

tablespoons all-purp Salt

Freshly ground black pepper

(23/4-pound) tied pork shoulder roast, netting or string intact

tablespoon peanut or vegetable oil, plus more, if needed

1 tablespoon olive oil

2 medium leeks, halved lengthwise and cut into half-moons

2 cloves garlic, finely chopped 1/2 pound small yellow pearl onions, peeled

I tablespoon chopped fresh thyme

3 to 4 cups hard apple cider

1 tart apple, peeled, cored and cubed

tablespoon Dijon mustard

1 tablespoon chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley



1. Preheat oven to 325 F. Heat a large, heavy, ovenproof soup pot or Dutch oven (with a tight-fitting lid) over medium-high heat. Place the flour on a small plate. Season the flour liberally with salt and pepper. Pat the pork dry: then coat it on all sides with the flour mixture.

2. When the pot is hot, add the peanut oil and sear the pork (leaving the string on) until nicely browned on all sides, 3-4 minutes per side. Transfer the pork to a plate, and carefully wipe the pot clean with paper towels. Reduce the heat to medium.

3. Add the olive oil to the pot, then the leeks, and cook, stirring, for 3 minutes. Add the garlic, onions and thyme, and season with salt and pep-per. Cook and stir for 2 minutes, then nestle the pork in among the vegetables. Add the cider until it comes about halfway up the sides of the pork, cover the pot, and transfer it to the oven. Braise for 1 hour; then turn the pork over, add the apple cubes, and braise for another hour or so, until the pork yields completely when poked with a skewer

4. Transfer the pork to a platter, cover with foil, and let rest. Meanwhile, return the braising liquid to the stove top, and simmer until considerably thickened, about 15 minutes. Stir in the mustard; then season to taste with salt and pepper. Stir in the parsley.

5. Slice the pork and top with the apples, vegetables, and braising liquid. Serving suggestion: This dish is tailor-made to be eaten with a bowl of mashed potatoes, or try it with some traditional Irish colcannon.

fostered. Customer service: Ensuring customers can seamlessly connect with your business, and your customer service staff in particular, should be a priority when switching to a remote work setting. A 2014 study published in The Quarterly Journal of Economics even found that remote working allowed customer service staff to get through 13 percent more calls each day. Remote customer service employees won't have the direct access to management and fellow team members that they had when working onsite, so business owners can employ central management platforms that make it easy to access information regarding new products and services and previous interactions with and responses to customers. That access can help solve issues while reducing the likelihood of substantial lag time as customer service employees wait to hear from coworkers and managers about how to respond to certain issues. Christians believe the apostle Judas betrayed Jesus Christ, a betrayal that led to Christ's crucifixion. Despite some groups denouncing the burning of Judas as anti-Semitic, the practice continues in many countries

• Spain: Holy Week commemorates the entire week preceding Easter Sunday, including Holy Thursday and Good Friday. In the Spanish town of Verges, Christians commemorate Holy Thursday by reenacting scenes from the Passion, which refers to the short period at the end of Christ's life. The "Dansa de la Mort (Death Dance)" is part of that commemoration, and during this dance, participants dress up like skeletons.

nies that previously had not had remote employees. many Employees were suddenly asked to work on home computers that may or may not have had all the necessary applications for them to perform the daily tasks associated with their jobs. Companies that must transition to being remote, whether that transition is temporary or permanent, must recognize that remote employees will need access to software necessary to do their jobs. Workers who only have old computers at home may need to be provided with computers that are compatible with the versions of software used in the office.

Communication:

Communication issues between remote workers can be an easy fix. Even businesses that are facing sudden and forced transitions to remote workerplaces can utilize instant messaging apps like Slack to facilitate immediate communication between employees.
