



The Department of Homeland Security recently announced that President Donald Trump ordered the deadline for the REAL ID program to be extended by a year due to the CO-VID-19 crisis. The program requires U.S. travelers to obtain REAL ID-complaint driver's licenses in order to board domestic and international flights.

According to a statement from Chad Wolf, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security, "Due to circumstances resulting from the CO-VID-19 pandemic and the national emergency declaration, the Department of Homeland Security, as directed by President Donald J. Trump, is extending the REAL ID enforcement deadline beyond the current October 1, 2020 deadline. I have determined that states require a twelvemonth delay and that the new deadline for REAL ID enforcement is October 1, 2021. DHS will publish a notice of the new deadline in the Federal Register in the coming days."



#### Governor Directs All People to Wear Face Coverings if Unable to Maintain Social Distance

On Wednesday, April 15, 2020, Governor Cuomo released Executive Order 202.17, which requires all people in New York State to wear face coverings when they are in a situation where they cannot maintain "social distancing." This state directive will take effect on Friday, April 17, 2020 at 8:00PM.

Any individual who is over the age of two and able to medically tolerate a face covering must be required to cover their nose and mouth with a mask or cloth face covering when in a public place and unable to maintain, or when not maintaining, social distance.

This state directive is applicable through May 15, 2020 and does not include any civil penalty at this time. Questions on this order can be directed to the Governor's general inquiry phone line at 518-474-8390.


