The Mount Morris Central School District can help residents who are essential health care workers and first responders find and obtain childcare.



County Officials Express Opposition to Proposed Medicaid Changes

Meeting with NYS Federal Delegation in DC

Livingston County officials expressed their opposition to Governor Andrew Cuomo’s proposed changes to the New York State Local Medicaid Cost Cap in a letter sent this week to the County’s State Legislative Delegation. The letter was sent to Assemblywoman Marjorie Byrnes and Senators Patrick Gallivan and George Borrello.

In the letter, County Administrator Ian M. Coyle said that the proposed changes to the Local Medicaid Cost Cap will make it more difficult for the County to stay within the local property tax cap and maintain a fiscally-sound and balanced budget. Under the Governor’s proposal, which was included as part of the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Executive Budget:

- Counties that fail to stay within the property tax cap in a fiscal year will lose necessary New York State Medicaid Growth payments;
- Counties that fail to keep increases in local share costs and associated state savings within 3% will be required to pay any excess amount to the State; and
- Federal savings expected to be distributed as part of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) will be capped to Counties, but not to the State.

“Medicaid costs are hurting local governments across New York State,” said Coyle. “Not only will the Governor’s proposal to make significant changes to the local Medicaid Cap impose fiscal stress on local governments, but they will also render inert the Governor’s signature local government achievement: the property tax cap. Shifting higher Medicaid costs to Counties will only serve to increase the necessity of Counties to override the property tax cap, which would open up Counties to even higher Medicaid costs as a penalty for overriding the cap. I urge Livingston County’s Legislative Delegation to research the Governor’s local Medicaid Cap proposals and work to reduce and/or eliminate the significant changes being made to the cap. After all, 30% of Livingston County’s tax levy already goes to Albany to fund just one program – our Medicaid share – and we do not need it to be even more.”

In addition to working with the County’s State Legislative Delegation, Coyle will join NYSAC leadership and other County officials in meeting with U.S. Senators Charles Schumer and Kirsten Gillibrand in Washington D.C. this week to discuss state and federal actions surrounding the Medicaid program and to push against the State’s proposed action on the ACA-related distributions.

Mount Morris, NY, March 26, 2020: The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting two new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to seven.

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, the first individual is a female in her 30s who resides in Geneseo and was tested at her medical provider's office. She is currently in a private residence under mandatory quarantine. Two household members related to this case are also under mandatory quarantine. The second individual is a male in his 20s who resides in Geneseo and was tested at his medical provider's office. He is currently in a private residence under mandatory quarantine. One household member related to this case is also under mandatory quarantine.

In accordance with state and federal medical privacy laws, additional information about these individual will not be provided. LCDOH was notified of these positive cases this morning. Rodriguez stated that LCDOH will immediately begin outreach to identify close contacts and potential exposure areas per prescribed New York State regulations.

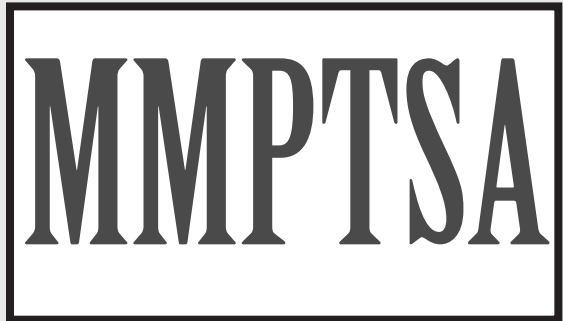

Livingston County Operations Amid COVID-19 Crisis

On Friday, March 20, 2020, Livingston County officials announced additional building and operational restrictions aimed at curbing the spread of COVID-19, or the coronavirus, in the County. Livingston County encourages residents to practice social distancing and limit public engagement as much as possible.

The County workforce will still be taking calls, responding to requests, checking emails, processing mail and other work and generally going about their essential business tasks but with significantly reduced staff on-site and in buildings that are now closed to the public.

Livingston County's first responders, including Emergency Medical Services and the Sheriff's Office, are still out in full force with the ability to respond to emergencies.

As of March 24th, these are the most up-to-date changes to Livingston County operations:
