medicaid.

(c.) Long-Term Care Insurance: After you purchase the policy and pay the premiums, of course – such as long-term insurance or a hybrid life insurance and long-term care policy. Clients who find insurance appealing need a competent broker that can walk them through the myriad of options available. There are even strategies an elder law attorney can implement in conjunction with a purchase of long term care insurance to ensure you get the biggest bang for your buck! Remember this, if you are thinking about the need for long-term care insurance, the 50's is the best time to buy it and take advantage of lower premiums! If you wait, you may not be able to afford the monthly premium.

(2.) You're still healthy: Hopefully that's the case. Particularly if you're interested in any sort of long-term care insurance, which helps pay for the cost of having somebody help you with tasks like getting dressed and going to the bathroom. It's an unpleasant thought, of course, which is why many people don't like thinking ahead.

The key to purchasing long-term care insurance is to do so when you're still healthy to qualify. Once health deteriorates, clients may no longer be eligible for coverage, or their premiums may increase. Approximately 25 percent of applicants who wait to apply for long-term care insurance after age 60 are declined for health reasons.

(3.) Insurance is cheaper. Any health insurance is always cheaper when you're younger, which is why – if you plan to get it, you'd likely want to get long-term care insurance now versus much later. Some experts advocate buying long-term care insurance as early as your 40s. The premiums are less the younger you are, so it pays to get started early. The earliest I have heard of is a couple buying their policies when they were 43 years old. "Although we've had two premium increases since we bought them, we still pay around half of what people looking to buy traditional LTC at my current age of 55 [would pay] – and the benefits I own on that old policy are far greater than what I can quote a 55-year-old couple."

The average cost of long-term care insurance is all over the map, depending on the insurer, your age and the policy, so it's difficult to say how much any one person will pay. Still, to give you an idea of why it's cheaper to get it sooner rather than later, it can be instructive to look at some of the numbers on the website of the American Association for Long-Term Care Insurance, a national trade association. A couple, both 55 years of age, with a shared policy would, on average, pay \$2,350 a year with a \$150 maximum daily benefit and a three-year benefit period. The same couple, if they were each 60, would pay \$2,970 a year.

(4.) You'll have some peace of mind, earlier. I often tell clients that if they can tell me the exact date they plan to die, I'll tell them exactly what to do!! Yet, nobody knows the future, and so your planning may not help you someday – or you may draw up an elaborate plan only to later discover that someday, wow, you're a 101-year-old marathon runner who needs no help being taken care of, and all that money spent was for naught. But, still, there is something to be said for knowing that you probablyhave things figured out, way ahead of time. Life favors the prepared, after all.

Terri Cochran is the editor of a non-profit newsletter. She is 66 and says that she bought a long-term care insurance policy when she was 53. Her husband, Vince, the owner of a small laser manufacturing company was 69 and at the beginning stages of a neurodegenerative illness that they were then unaware of. An insurance company cold-called him, to sell him long-care insurance. He was ultimately denied due to his poor health, but Cochran decided to buy some for herself.

"I was afraid he would have expensive medical bills in the future, so it was another reason for me to have my own insurance," Cochran says. "Sure enough, he soon needed 10 hours a day of [care from] home health aides, which we paid out of pocket for well over 10 years until his death in 2016. We were lucky to have the money to pay for aides. I couldn't work either since he needed my full-time care."

Cochran says she feels prepared for the possibility that someday she may need long-term care, but even with the peace of mind of having a plan in place, she is a little unsettled. "If I do need to use my long-term care insurance, I hope the insurance company isn't difficult to work with. Because I hear horror stories about people trying to collect on their insurance when they need it," she says. But, imagine the horror stories of needing long-term care and not being prepared.

Beware of Potential 2020 Census Scams

Dear Savvy Senior,

Can you offer some tips to help seniors guard against census scams? With the 2020 census gearing up, I've read that there are a lot of potential scammers out there looking to take advantage of older people and I want to protect myself.

Cautious Judy

Dear Judy,

Unfortunately, scams have become a persistent problem when the U.S. Census Bureau does its once-a-decade count of the U.S. population. Here's what you can expect from the 2020 Census in the coming weeks, and how you can protect yourself from potential scams.

What to Expect

In mid-March, you and nearly every other U.S. household will receive an invitation in the mail to respond to the 2020 Census. This year, you will have the option of completing the 2020 census questionnaire either online, by mail, or by phone. The invitation will include detailed instructions of what you need to do.

If you don't respond to this invitation letter, you will receive several follow-up postcard reminders from the Census Bureau by mail. If you still don't respond by late April, a census worker will come to your door to collect your response in person.

It only takes a few minutes to complete the census questionnaire.

While census participation is very important and required by law, you also need to be vigilant of census-linked scams. This is especially important for seniors who tend to be prime targets.

The Census Bureau warns against phishing email scams as well as con artist masquerading as census workers who will try to solicit your personal financial information. Here are some tips that can help you protect yourself.

Guard Your Information

Don't give out your personal or financial information. The Census Bureau or a legitimate census worker will never ask for your Social Security number, bank account number, credit card number, money or donations. And they will never contact you on behalf of a political party. If you're asked for any of these, whether it be via phone, mail, email or in person, it's a scam and should be reported to rumors@census.gov.

Avoid Online Scams

The Census Bureau will not send you an unsolicited email to request your participation in the 2020 Census. So, ignore any emails you get that may direct you to a census website that looks real but is fake – and may be infected with malware. Also, don't reply to the email or open any attachment because they could contain viruses that could infect your computer. Forward the email or website address to the Census Bureau at rumors@census.gov. Then delete the message.

Be Safe at Home

If someone visits your home to collect a response for the 2020 Census, make sure you verify their identity. A legitimate census taker must present a field badge that includes a photograph of themselves, a Department of Commerce watermark and an expiration date. Census workers will also be carrying a Census Bureau laptop or cellphone, as well as a bag with a Census Bureau logo.

Also, remember that a census worker will only ask you the questions that appear on the questionnaire – your name, gender, age, race, ethnicity, phone number, type of residence and number of people living with you. They will not ask for sensitive personal information, such as your Social Security or credit card number.

If you have questions about their identity, you can call 800-923-8282 to speak with a local Census Bureau representative. If it is determined that the visitor who came to your door does not work for the Census Bureau, contact your local police department.



Chicken Stir Fry Recipe



INGREDIENTS

1 lb boneless, skinless chicken breast cut into 1 inch

salt and pepper to taste

2 tbsp olive oil divided

2 cups broccoli florets

1/2 yellow bell pepper cut into 1 inch pieces

1/2 red bell pepper cut into 1 inch pieces

1/2 cup baby carrots sliced

2 tsp minced ginger

2 garlic cloves minced

Stir Fry Sauce
1 tbsp corn starch

2 tbsp cold water

1/4 cup low sodium chicken broth

3 tbsp low sodium soy sauce

1/4 cup honey

1 tbsp toasted sesame oil

1/2 tsp crushed red pepper flakes

INSTRUCTIONS

Stir Fry Sauce

In a medium size bowl, whisk together corn starch and water. Add remaining ingredients (chicken broth, soy sauce, honey, and toasted sesame oil, red pepper flakes) and whisk to combine. Set aside.

Add one tablespoon of olive oil to a large skillet or wok and heat over medium high heat.

Add chicken (in batches if necessary) and season with salt and pepper. Cook for 3 to 5 minutes or until cooked through. Remove from skillet.

Reduce heat to medium and add remaining tablespoon of oil to the skillet.

Add broccoli, bell pepper, and carrots and cook, stirring occasionally, just until crisp tender. Add ginger and garlic and cook for an additional minute.

Add chicken back into the skillet and stir to combine.

Whisk stir fry sauce and pour over chicken and vegetables and stir gently to combine.

Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally, and let boil for one minute.

Serve with rice and/or chow mein if desired.
