Things can certainly change rapidly in the world today. Two weeks ago, it would have been hard to imagine how a pandemic can change our daily lives.

For now, the City animal shelter will operate with regular hours. We will remain an open-admission shelter and will turn away no animal.

To protect the health of our staff, volunteers, and the community, we ask that visits to the shelter be limited to those who are seriously interested in adopting an animal, bringing an animal to us, picking up their animal that has been picked up as a stray, or conducting other business (e.g. purchasing county dog tags, picking up spay/neuter rebate certificates, or donating items for our yard sale). No more than five will be allowed to go in the animal areas at the same time.

At this time, we are discouraging casual visits to the shelter. Since schools are closed, it may be tempting to bring children to the shelter to look at the animals, but we ask that parents do not do this. Updates will be provided on our Facebook page and website (dahsinc.com).

Visitors, staff, and volunteers are asked to wash their hands frequently and to use hand sanitizer that we have available. This has always been something we have always encouraged to prevent the spread of disease from humans to animals. For example, people may pet an animal and then pet another one, unknowingly spreading germs. We also ask that people practice social-distancing and understand when we do not shake your hand.

Volunteers who have been through the orientation training may come; however, we ask that they schedule the time on the calendar we have at the

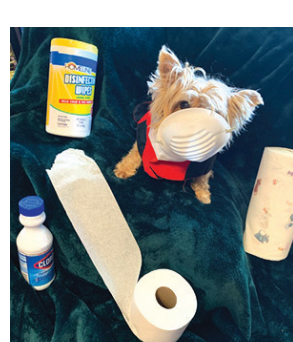
front desk. If volunteers feel ill, please stay home!

Obviously, anyone who has flu-like symptoms, or feel sick with a fever and cough, please be courteous and stay away.

For years, we have encouraged people to have a plan in place for pets during an emergency. Pandemics are handled differently from natural disasters; however, with the possibility of a forced-quarantine, please make sure each pet has a supply of food and medicine readily available

This would be a good time for healthy people to prepare for a time when they may become ill. Make arrangements with a trusted family member, friend, neighbor, or pet sitter who can care for your pet if you become ill and are hospitalized. Always, always, make sure pets have proper identification on them!

We join the entire world in hoping that the pandemic will be short-lived and life as we have enjoyed it in the past can return! For now, though, please help us keep shelter staff and animals safe and healthy by following the guidelines above.

Answering Your Safety & Security Questions

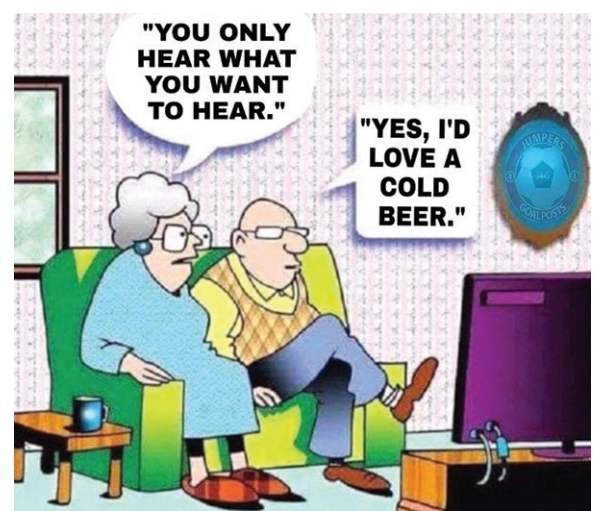

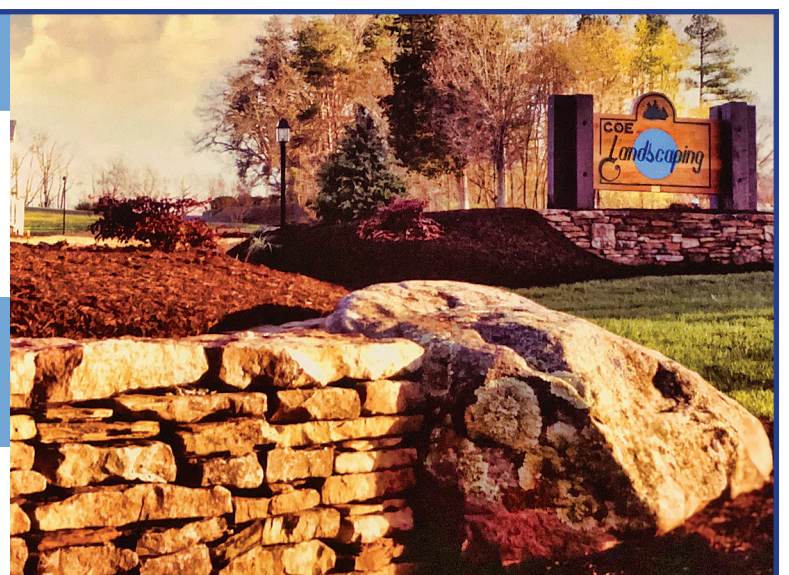

Lemon Asparagus Chicken Pasta



INGREDIENTS

- Kosher salt
- 1 lb. linguine or spaghetti
- 1 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 lb. boneless skinless chicken breasts
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 2 tsp. Italian seasoning
- 2 tbsp. butter
- 1 small red onion, chopped
- 1 lb. asparagus, stalks trimmed and cut into thirds or quartered if large
- 3/4 c. heavy cream
- 1/2 c. low-sodium chicken broth
- Juice of 1 lemon
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 3/4 c. shredded mozzarella
- 1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan, plus more for garnish
- 1 lemon, sliced into half moons
- Freshly chopped parsley, for garnish

DIRECTIONS

In a large pot of salted boiling water, cook pasta according to package directions until al dente. Drain and return to pot.

In a skillet over medium heat, heat olive oil. Add chicken and season with salt, pepper, and Italian seasoning. Cook until golden and no longer pink, 8 minutes per side. Transfer to a plate to let rest, then thinly slice.

To skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Add red onion and asparagus and season with salt and pepper. Cook until tender, 5 minutes, then add heavy cream, chicken broth, lemon juice, and garlic and simmer 5 minutes.

Stir in cheeses and let cook until melty, then add lemon slices and cooked linguine.

Top with sliced chicken and garnish with more Parmesan and parsley.

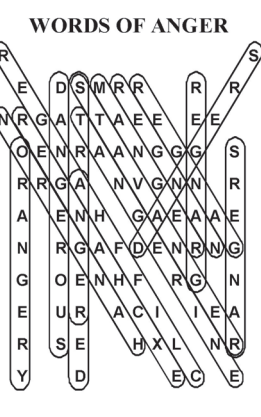

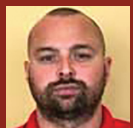

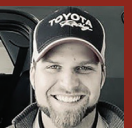
