

PACE** ATTORNEY AT LAW WHAT IS AN "IRREVOCABLE" **CONTRACT?** A contract is a legally binding agreement between parties that consists of an offer, an acceptance of that offer, and agreement on the financial terms of the contract. Once those three steps are completed, a contract is considered "irrevocable" unless conditions have been established, in writing, for revoking it. Offers can usually be altered or withdrawn at any time before they are approved, but once accepted, both parties are legally bound to the contracted terms. This does not mean that one party can be forced to carry out services if they change their minds, but it does mean they can be held financially responsible in a

court of law for doing so. The term irrevocable does not mean that a party cannot refuse to perform its obligations, but rather that it can be held financially liable in a court of law for such refusal. The only exception would be if the terms of the contract specifically state that one or both parties can revoke it in certain situations. 

Recommendation for Cloth Face Coverings

The CDC continues to study the spread and effects of the novel coronavirus across the United States. We now know from recent studies that a significant portion of individuals with coronavirus lack symptoms ("asymptomatic") and that even those who eventually develop symptoms ("pre-symptomatic") can transmit the virus to others before showing symptoms. This means that the virus can spread between people interacting in close proximity—for example, speaking, coughing, or sneezing—even if those people are not exhibiting symptoms. In light of this new evidence, CDC recommends wearing cloth face coverings in public settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain (e.g., grocery stores and pharmacies) especially in areas of significant community-based transmission.

It is critical to emphasize that maintaining 6-feet social distancing remains important to slowing the spread of the virus. CDC is additionally advising the use of simple cloth face coverings to slow the spread of the virus and help people who may have the virus and do not know it from transmitting it to others. Cloth face coverings fashioned from household items or made at home from common materials at low cost can be used as an additional, voluntary public health measure.

The cloth face coverings recommended are not surgical masks or N-95 respirators. Those are critical supplies that must continue to be reserved for healthcare workers and other medical first responders, as recommended by current CDC guidance.



Holley village budget will cut tax rate by 21 cents

HOLLEY — The Holley Village Board has approved a tentative budget that would reduce the tax rate from \$16.41 to \$16.20 per \$1,000 of assessed property. The board held a public hearing on the budget on Tue., April 14. The meeting was done online through Zoom. The Village Office remains closed to the public due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This was the village's first meeting online.

The budget will be formally adopted later this month. The village fiscal year runs from June 1 to May 31. Although the tax rate will be going down, the village will be collecting more in property taxes. The tax levy will go up 2.3 percent or by \$20,483 from \$887,999 to \$908,482. The tax rate will go down because the village's tax base grew by about \$2 million. The village assessed value is up 3.6 percent or \$1,967,513, from \$54,098,660 to \$56,066,173. The general fund portion of the budget – office, DPW, police, employee benefits and general debt – totals \$1,239,434, while the water budget is \$436,401 and the sewer budget is \$180,338.

Mayor Brian Sorochty said village officials have been working hard on the budget in recent months. He is pleased the tax rate will go down and the budget is under the property tax cap. However, he said the village will have to be extra careful this coming fiscal year because state and federal funding may change due to the economic strains from COVID-19's impact on the economy. "We will really need scrutinize spending given the uncertainty," Sorochty said.

In other action at the meeting, the Village Board:

- Approving spending \$1,500 for the Waste Water Treatment to purchase two submersible pumps from Goodwin and 100 feet of lay flat hose.
- Approved spending \$600 for the Police Department's annual defibrillator certification conducted by Zoll.
- Approved spending \$3605.83 for the Water Department to buy a Well Pump from Bailey Electric.
- Authorized spending \$3,800 for the Water Department to buy four sampling stations from Blair Supply.
- Approved up to \$900 for flowers and mulch for containers on Public Square and Wright Street.

The outlook for nurses is very strong

Many people consider the right job one that provides both a sense of fulfillment and the opportunity to achieve financial security and stability as one's career advances. Given that criteria, the field of nursing should make for an attractive career path.

The outlook for registered nurses, often referred to as "RNs," is very strong. In its recent "Occupational Outlook

Handbook," the Bureau of Labor Statistics, a division of the U.S. Department of Labor, issued a highly favorable employment outlook for registered nurses. According to the Canadian Occupation Projections System, which is provided by Employment and Social Development Canada, new job openings for registered nurses and registered psychiatric nurses are expected to total 157,100 between 2017 and 2026. The ESDC anticipates a nursing shortage during that same period, estimating that only 143,900 new job seekers will be available to fill those positions. But that gap between job openings and qualified candidates means that nurses should not experience much difficulty in regard to finding work. While the outlook in terms of availability of work is strong for current nurses and those who aspire to one day follow this career path, that outlook should not alone compel people to pursue a career in nursing. Few fields can be as demanding as nursing, which means not everyone is necessarily cut out to be a nurse. The demands are perhaps best exemplified by examining the hours registered nurses may expect to work, especially at the beginning of their careers when they have no seniority. The BLS notes that hospitals and nursing care facilities require round-the-clock employees every day of the year. That means nurses can expect to work long hours on nights, weekends and holidays. That requires considerable sacrifice on the part of nurses, and those aspiring to enter this line of work should consider if they're willing to make those sacrifices before enrolling in a nursing program. Estimates suggest the employment outlook for qualified nurses will be very strong over the next several years, which should compel more and more talented people to pursue this fulfilling career path.



Memorial Day parade in Lyndonville cancelled due to COVID-19 concerns

LYNDONVILLE – The Memorial Day parade has been cancelled in Lyndonville, Steve Goodrich, the American Legion commander for the Houseman-Tanner Post 1603, announced this morning. Several of the American Legion Posts in Western New York have announced they are cancelling the parades on May 25 due to concerns about COVID-19.

Goodrich said the average age of the post members in Lyndonville is 83. "I can't in good conscience put them at risk," Goodrich said. "I feel it is only prudent to take this action for the safety of everyone."

News organizations in Western New York are reporting Memorial Day parades are cancelled in Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda, West Seneca, Lewiston, Lockport, Rochester and Irondequoit. Goodrich said he has plans to recognize veterans in Lyndonville on Memorial Day. He asked community members to send him the names of local people currently serving in the military. He wants them to publicly acknowledged in the near future.

The American Legion in Lyndonville also places more than 400 flags on veterans' graves right before Memorial Day. Goodrich said he doesn't want the older members to be at risk with that duty. Goodrich said he will place the flags alone when he gets out of work. He said it will be a gradual process and urges the public's understanding.

"If one is missed, I ask you notify me," he said in a Facebook message on the Lyndonville, NY People page. "I will ensure any overlooked will receive a flag."



Salmon, Asparagus and Orzo Salad With Lemon-Dill Vinaigrette

Makes 6 servings



6 cups water

- 1 pound asparagus, trimmed and cut into 3-inch pieces
- 1 cup uncooked orzo
- 1 (1 1/4-pound) skinless salmon fillet
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

- 1/4 cup thinly sliced red onion

1. Preheat broiler.

3. Return reserved water to a boil. Add orzo, and cook according to package directions, omitting salt and fat.

4. While orzo cooks, sprinkle fillet evenly with salt and pepper. Place fish on a foil-lined broiler pan coated with cooking spray. Broil 5 minutes, or until desired degree of doneness. Using 2 forks, break fish into large chunks. Combine fish, orzo, asparagus, onion, and Lemon-Dill Vinaigrette in a large bowl; toss gently to coat.
