





Testing Not Required and Not Feasible for Return to Work

Spencer Hospital's Emergency Department and Avera Medical Group Spencer have been contacted by local citizens who state they are being required by their business to be screened for COVID-19 (Coronavirus Disease 19) prior to being permitted to return to work following an illness. Testing of people who do not meet the Iowa Department of Public Health's screening protocol is not necessary or feasible.


The Centers for Disease Control & Prevention guidelines are: Employees who have symptoms of acute respiratory illness are recommended to stay home and not come to work until they are free of fever (100.4° F [38.0° C] or greater using an oral thermometer), signs of a fever, and any other symptoms for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing or other symptom-altering medicines (e.g. cough suppressants). Employees should notify their supervisor and stay home if they are sick.





Local Experts Discuss COVID-19 Testing Availability

are confirmed in Iowa and across the country, many people are wondering if they have the virus and asking what they can do to get tested. Conflicting information from across the country has added to the confusion.

"The first question anyone should ask when considering if they should get tested for coronavirus is if they have traveled to an area with ongoing spread of the virus, or if they have come into close personal contact with someone who has tested positive," said Dr. Stephanie Johnson, pathologist and Medical Director of Spencer Hospital's Laboratory.

Dr. Johnson added: "If you happen to meet these criteria, then you need to assess yourself for symptoms of coronavirus including a fever over 100.4 degrees, cough, and shortness of breath. People who have met the contact criteria and have symptoms should call their physician's office for further evaluation and to determine if they need testing." She emphasized: "if at any time you should develop difficulty breathing, pain or pressure in your chest, confusion, or bluish lips or face, you should call 911 or your local emergency department and seek medical attention immediately.'

Besides the criteria for individual testing, there has been a significant amount of media attention given to local and national availability of testing.

"Locally, we have the supplies needed to collect samples from people who meet the criteria for testing," said Jordan Reed, Spencer Hospital's Laboratory Director. "We have worked closely with local physicians, using regional and national resources, to develop criteria to test patients that ensures local testing materials are used appropriately while providing testing and care when it is indicated.'

Reed added: "While the sample is collected from a person within our community, the test-

As more cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) ing for coronavirus is performed at the State Hygienic Laboratory at the University of Iowa or at a regional reference laboratory so it's important we meet the testing protocol for those labs before collecting a specimen."

Reed continued: "Beyond concern for conservation of local testing materials, the materials needed to conduct the actual test for coronavirus at state and national labs are limited. Development of new medical tests is a complicated process that typically takes years, so limitations in testing supply is due to a combination of this developmental process and the fact that coronavirus is a new virus that we couldn't even test for in the United States outside of the CDC (Centers for Disease Control & Prevention) prior to February 7."

Despite the current limitations, Reed remains optimistic. "Every day we get updates about progress testing sites are making to add testing and testing capacity," he shared. "The nation's testing is projected to increase over ten times its current capacity within the next two weeks."

As the region's and country's capacity to test for coronavirus grows, patients should start to see results from testing in a shorter amount of time. "Currently it is taking from 2-7 days to receive patient results," Reed said, "as more locations offer testing and increase capacity, we will see that time decrease to 2-3 days."

In summary, Dr. Johnson added, "The current testing situation for coronavirus highlights the importance of social distancing in order to 'flatten the curve', which means giving the healthcare system the opportunity to build testing capacity and the ability to respond healthcare needs when they arise." She finishes by commenting, "The best thing people can do right now to improve testing for coronavirus is to stay home, avoid contact with others, and to call your physician's office for further evaluation if you feel ill."

At this time Lakes Area Farmers Market plans to open in June for the 2020 season. Management is currently discussing changes and safety procedures to keep the market safe for customers and vendors. We will stay in contact with local health departments for their latest recommendations. The current recommendation calls for gatherings of no more than 10 people, therefore Lakes Area Farmers Market is postponing their April 2 meeting. The meeting is now tentatively set for April 22, at 6:00pm, at Spirit Lake library. More information will be available closer to that date. Persons interested in becoming a vendor at Lakes Area Farmers Market in Spirit Lake are invited to attend this meeting. Lakes Area Farmers Market requires that vendors grow or make what they sell and live in Dickinson or surrounding counties. If you have questions, call 712-336-4430 and leave a message. We are working to make the Farmers Market as safe as possible so you may enjoy the benefits of fresh local food. We hope to see you there.

"Governor Reynolds issued a proclamation on 3/19/2020, that waives late penalty on property tax payments through April 16, 2020, to help give some assistance to Iowans dealing with the impact of COVID-19's arrival in our state," says Dickinson County Treasurer Kris Rowley. "Payments must be postmarked by April 16, 2020, paid online at www.IowaTaxAndTags.org by April 16, 2020, or dropped off in the Dickinson County Treasurer drop box outside the Courthouse by April 16th to avoid a late penalty Payments can also be called in to the office.'

The county offices at the Dickinson County Courthouse closed to the public at noon on 3/17/2020, due to concerns over CO-VID-19 in Iowa and surrounding states. "Sadly the Coronavirus has changed how we live our lives and conduct our business,' says Rowley. "My staff are still here at the office handling our workflow and answering questions by phone and email. Many of the driver's license and motor vehicle deadlines have been extended through a State of Public Health Emergency Proclamation made by Governor Reynolds on 3/17/2020 backdated to 3/16/2020."

If your driver's license has an expiration date of January 16, 2020 or later, you do not have to renew your license at this time. It will remain valid until the declared disaster is lifted. It is s also considered valid to fly in some instances with an expired driver's license or state-issued ID if the expiration date was on or after March 1, 2020. Check with TSA to make sure you can fly if yours is expired.

If your vehicle registration expired January 16, 2020, or later, it will be considered valid until the declared disaster has ended.

If you purchase or transfer a vehicle, you will not be required to obtain a title and registration within 30 days. This will remain in effect until the declared disaster is over. Carry your purchase documents/bill of sale in your car when driving until it is transferred into your name and plated. The bill of sale is also needed at the treasurer's office to complete the transfer.

If you purchase a vehicle from a dealer, you will not be required to obtain license plates within 45 days. This will remain in effect until the declared disaster is over. Carry your purchase documents in your car when driving until it is transferred into your name and plated.

On non-interstate roads only, trucks hauling food, medical supplies, cleaning products or other household goods may exceed the weights listed in Iowa Code 321.463 by 12.5% without a permit so long as they don't exceed 20,000 pounds on an individual axle and their total weight does not exceed 90,000 pounds. Trucks are still required to obey posted bridge restrictions.

Rowley says, "The website for Dickinson County is https:// dickinsoncountyiowa.org. Many of the motor vehicle forms are available on this website. There are also links to the Iowa Tax and Tags website, www.IowaTaxAndTags.org, for making property tax and motor vehicle renewal payments.

Local COVID-19 **Call Center Established**

To help manage the number of calls related to COVID-19 to the local family practice clinics and Spencer Hospital emergency department, a Clay County Medical Community COVID-19 Call Center has been established and will be operational effective March 18.

'The clinic and hospital are receiving numerous calls from people who are concerned about their risk for becoming infected with COVID-19," explained Colette Rossiter, Clay County Public Health nurse. "The call center is designed to help people determine if they meet the criteria for testing. If they do, they will be asked to call their physician for further instructions."

Nate McCormick, Avera Medical Group Spencer manager, added: "In our region, all tests for COVID-19 are transported to the University of Iowa to the State Hygienic Laboratory where the tests are conducted. This means that locally we can only collect a test sample if the patient meets the state lab's criteria as they will not run a specimen from a patient who does not meet protocol."

The local COVID-19 Call Center will operate from 7:00am -7:00pm each weekday. The local number is 712-264-6514 and the toll-free number is 1-800-848-0638.

Avera Medical Group Spencer

March 18, 2020 - Spencer Clinic Urges 'Call First' – Drive-up Testing Will Be Available for Some Conditions Avera Medical Group Spencer (AMGS) has implemented drive-up testing for patients who have been referred by an AMGS provider to specifically come to the clinic to be tested for influenza, RSV or strep throat.

"In addition to encouraging the public to practice social distancing, we're practicing medical distancing as well," explained Dr. Nathaniel Meyer, family practitioner at AMGS. "At this time, walk-ins are not permitted for any health concern, which means every patient needs to call first for an appointment prior to being seen. During that phone call, it will be determined if the patient meets our criteria for using the drive-up testing for the respiratory illnesses of strep, influenza or RSV. We will only test and run lab tests on patients who have a physician's or provider's order."

Dr. Amanda Young, AMGS family practitioner and president of the Spencer Medical staff, emphasized that patients must call the clinic first for instruction. "If a patient meets criterion for strep, influenza or RSV testing, a physician or healthcare provider will initiate an order for the test and provide instructions for curb-side testing. We will not test patients curb-side or in the clinic without an order."

Dr. Young added: "We are here to care for the community. If you feel you need to be seen rather than have a drive-up test, we have a process in place for that as well. Our goal is to practice medical distancing as much as possible, while continuing to meet our patient's needs and reduce the spread of illness."

If these more common illnesses are ruled out, healthcare providers can further assess patients and determine if they meet the current state guidelines for COVID-19 testing.

While AMGS and Spencer Hospital both have a limited supply of test kits available, that only enables a specimen swab to be collected locally. Testing for COVID-19 is conducted the State Hygienic Laboratory at the University of Iowa (SHL).

Due to a global shortage of supplies, the state hygienic lab, currently will only perform tests on patients with confirmation of one or more of the criteria below:

Hospitalized patient with fever and respiratory failure and no alternate diagnosis

· Hospitalized older adult (> 60 years of age) with fever or respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, difficulty breathing) and chronic medical conditions (e.g., diabetes, heart disease, immunosuppressive medications, chronic lung disease, or chronic kidney disease)

· Any person (including healthcare providers) with household contact with a laboratory confirmed case of COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to becoming ill with fever or respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, difficulty breathing)

· Any person with a history of international travel to a country with a Level 3 CDC travel health warning (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/index.html) or has taken an international cruise in the 14 days prior to becoming ill with fever and respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, difficulty breathing) and no alternate diagnosis

"In addition to implementing drive-up testing for certain illnesses, we are making other temporary changes to help protect our patients' health and well-being," commented Dr. Young. "This includes working with elderly patients or those patients who have underlying medical conditions to reschedule routine appointments to a later date."

Curb-side testing for patients with a physician order is currently in effect and available during clinic hours, 8:00am – 6:30pm, Monday through Thursday and until 5:00pm on Fridays.




