



Whether you call Lake County home or plan on visiting for the first time, here are some more details on the new and notable things to look out for:

Hotels

Lake County's new hotels offer a comfortable, cozy, and convenient home away from home for any occasion. If you're looking to immerse yourself in our heritage sites, Four Points by Sheraton Cleveland-Eastlake is located just 7 miles away from the James A. Garfield National Historic Site and Historic Kirtland Visitors Center. This newly renovated hotel offers 16,000 sq. ft in 12 event spaces and those looking for family fun can head to the indoor pool or enjoy a delicious meal at the Firelake Bar & Grill. For those visiting the Painesville, Mentor, or Chardon area, the Holiday Inn Express Concord is close to some of the area's largest employers, including Lubrizol, Avery Dennison, Steris, and more. Leisure travelers can find easy access to wineries, beaches, and a wide variety of restaurants. If you're looking to explore the wineries of the Grand River Vallev. Madison's two new hotels will make sure you're comfortable and well-rested so that you can get to everything on your must-see-and-do list. Just minutes from the Shores of Lake Erie and conveniently located off I-90, Madison's Holiday Inn Express and Hampton Inn are near the Grand River Valley Wineries, shops, museums, and other attractions located on the eastern side of Lake County.



Restaurants & Wineries

Lake County has quickly become known for its award-winning wineries and has also become one of the region's most popular travel destinations. Whether you're looking to take in the sights on the west end of the county or experience the lively nightlife and historic downtown on the eastern end, add these local newcomers to your list.

Opened in June of 2019, Cask 307 offers contemporary wine styles in a beautiful new state-of-the-art facility. Guests can enjoy globally-inspired small plates, craft beer, fine dining, and live entertainment. Located at the edge of the Grand River in Madison, Ohio, Silver Crest Winery & Cellars opened in June 2018. Local grape farmers John Bohinc, Eric Cotton, and Patrick Linehan founded the winery using the grapes from their family vineyards, which date back as far as the 1930's. Together, they grow and make both old-world and new-world wine varieties as well as local, historical varieties and blends.

If you'll be staying on the western end of the county, put Casa De Vino Winery & Restaurant in Wickliffe on your to-do list. Opened in July of 2017, this elegant eatery offers American/ European cuisine and wine in a newly renovated facility and boasts a 4,000 sq. ft. outdoor patio. Spirits in Willoughby is an open-air establishment with indoor/outdoor seating, bocce ball courts, fire pit, live music and house-made wine. All of the wines are made on-site in a train car that also serves as a tasting room. In downtown Willoughby, "Spirits in Willoughby" makes a clever play on words between alcohol and the haunting of the Willoughby Coal building, which sits behind the winery. For those who crave something different, BRIM Kitchen + Brewery balances the latest with the greatest, offering clean eating options along with tried-and-true favorites. Located on Erie Street in Downtown Willoughby, this beautiful, two-tiered restaurant also offers a rooftop patio, embraces sustainability, and offers healthier dishes you can feel good about.

Things To Do

Constructed in 2016, the 50-foot coastal observation tower at Lake Erie Bluffs overlooks the lakeshore with multiple viewing platforms along a staircase that culminates in a deck featuring 360-degree-views. The height and location of the tower provide visitors with a unique view of the lake and the surrounding woods, fields, and wetlands, along with a variety of wildlife-including a notable number of bald eagles that are regularly seen at the park. The Painesville Township Park Pier offers visitors a chance to see an incredible Lake Erie sunset and provides anglers from all over the region a prime location to cast their reels. The pier, 20 feet in width and standing 10 feet above the lake, has a 50-foot bridge that connects the pier to the shoreline. Stairs and an ADA-accessible walkway allow visitors with mobility impairment a chance to experience the pier.

This year marks the third annual season for the Miracle League of Lake County. The Miracle League, whose motto is "every child deserves a chance to play ball," is a nonprofit baseball league for children and adults with special needs. In 2018, Lake Health Miracle Park and The Lubrizol Playground was built adjacent to Classic Park, home of the Lake County Captains. Featuring a fully ADA accessible baseball field and playground, the park was built to provide children and adults with special needs a first-class facility of their own. The baseball field features a custom-designed. rubberized turf that accommodates the needs of players in wheelchairs, scooters, walkers, and other assistive devices. The dugouts were designed to accommodate those who need mobility devices and feature calming and sensory spaces. The Lubrizol Playground is open year-round with a fully accessible restroom building nearby, and offers a latex-free playground surface, accessible playground equipment, sensory play, and an igloo when silent time is desired. One of the most exciting offerings at the playground is the zip line, where children can get lifted into the seat and experience the freedom of flight and movement without their wheelchairs. The field is used by over 100 special needs children every Saturday from early June through September. Lake County is proud to be one of six locations in Ohio that have this special field and allinclusive playground.

Rich national history can be found in Mentor, one of the county's busiest cities. Part of the National Park Service, this site preserves the Lawnfield estate and surrounding property of James Abram Garfield, the 20th President of the United States. Join a guided tour through Garfield's family home, the site of the first established presidential library, or take the cellphone tour around the remaining parts of the 160-acre farm. Stop in the Visitor Center, where visitors can find exhibits and artifacts that illustrate his life chronologically. Read about Garfield's early life and school days, the Civil War, Washington

D.C., the 1880 Republican Convention, and presidency. Also, various artifacts from his funeral can be found in the exhibit area. With so many ways to learn about President Garfield and his family, this site has become one of the most famous historical attractions in the state. The James A. Garfield Historical Site is perfect for a day trip or added onto a weekend adventure.

Visit The Holden Arboretum



Locals and visitors alike can not say enough about the 3,500 acres of flora, fauna, trees, and animals at the Holden Arboretum. This local treasure features over 20 miles of trails that take you through impeccable cultivated gardens and native forest. One of the most "remarkable" features is the Murch Canopy Walk, an elevated walkway that takes you 65 feet above the forest floor. Make sure to climb the Kalberer Family Emergent Tower, a wooden tower that rises 120 feet above the forest floor for breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape. If heights are not your thing, the Holden Butterfly Garden is a sight to see. The 20-acre Layer Rhododendron Garden and the 4.5 acre Paine Rhododendron Discovery Garden attracts humminabirds and butterflies for a whimsical learning experience. Picnic areas are available, and a children's play area will keep the little ones entertained as they reconnect with nature. Tours and guided hikes are available, and you can bring your best friend along (dogs on leashes are permitted), making it the perfect family getaway.

See a Sunset at Headlands Beach State Park



Home of the "Remarkable Sunset," Headlands Beach State Park is the longest natural beach in Ohio and is ranked as Ohio's #1 beach. The mile-long beach attracts two million visitors a year from the U.S. and Canada. It boasts a mile-long natural sand beach, which is home to many plant species typically found only along the Atlantic Coast. Whether you're a "beach bum" or prefer to hike and explore, Headlands Beach has something for everyone. In the summer you'll find sunbathing spots, swimming and picnic areas, but also parts of the beach in its natural state, including dunes, driftwood and an abundance of wildlife. Seated near the break wall, you'll find our historic lighthouse that can be accessed by both water and walking. Built in 1925, this lighthouse was constructed at the mouth of the Grand River to replace the original Fairport Harbor Lighthouse, which serves as a maritime museum, and sits on a hill in Fairport overlooking the lake. Visitors will find plenty of free parking, restrooms, concession stands, and changing areas for swimmers or sunbathers.

Ohio is ranked in the top ten wine-producing states in the U.S. and Lake County is the proud home to eleven wineries, including Ohio's largest estate winery and family vineyard, Debonne Vineyards. The Grand River Valley's location near Lake Erie makes our soil ideal for growing a variety of grapes like Concord, Niagara, Delaware, and Catawba, as well as European grapes like Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, Rieslina, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc, allowing our vintners to create a wide variety of wines each year. Many of the wineries provide live music and entertainment with picturesque views, making them a hit for relaxing afternoons, bridal parties, and get-togethers. The Grand River Valley Ice Wine Festival is one of Ohio's most celebrated winter traditions. Each year, local wineries come together to celebrate the region's famous ice wine. During the event, participating wineries offer samples of their ice wines along with a complimentary appetizer. In addition to protecting and maintaining our parks, residents and visitors can also find educational opportunities throughout the year for the entire family, including hiking, birding, boating, biking, and skiing. Lake Metroparks also offers Adaptive Programming that is designed specifically for individuals with special needs.

The Lake Metroparks Farmpark is a family-oriented science and cultural center devoted to agriculture and farming with 235 acres with fields, gardens and farm buildings. Lake Metroparks Farmpark is also home to the premier food and wine event of the year, Vintage Ohio. This annual event is a weekend-long celebration that brings in approximately 11,000 people to sample our region's award-winning wine, partake in food demonstrations, live entertainment, and much more.



Lessons are available for first-timers or those looking to improve their nautical skills. If you prefer to sink your feet in the sand, Fairport Harbor Lakefront Park has everything you need to make your beach day memorable. Amenities include an accessible harbor view boardwalk, restrooms, changing rooms, shower facilities, picnic area and pavilion with grills, drinking fountain, playground, volleyball court, and a Surf Chair for visitors with mobility challenges. With wooden benches and tables placed along the harbor view boardwalk and parking lot accessibility, visitors can relax and enjoy the view of our remarkable sunsets and historic lighthouse. Lastly, Fairport Harbor Lakefront Park is one of the only beaches on Lake Erie that has a designated dog-swim area so you can bring your best friend along too.

Eastlake: The "Crown Jewel" of Lake County

Eastlake is located 20 miles northeast of Cleveland at the mouth of the Scenic Chagrin River. With several parks, marinas, yacht clubs, and easy access to Lake Erie, Eastlake is a favorite destination for recreational boaters, anglers, and nature lovers. One of Eastlake's most beloved attractions is Classic Park, home of The Lake County Captains minor league baseball team. The team, a Class A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, plays in the Midwest League.

Eastlake is home to several heritage sites where visitors from all over the world come to pay tribute to the fallen–The Boulevard of 500 Flags, The America Remembers 9/11 Memorial, and The War Dog Memorial. These memorials include a section of grass from Flight 93 that crashed in Shankland, PA, a piece of granite from the Pentagon, and a steel beam and light post from the Twin Towers. The War Dog Memorial honors the dogs that served to protect our Service People during World War I, World War II. Korea, and Vietnam, Attached to a dog park, its unique location made it the first in the United States, where visitors can bring their dogs and let them run.

Kirtland, the "City of Faith and Beauty," has something to offer everyone. Two popular destinations are the Visitor Centers at Historic Kirtland and the Kirtland Temple, attracting thousands of tourists annually. Historic Kirtland, a meticulously restored and reconstructed 19th Century settlement, showcases the spirit and vitality of the early American frontier.

Kirtland is also home to the beautiful Holden Arboretum. One of the largest arboreta and botanical gardens in the United States, the Holden Arboretum has more than 3,600 acres to explore, including 600 acres devoted to collections and gardens. The Murch Canopy Walk and the Kalberer Emergent Tower are a must-see, where visitors explore new heights from the treetop perspective as they take in the unique view and surroundings. Within Kirtland's 17 square miles are several popular Lake Metroparks (Penitentiary Glen, Chapin Forest, and Lake Farmpark), which offer year-round programming for all ages.

Kirtland continues to be ranked as one of the safest cities in Ohio, due to the superb work of the Kirtland Police Department. Be sure to put Kirtland on your list of places to see during your time in Remarkable Lake County, OH.

Madison Village is a picturesque Victorian-era village established in 1867 and listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Just three minutes away from three Lake Metroparks, visitors can find camping, hiking, hunting, birding, canoe and kayaking along the state-designated scenic Grand River spanning over 1,300 acres.

Explore the historic Main Street, where a variety of local retail stores and

restaurants attract locals and visitors alike. Take a walking tour of mid-to-late-19th-century homes from by the Madison Historical Society or stop by the beautiful Village Square and Band Stand, where visitors can find activities going on year-round, such as outdoor markets, evening concerts, classic car shows, craft fairs, seasonal festivals, and ice skating in winter. See a live performance at Rabbit Run, which has been a live theater mainstay in Northeast Ohio for generations.

With 20+ wineries, diverse restaurants, two craft breweries, and a microdistillery within 10 miles of the Village Square, there is no shortage of incredible things to experience. Madison offers plenty of lodging options, including lakeside campsites, cozy B&Bs, and a brand new Holiday Inn Express.

Painesville: Vibrant and Historic

Known as the county seat, Painesville is located along the beautiful Grand River, 2.5 miles from the shores of Lake Erie, and roughly 30 miles northeast of Cleveland. From the 100-year-old Lake County Courthouse to the Greek Revival styles of City Hall, visitors will take note of the unique historical buildings all over the downtown district.

Painesville is known for its beautiful nature and spectacular riverfront views, including 13 parks and a charming city square. Residents and visitors enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities, including baseball, disc golf, hiking, fishing, and birdwatching. Easy access can be found to the Lake Metroparks Greenway Corridor, an almost 5-mile paved trail, where visitors can walk, run or bike their way through natural beauty.

Discerning shoppers will enjoy the eclectic and varied Craft and Antique Co-op, open through the weekend. At the Painesville Farmers Market, known locally as "the best market in Lake County," visitors can meet energetic artisans, and vendors with produce picked the same day. Those who are curious can get a taste of history at the Painesville Railroad Museum, which showcases the local railroad history and promotes model railroading.

Wickliffe: The Gateway to Lake County

Local outdoor gathering spot Pete's Pond Preserve features walking, biking, and hiking trails, and makes an excellent spot for those looking to unwind and get some fresh air. Wickliffe is home to several parks, most famously Coulby Park and Orlando Park, the former having an aquatic center, baseball fields, and pond. Visitors from all over the state also enjoy the Coulby Mansion, a perfect location for taking photos of special occasions. The 54-acre estate is on the National Register of Historic Places and is home to an immaculately well-kept 16-room mansion owned by the former shipping baron Harry Coulby. Great restaurants located throughout the city means visitors are sure to find a favorite. Easy access from anywhere in the state on Routes 2, 90, and 271, suggests that Wickliffe is only a day trip away.









Rustic Tent Camping

Lake Metroparks offers a "rustic" tent camping experience for small groups of up to eight people staying in tents. Campers must hike or paddle to the campsites. The sites are set back from the developed areas of the parks from about 0.25 mile to more than a mile. Each location is different and provides a quiet, intimate natural experience—much different than crowded campgrounds.

Each site has a designated area to pitch a tent, a place to build a fire, a grill and a picnic table. The sites do not have restrooms, running water or trash cans. Campers are expected to practice a "leave no trace" camping ethic including carrying in and carrying out all supplies and trash, with the goal of leaving the area better than it was found.





Portions of two state designated wild and scenic rivers — and many tributaries — flow through and are protected by Lake Metroparks. Lake Metroparks annually provides more than 3.3 million visitors with countless recreational and educational experiences to enjoy Lake County year-round at diverse facilities including a family-oriented science and cultural center devoted to agriculture and farming, a nature center and wildlife rehabilitation center, two golf courses, more than 60 miles of trails, six parks on the Lake Erie shoreline and a cross-country ski center.

Step out onto the 200' pier at Painesville Township Park, which extends 200 feet into the water and provides public access to our region's greatest natural resource; Lake Erie. The pier is a areat place to marvel and experience stunning views of the lake and the setting sun as well as a chance to witness bald eagles fly over. The pier also provides excellent fishing access for a wide variety of fish including smallmouth bass, perch, walleye, and steelhead trout. An ADA-accessible walkway and stairs lead down to the pier.
