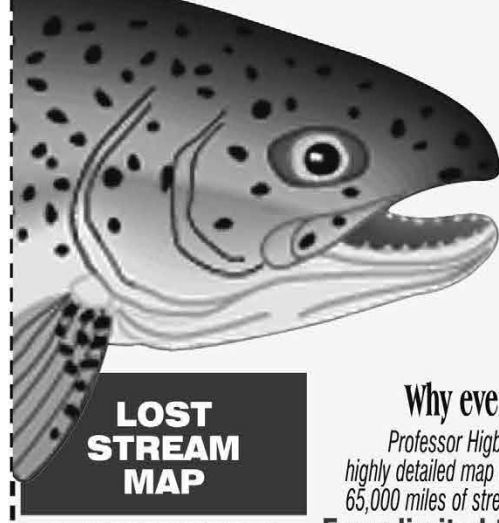

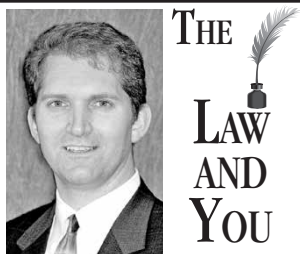
Tips on how to write CLASSIFIED ADS that sell!

- IF THERE IS A GENUINE SENSE OF URGENCY,** say so. The words "We're moving," or "Must sell fast," suggest that readers respond immediately.
- INCLUDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER.** Classifieds get results fast and often generate immediate sales. If you cannot be available to answer the phone at all times, be sure to specify special calling times such as "after 9pm" or "before 11am."

THE REALITY OF PRENUPTIAL AGREEMENTS

Prenuptial agreements have a bad rep for being manipulative and unfair, mostly due to their portrayal in movies and television. The reality of this legal document, however, is far less dramatic, and there are rules to ensure this is so. For example clauses stipulating physical appearance or sexual activity are almost always ignored by the court, as is anything that could be deemed extremely one-sided or unfair. Verbal agreements are also not considered valid, and in many states, each party must have legal representation when creating a prenup. Prenuptial agreements are primarily financial in nature, and for many couples, beginning a marriage with specific stipulations already established can provide a sense of security that helps avoid tension and anxiety.

Some people worry that bringing up the word "prenuptial agreement," will cause difficulty in their relationship. Often times, the opposite is true. One of the main irreconcilable differences leading to divorce is finances. Talking to your spouse ahead of time regarding finances, property, and marital asset management can avoid a lot of these disagreements. 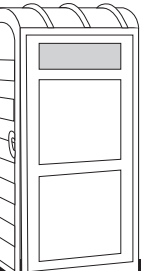

Governor extends closures for schools, many businesses until April 29

Gov. Andrew Cuomo announced today he has extended the closure for schools and many businesses in the state until at least April 29. The governor on March 16 first announced schools would be closed for two weeks until April 1, due to health concerns about the coronavirus.

"I'm not going to choose between public health and economic activity," Cuomo said during a news conference today. The virus continues to have a deadly toll in the state. Cuomo announced 599 people died from the virus on Saturday, bringing the state's total deaths from COVID-19 to 4,758. The state also has 8,658 new confirmed cases of the virus, bringing the total to 130,689 in the state.

The governor said social distancing seems to be slowing the rate of increase in new cases and deaths, but the Cuomo said it is still a high number in the state. He said New Yorkers throughout the state need to take social distancing more seriously to further reduce the number of new cases. He urged local governments to enforce social distancing in public, keeping people at least six feet apart. He also announced fines for noncompliance would be increased from \$500 to \$1,000.

"None of us has the right to be reckless with our own behavior," Cuomo said. "Now is not the time to be playing frisbee in the park with your friends. Now is not the time to attend a funeral with 200 other people."

Getting Here to There on Your Wedding Day

You've planned the date, met with the officiant, decided on what to wear, and booked the venue. But how are you going to arrive in style?

Arranging wedding transportation can be tricky, even if it seems like it's a relatively minor detail. However, getting not only the bride and groom, as well as the rest of the bridal party and guests, from point A to point B and even point C is often a taller task than it seems.

The wedding planning resource The Knot says couples should begin focusing on transportation between four and six months before their weddings. If the wedding will be held during prom or graduation season, couples may want to reserve vehicles even earlier due to high demand.

While rented transportation is not necessary, it's a luxury many couples prefer, as it allows them to leave the driving to someone else. Generally speaking, hired cars will pick up the bride and groom separately before the ceremony; otherwise, they will arrive to the ceremony by other means and then utilize a limo or other vehicle afterward. The transportation will then take the married couple and typically members of the bridal party and immediate family to the reception venue.

Depending on the head count and how many other people will be getting a lift, two or more vehicles may be necessary. And since the limos will leave after the reception drop off, some other form of transportation will be necessary to take the couple and whomever else rode to the reception back home (or to the airport). This may require dropping off one or more personal cars at the reception venue in advance.

Budget also will dictate if transportation is provided for other guests. The majority of guests will drive their own cars to the wedding. However, if the ceremony and reception site are far apart or if the journey is arduous and out of the way, some well-meaning couples will arrange for transport. Many times couples will have to opt for function over form when tasked with transporting a large number of people. Pricing out different options can yield the most cost-effective route, which very well may be a school or charter bus instead of several limousines.

Couples can start the process by asking their reception venue for transportation recommendations. Or if there are hotel accommodations after the party, the hotel may have connections or offer shuttle services. ■

Travel and COVID-19

The global travel industry has been in turmoil since the outbreak of the novel coronavirus COVID-19 in December 2019. Many would-be travelers, including business travelers and vacationers, canceled previously planned trips or delayed future travel plans in the hopes of reducing their risk of catching a virus that CNN estimated had claimed more than 4,000 lives across the globe between December 2019 and mid-March 2020. According to estimates from the Global Business Travel Association, business travel revenue loss totaled \$820 billion across the globe through the first week of March 2020. The International Air Transport Association estimated that global airlines stood to lose \$113 billion in sales if the coronavirus continued to spread, a decline in sales that the industry has not experienced since the global financial crisis of 2008. That loss in revenue has led many airlines and cruise lines to decrease prices in an effort to entice more people to travel. However, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention note that travel could be dangerous, particularly for people with underlying health conditions who intend to take cruises. As of March 2020, the CDC was recommending that travelers who fit that criteria defer all cruise ship travel. Cruises place vast numbers of people in frequent and close contact with each other, conditions that can promote the spread of respiratory viruses like COVID-19. The CDC notes that, due to the way air is circulated and filtered on airplanes, most viruses and other germs do not easily spread on airplanes. However, those who want to err on the side of caution should discuss travel with their physicians, including whether or not it's beneficial to delay unnecessary travel plans until the threat of COVID-19 is minimized.

FACT 1 Diseases can make anyone sick regardless of their race or ethnicity.

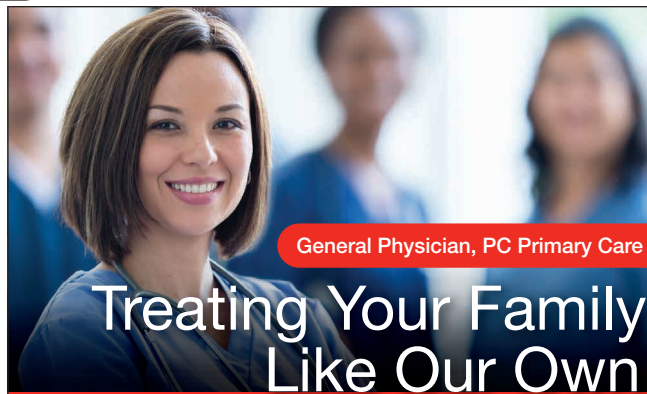

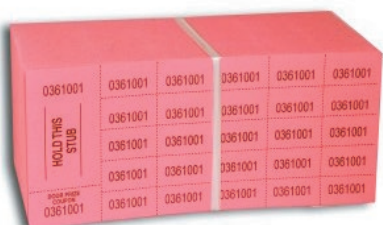

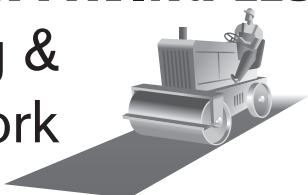

Albion village budget would keep tax rate the same

ALBION — The Albion Village Board has put together a \$6,872,286 budget that keeps the tax rate at \$17.80 per \$1,000 of assessed property.

The budget would increase the tax levy, what the village collects in taxes, by \$17,252, or by less than 1 percent (0.6 percent). The tax levy would go from \$2,730,417 in 2019-2020 to \$2,747,669 in 2020-21.

The board held a public hearing on the budget Wednesday. Residents could only comment through the Zoom online option because the village hall is currently closed to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic. No one commented on the budget during the hearing.

The board is scheduled to adopt the budget at 6 p.m. on April 22. The fiscal year starts June 1 and runs to May 31, 2021.

Mayor Eileen Banker is pleased the budget doesn't increase the tax rate. She is concerned state and county revenues that are in the budget may not come through at the budgeted amounts. That includes road paving and maintenance funding from the state (CHIPS) and some of the local sales tax revenue distributed by the county.

If those revenues don't meet expectations, the village will likely have to make some adjustments.

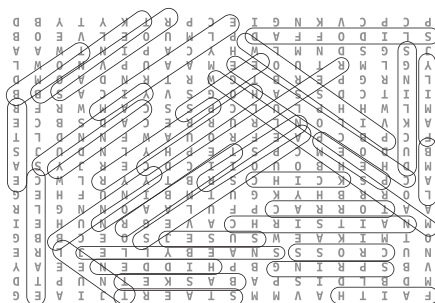
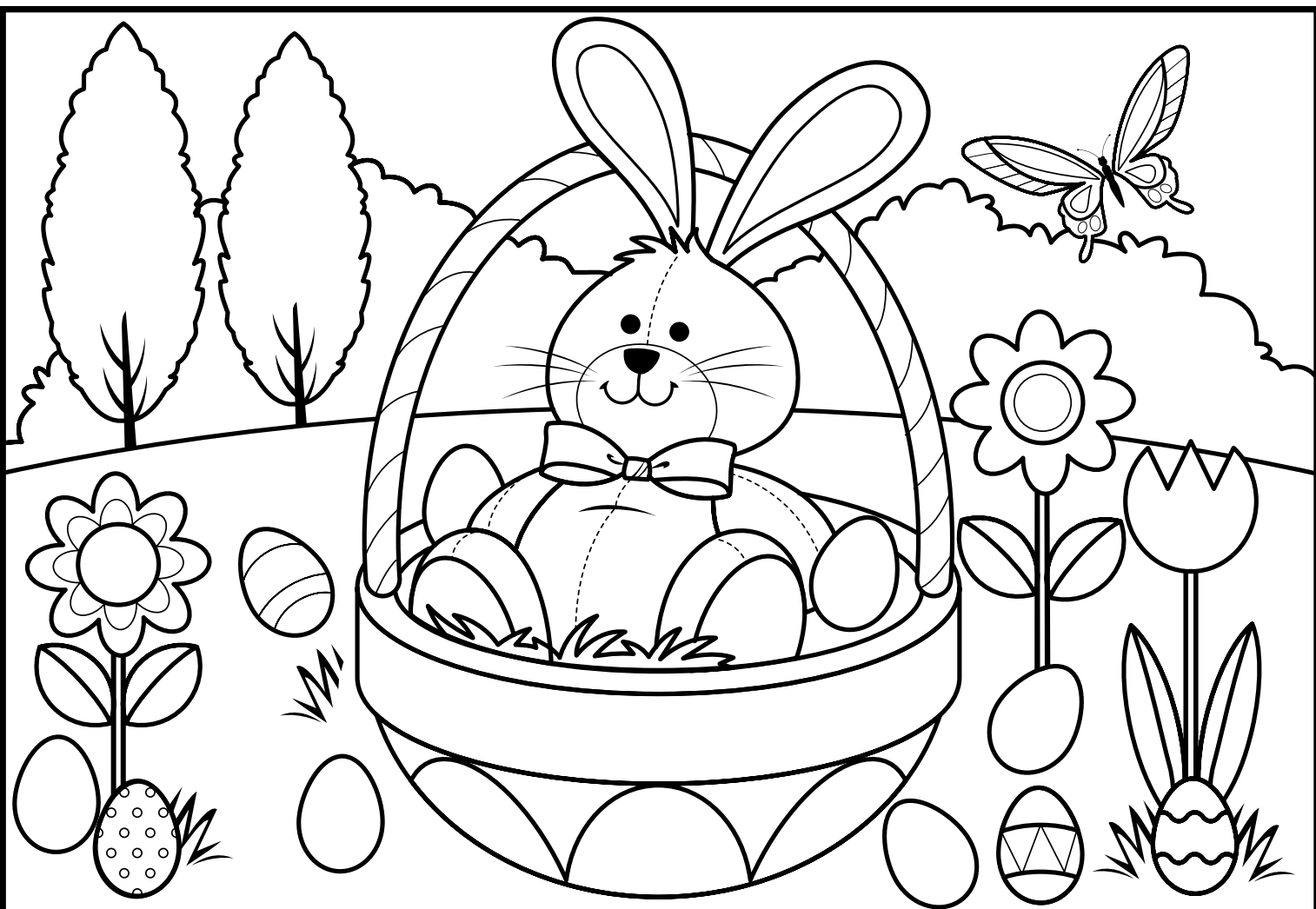

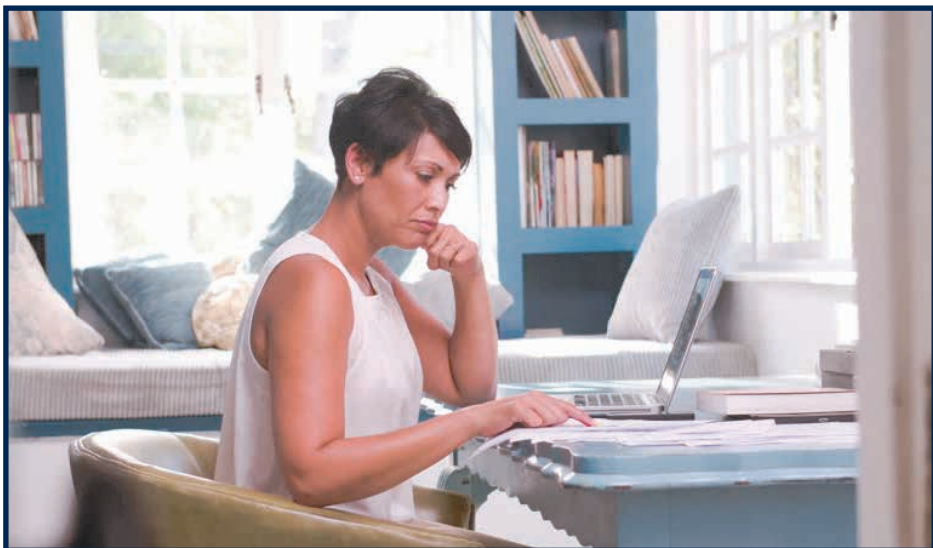
