
### Forest Pests Workshop








#### IBBB Returns to VFW

- 2 sweet potatoes, peeled & diced into 1/2" cubes (about 3 cups)
- 1 pound Brussels sprouts, trimmed
- & halved (about 2 cups) 3 bratwursts or chicken sausages, sliced into 1/2" thick slices
- 2 tablespoons olive oil 2 tablespoons honey
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme leaf 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper

Serve with: 3 cups fresh fruit

Preheat oven to 425°F. Line a large sheet pan with parchment paper or aluminum foil. Place veggies and brats on the sheet pan. In a small bowl, whisk



### Drinking Green Beer? Call a Designated Driver

If you are heading out to a St. Patrick's Day celebration this year make sure you have more than just the luck o' the Irish on your side. This holiday, March 17, 2020, is one of the biggest drinking nights of the year and this, unfortunately, means more impaired drivers on the roads. Drunk driving accounts for nearly one-third of vehicle related fatalities in the United States. Nationally, in 2018 alone, 73 people (39% of all crash fatalities) were killed in drunk-driving crashes over the St. Patrick's Day holiday period 33% of the pedestrians aged 16 and older killed in crashes had a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) at or above .08. In 2019 in Iowa, there were two crashes over the holiday which killed four people.

To combat the increased impaired driving around the holiday local law agencies will be stepping up traffic enforcement March 14-17, 2020. Officers will especially be watching for drunk and drugged drivers and anyone not wearing seat belts.

Drinking and driving should never be combined. It's essential to plan a sober ride in advance if the holiday celebration will include alcohol. The alternative could change your life, not to mention the lives of your passengers, pedestrians, or other drivers and passengers nearby. Celebrate St. Patrick's Day responsibly.

The Iowa Department of Public Safety and the Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau remind you; driving while impaired is illegal. If you feel different, you drive different.




Leap Day was approaching and suspected their baby may choose that unusual date for arrival.

chorus, which was the 1st Runner Up in the weekend's Emmetsburg Extravaganza. Professor A. Good Outlook found it to be a great show all around... Even though one of the Old Professor's brothers has celebrated his birthday on March 11th for more than 60 years, it is only through research director RD's efforts that we learned March 11, 1919, is the day Duke Ellington's most musical son Mercer, was born. In addition to fronting his father's band in later years, Mercer wrote several songs that were often misattributed to his father One song, Things Ain't What They Used To Be, has been covered by numerous artists, includ-

ing The Dave Brubeck Quartet (1958), Lambert, Hendricks, and Ross (1960), and Doc

Sever-insen with his Tonight Show Band on their 1991 release, Once More With Feeling! The Dick Bauman Big Band plays this, too... Whether Friday the 13th is a cause to celebrate or not remains to be seen; but RD has found a song to pretty well guarantee a lucky day. I'm Just a Lucky So-and-So was written by the aforementioned Duke Ellington, with an assist from Mack David, in 1945. Duke recorded the tune with Louis Armstrong, in 1961. Interestingly, that was the first time they worked together. Through the decades, a host of other singers have included the song in their

studio sessions, as well. Annie Ross did so in 1960. Tony Bennett did the same on three occasions. And Diana Krall sang it on her 1993 debut album, Stepping Out... As the first Friday the 13th of the new year, it is also Blame Someone Else Day. Apparently Louis Armstrong thinks like the Old Professor — or vice-versa. Louis' *I Didn't Know Until You Told Me* was recorded by Louis, Dave and Carmen McRae, on the 1962 album, *The Real Ambassadors*. The LP was also the soundtrack

for a jazz musical. You'll find I Didn't Know... on YouTube... And, Friday is also the day in 1965 that *The Beatles'* single, *Eight Days a Week*, made it to the top spot on the music charts. Of particular note is that this Lennon/ McCartney song opens with a fade-in, marking the first time that this technique had been used on a pop studio recording. That same year, Wrecking Crew session musician Billy Strange recorded Eight Days... for his LP English Hits of '65...

Having nothing to do with religion, RD also tells us that Sunday is True

Confessions Day. She's thinking of her elementary school days, and the song I've Got a Crush On You, written by George and Ira Gershwin. The jazz standard is unique among the brothers' compositions in that it was used for two different Broadway productions — *Treasure Girl*, in 1928, and *Strike Up the Band*, in 1930. Famous recordings of the song include those by Frank Sinatra, Ella Fitzgerald, and Linda Ronstadt on What's New, the first album of a trilogy she made with bandleader/arranger Nelson Riddle, in 1983...

And, March 15th is also the day the motion picture, The Godfather, held its national premieres in 1972. The show's theme song, Love Theme From The Godfather, was a Nino Rota, Larry Kusik composition that became a hit in its own right only after Andy Williams sang the song under the title, Speak Softly, Love. Al Martino covered Williams' work a year later. Roger Williams and Stan Kenton followed with their own instrumental versions...

Did you remember to set your clocks ahead one hour on Saturday night? We received a text message reminder and warning late Sunday night as *RAMBOling* was wrapping up: "This is the week that started by changing the clock, has a full moon (Monday), and ends with a Friday the 13th.

This update to the airplane fleet is another step towards ensuring pilots trained at Iowa Lakes are highly employable in a job market that continues to expand.





#### **OHS Mock Trial to State**

begin to float around the heads of Iowa Great Lakes area locals and tourists.

For some. those visions are of motorized boating. For some, it might be paddle boarding. For some, it's kayaking.

The Dickinson County Conservation Board wants to help those who dream of

kayaking by providing adult classes throughout the summer. "We have a lot of adults in the area who have taken up kayaking, and we wanted to continue to offer adult kayaking classes because we want to teach appropriate techniques to help make their lives easier on the water and to make their experiences safer," said Bryanna Kuhlman, environmental education coordinator. "We have so many great lakes for it. Some of our

small lakes are good to explore via kayak, because you can't

get on them with motorized boats.' Three beginners class sessions will be held at a location to be determined by wind and weather conditions. Select from classes 9:00am-noon or 1:00-4:00pm, June 24, or 1:00-4:00pm, June 25. The beginners class will teach skills such as entering and exiting a kayak, paddling and safety. Beginners may bring their own kayak and personal flotation device or may choose to

borrow a kayak and PFD from the conservation board. Even those who are experienced kayakers can learn from the beginners class if they haven't taken a class from a certified instructor before. American Canoe Association certified instructor Mark Foss teaches all Dickinson County Conservation kayak classes and camps.

"He is just really wonderful because he volunteers his time to teach these classes," Kuhlman said. "He's passionate about kayaking."

Foss will also teach an advanced course for adults who have taken the beginners course and want to delve a little deeper. The advanced course will be held 9:00am-2:00pm, July 7, and all participants must bring their own kayak --- at least 10 feet long --- and personal flotation device.

Dickinson County Conservation Board kayak class participants must be at least 16 years old. Each class costs \$20 and is limited to five participants, so make sure to register quickly at www.dickinsoncountyconservationboard.com.

### USDA to Open Sign-up March 16 for Conservation Reserve Program Grasslands

Farmers and ranchers may apply to enroll grasslands in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Grasslands signup beginning March 16. The signup runs through May 15.

"Through this CRP Grasslands signup, farmers and ranchers can protect grasslands, rangelands and pastures, while maintaining the land as working grazing lands," said Amanda De Jong. "The program emphasizes support for grazing operations and plant and animal biodiversity, while protecting land under the greatest threat of conversion or development."

Through CRP Grasslands, participants retain the right to conduct common grazing practices, such as haying, mowing or harvesting seed from the enrolled land. Timing of some activities may be restricted by the primary nesting season of birds.

Participants will receive an annual rental payment and may receive up to 50 percent cost-share for establishing approved conservation practices. The duration of the CRP contract is either 10 or 15 years. FSA will rank applications using a number of factors including existence of expiring CRP land, threat of conversion or development, existing grassland, and predominance of native species cover, and cost.

The 2018 Farm Bill set aside 2 million acres for CRP Grassland enrollment. CRP is one of the largest conservation programs at USDA. CRP marks its 35-year anniversary in 2020 with 22 million acres currently enrolled.
