When the best senior golfers in the world step to the tees at the Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course at Harbor Shores Resort this spring for the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship they will find the 5th such championship in the past ten years here to be the best it has ever been.

The KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship Tue, May 19- Sun, May 24, 2020

The team that works year-round to make this the most prestigious event on the Champions Tour is in perpetual pursuit of perfection. That will be readily evident on the Memorial Day weekend when the 2020 Championship occurs.

Championship Director Ryan Ogle says the players "have really begun to understand the story of the community transformation fostered by the course and they're really embracing it by enjoying their visit."

When the best 156 players in the world show up, their audience numbering in the tens of thousands will find newly-enhanced interactive experiences at the KitchenAid Fairway Club, where celebrity and local chefs hold court Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Fans will enjoy more hands-on experiences with innovative KitchenAid products, with an opportunity to ask questions to improve and inspire their own culinary skills. Ogle says research shows that 90-percent of past ticket buyers consider themselves 'foodies," making the partnership with KitchenAid even more impactful.

Back by popular demand, the Makers Trail 19th Hole, the upgraded spectator experience in a covered pavilion, is now overlooking the 17th Green at Harbor Shores, the last par three on the course and the scene of 2016 Champion Rocco Mediate's thrilling chip-in, sealing his win that year. The Makers Trail 19th Hole features craft breweries, wineries and distilleries from the region showcasing their talents in a fun atmosphere for everyone. Each ticket holder will receive \$25 worth of vouchers to use for food and drinks inside the pavilion. It was a sell-out on Friday and Saturday in 2018, a feat likely to be replicated.

The KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship is a very affordable affair in the realm of major sporting events. Juniors 17 and under are admitted free with a paid adult, and there's something for everyone when you head for the YMCA Kids Zone in the Jean Klock Park portion of Harbor Shores. After being told to be quiet all day, kids can let loose in YMCA bounce houses and inflatable hitting bays where PGA Professionals will offer swing tips and other golf fun. There will be special programs for Kids Day, Saturday, May 23rd that will be exciting for all ages.

Local businesses have the opportunity to host clients and entertain staff in corporate hospitality suites. Also, some local firms join the army of volunteers working together as a team of ambassadors for the community welcoming the swarm of spectators.

On average over 300 credentialed media turn out to cover the championship, with NBC and Golf Channel broadcasting to more than 100 countries and over 250-million households. Newly eligible golfers to the field this year include Ernie Els, Steve Stricker, Jim Furyk and Retief Goosen. Get your tickets soon at srpga.com. It'll be a spectacular year at Harbor Shores Resort with their 10th Anniversary celebration.











Spectators from far and wide who make the journey to the 2020 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship at Harbor Shores Resort this spring will enjoy a multi-dimensional preview of all of Michigan's Great Southwest just steps beyond the front gate and ticket booth, thanks to the team of the Community Showcase Committee.

That committee, which includes your Southwest Michigan Regional Chamber, will present eyepopping imagery, virtual reality, performing artists, and even a taste of the talents found along the renowned Makers Trail of craft breweries and wineries.

The Community Showcase, alongside the PGA of America merchandise center, again will highlight and promote the broad range of amenities, destination attractions and family fun opportunities that await visitors either at the end of their day at Harbor Shores Resort or when they return to the community for the full tourist experience.

CrazeVR of St. Joe will tee up a virtual reality experience to either play a hole of golf without even picking up a club or soar above the community in an aerial fly-by. Tastings of Makers Trail offerings will welcome spectators, and eight talented artists will be in the house at varying times, creating artwork right before your eyes, accompanied by live performing musicians.

Visitors can also step aboard a shuttle bus that makes stops in both the Benton Harbor Arts District and downtown St. Joe. New this year is a shuttle stop connecting the new water taxi from Cornerstone Alliance, the Harbor Cycleboat and the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship which will share a unique view from the community's waterfront.



The tradition of a major musical concert at City Center Park returns again as Benton Harbor welcomes the entire community to celebrate the transformation over the years since the Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course burst onto the scene. Especially noteworthy is that this year marks the 10th Anniversary of Harbor Shores Resort and the fifth time the Championship has been played here in that ten-year span.

Champions for Change

Every year that the Championship has been played at Harbor Shores, the actual economic impact to the community tops an estimated \$8 million, and the worldwide showcase of the community on NBC and Golf Channel is valued at the equivalent of another \$8 million in global exposure.

As golfers and spectators arrive in town, every hotel in the region sports colorful lobby banners welcoming them, and those hotels themselves have seen revenues spike by an additional \$1-million a year as compared to the off years when the Championship is played elsewhere.

Visitors arriving by car are greeted in both St. Joseph and Benton Harbor by colorful banners erected on light poles, showcasing the event each year as well.

The PGA of America creates approximately 600 temporary jobs during each Championship event, resulting in more than \$500,000 in payroll wages, and has now to date donated nearly \$1 million to local youth organizations in Michigan's Great Southwest over the past decade.

Clearly, the vision of the Champions for Change in our community lives on.


Government Affairs
