



My uncle was in hospice and started having more pain. His hospice said the family must 'revoke' hospice so he could go to the ER and be admitted. I thought that it was hospice's job to control his pain and keep him out of hospital.

> There are really two issues here.

1. Can you take him to the ER? One of Medicare's goals for hospice patients is to help them remain at home

and die there comfortably with dignity. Therefore, hospice is obligated to do whatever it takes to achieve that, including providing continuous care if necessary.

If the hospice can't control a symptom, patients can be taken to the ER either to be stabilized and return home, or to be admitted; both are covered by Medicare.

Hospice cannot force a patient to 'revoke' and go to the ER. To 'revoke' means you choose to stop hospice or want a different one. The hospice can only 'discharge' if the patient refuses care, moves away, or is a danger to the hospice staff. Controlling pain must be part of their Plan of Care and if the pain cannot be controlled at home then the hospice is responsible for arranging an admission under hospice.

2. How to control his pain? For mild pain, extendedrelease acetaminophen [Tylenol Arthritis] combined with non-drug options [such as rubbing a mentholated cream, like Bengay or Biofreeze, into the painful area] is often adequate. If that's not enough, narcotics such as hydrocodone, oxycodone, morphine or methadone are used, either by mouth or by injection.

Because we are unique individuals, if a drug didn't help one person, that doesn't mean it won't work for someone else.

So if he is hurting, call the hospice nurse. Ask what they can do now and if a crisis occurs, so you can be better prepared which should help you and your uncle be more comfortable.

Dear Dave,

My parents are going through a divorce, and money issues are a big part of the problem. My dad bought several rental properties and poured money into them. Then, he lost them to foreclosure and isn't making a lot in his new, commission-based job. How can I, as a 25-year-old kid, tell him that his career choices aren't working? Ryan

Dear Ryan,

I'm sorry to hear about your mom and dad. Divorce is never an easy thing, no matter how old you are.

You've probably heard lots of old sayings about how winners never quit. Well, in many cases those are false statements. Winners and successful people quit all the time; they quit doing things that aren't working. This doesn't have to mean that you quit on a dream, but it could mean you change the methodology you're using — especially if it's not getting you anywhere.

Part of being a successful entrepreneur is having the ability to recognize when something isn't working and change it. You sound like a smart, caring young man, but there's little chance that a twenty-something with very little life experience will be able to convince his father of these things. I mean, he's probably in his fifties, right? Plus, he's going through a divorce, and it sounds like he's broke and emotionally worn out.

You've got a great heart, and I'm glad you care enough about your dad to try and help him. But in this scenario, I think he needs to talk to someone like a pastor, or even an older relative or good friend closer to his own age — a guy with a little more life experience. Maybe you could talk to someone like this and explain what your dad is going through. Ask them to talk to him, and see if he'll open up to some new ideas. In the meantime, just be there for him and show all the support you can. You're a good son, Ŕyan. -Dave

interest rate mortgage let's say six percent — and mutual funds at 11 percent or so, is about five percent. And that's assuming nothing goes wrong, and you can get your mutual fund out if needed.

What you're talking about is theory, and what I'm talking about is actual life. In your theory you've left out two major issues: paying taxes on the mutual fund, which would make your yield less, and risk. You've compared a zerorisk investment with a risk investment, and you shouldn't do that. You must factor in risk so you can accurately compare one investment to another.

Every time you pay off a mortgage, the bank no longer charges you interest. That's zero risk compared to a mutual fund, which does have risk. Remember, if your house was paid for you wouldn't borrow \$300,000 against it to invest in mutual funds! —Dave

THE BROWSER IS THE software we all use on our

devices (phone, tablet, computer) to waste time while we should be productive. For the most part, there are three worthy contenders for "The Best": Internet Explorer from Microsoft, Chrome from Google

and Firefox from Mozilla. Some of us geeks would also include Opera and Maxthon but those are mostly special-purpose browsers for folks with

specific needs or just want to drive new software. Mac users generally use Apple's built-in Safari browser but should also consider these alternatives.

First the basics: All PCs come with Internet Explorer **"BROWSER WARS"** by "The Computer Skeptic"

so that's what most of us use. Chrome and Firefox are 100% free and available from their respective websites. I did some research to find out which browser is "best" and happy to report that I have no idea. They are all pretty good but your specific needs will dictate which one is best for you.

What constitutes a "best" browser? Answers vary but what I look for is how fast it launches and how much it slows down my computer, the availability of useful extensions (such as weather bars, incoming text alerts and password keepers), and security (the ability to

block malicious software from installing without my permission).

Microsoft's Internet Explorer (IE) was long regarded as the worst browser because it was so often the target of attacks from scammers and Microsoft didn't update it as often as they should. Hardly a day goes by that I don't have to fix some issue with outdated versions of IE. However, Microsoft has come a long way in improving IE. The latest version, IE 11, is available only for Windows 7 and Windows 8 users. Vista users and you XP holdouts can't play and should immediately download one

of the alternatives mentioned below.

Firefox is an old favorite. It's fast, stable, efficient and loaded with useful extensions. Like IE, Firefox went through a spell where they didn't update it as often as they should so the competition started barking at their heels. The latest version is super fast. Get it from FireFox. com.

Google fans like me prefer Chrome. It's very fast and secure. Google is very strict about what extensions can be loaded so it's more likely to keep your computer out of my shop. If you use lots of Google apps, this is the browser for you. Get it from Google.com/ Chrome.

Where some of the magic really comes alive is when you create a user account (Gmail for Chrome, a Microsoft Account or Firefox's "Sync" account)



ASK THE ATTORNEY

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama. I was injured on the job and workers comp sent me to their doctor who treated me for a few weeks and released me to go back to work but I'm still having problems and they refuse to send me back to the doctor or to another doctor. The first doctor said

I needed an MRI but workers comp wouldn't approve it and I'm still having problems. Is this legal?

> Roger, Tuscumbia, AL

Roger, Joel and I do workers compensation cases day in and day out. All we do is personal injury consisting primarily of automobile accident cases, workers compensation and social security disability. From time to time we involve ourselves with other types of personal injury cases that involve defective products or drug litigation. The rules governing lawyers prohibit us from claiming to be specialists although among lawyers, we all know that most lawyers actually concentrate in specific areas of the law.

Joel and I go to trial on car wreck cases and workers compensation cases fairly frequently. Most people don't want to hear that their case may go to trial, but the fact is, if your case isn't prepared for trial you will never be able to settle the case for its true value. The vast majority of cases settle but the ones that are prepared for trial settle for more. In most of the world, there are two types of lawyers, one type that does primarily legal work out of court and those that specialize in trial work. Around 100 years ago in this country there was a popular movement for that system to be imported from England in recognition that an experienced trial attorney could try a case and get a better result in about half the time that an inexperienced trial attorney could.

In your case, there used to be a "motion for medical treatment" which workers compensation attorneys would file in cases such as yours. The court would usually grant a motion for medical treatment and order the defendant to provide a panel of four doctors that the injured worker could choose from for further medical treatment. The Supreme Court changed the rule in a case some years ago and now we have to cut cases like yours in half and try what is known as a "bifurcated" hearing to obtain denied medical treatment. At that hearing we have to prove by competent evidence that the injured employee was acting in the line and scope of their employment and that the employer had notice of the injury as required by law. We also have to present medical testimony from a doctor who testifies that your injury was caused, contributed to, aggravated or accelerated by the event causing the injury. If those things are proven to the judge's satisfaction, the court will then order the defendant to provide further medical treatment. That is what you will have to do if your employer's compensation carrier will not allow you further medical care. Call us if you would like our assistance. Buckle up and drive safely.



oly Week for Christians worldwide culminated in Good Friday and Easter weekend. We now know how al-Shabab

feels about Holy Week with last week's attack at a University in Kenya where they separated Muslims from Christians - and executed the Christians. Fox News reported that Al-Shabaab claimed

responsibility for an attack at Garissa University in eastern Kenya Thursday

that left at least 147 people dead, dozens more injured and hundreds of students unaccounted for.

"There are many dead bodies of Christians inside the building," spokesman Sheikh Abdiasis Abu Musab told Sky News. "We are also holding many Christians alive. Fighting still goes on inside the college.' Student Union Vice

Chairman Collins Wetangula said, "When the gunmen arrived at his dormitory he

could hear them opening doors and asking if the people who had hidden inside whether they were Muslims or Christians.

"If you were a Christian, you were shot on the spot," he said. "With each blast of the gun I thought I was going to die."

I would hope that we would not deny this was inspired by militant Islamic ideology which must be defeated.

I find it ironic that we are so tolerant of a religion that kills Christians, gays, and lesbians, yet we are punishing businesses in America for their Christian religious beliefs. It seems that Easter week we were reminded that Christian persecution has risen to a disturbing level.





may have your doubts about that. But even if ticks aren't active all 365 days of the year, they are active every month of the year. There will always be a few days that are warm enough for them to make an appearance.

A tick begins the disease transmission cycle when it inserts its sharp mouthpiece into a rodent or deer and feeds on its blood. In the process, the tick takes in bacteria, protozoa and viruses that it later passs on to cats, dogs and humans.

Yes, cats, too. They don't appear to get Lyme disease — yet — but ticks can transmit a deadly disease called cytauxzoonosis to cats, as well as ehrlichia and anaplasmosis. What can you do to word off the beactly

What can you do to ward off the beastly bloodsuckers?

 Start thinking about tick prevention before May. Dr. Little recommends yearround protection, no matter where you live.
 Talk to your veterinarian about the best tick preventive measures for your pet's lifestyle, as well as about the species of ticks found in your area. Products include oral preventives that kill both ticks and fleas on dogs, and long-lasting anti-tick collars for use on dogs and cats.
 Keep grass short and foliage trimmed back to reduce tick habitat.

Climate change among factors that influence tick season, geographic spread of ticks

Tick season is between May and September, right? That has been the conventional wisdom — until recently. Two recently published studies found that deer, or black-legged, ticks — the ones that spread Lyme disease — are emerging earlier and expanding their range, thanks to warmer spring temperatures and milder fall weather. Based on data collected over 19 years, researchers concluded that milder weather allowed nymphs — immature ticks — to feed as much as three weeks earlier in spring. The change in activity may presage a spread of tick-borne diseases, one that's already being seen in some areas.

Tick populations have moved northward into Canada, making Lyme disease endemic in southern Ontario, says Susan E. Little, DVM, who teaches veterinary parasitology at Oklahoma State University and is president of the Companion Animal Parasite Council. Ticks have also moved up in altitude and are now found at higher elevations in Appalachia than in the past.

"It used to be that ticks weren't at 3,000 or 4,000 feet, and now they are," Dr. Little says. "That's a change that we think is due to warming trends."

Ticks are also moving farther south. From

its origins in the Northeast, Lyme disease is now established down the Virginia coast and into North Carolina. In the Midwest, ticks are moving southward across Iowa, through the northern half of Illinois and most of Indiana, and into the lower peninsula of Michigan. One or more species of tick can now be found in every state, including Alaska.

Climate isn't the only culprit. Ticks piggyback on wildlife such as white-tailed deer and coyotes, which spread them to new habitats; they can also be carried away by migratory birds. Habitat modification, such as increasing development in formerly rural areas, also contributes to the expansion of tick territory.

"We're seeing a general expansion of range," Dr. Little says. "It's probably facilitated by longer, warmer periods in most of the country."

If you're still digging out from the snow that buried much of the Northeast this winter, you Discourage deer from grazing near your yard.

✤ Indoor pets can be at risk, too. You can bring ticks in on your clothing or body
— it's happened at my house — and the brown dog tick (Rhipicephalus sanguineus) prefers to live indoors.

Pets don't directly spread tick-borne diseases, but they can bring you into contact with ticks — and vice versa. If your cat goes outdoors or your dog hikes or hunts with you on a regular basis, tick prevention can help protect all of you from disease.







But I didn't get to say it because it was only a moment. A nurse quickly took Ruby and said, "Her oxygen is low. We need to get her to pink up." Pink up? But we were supposed to be celebrating. A moment was all we had.

The next moments, hours, days, and weeks were fast and blurry. "We've got to get the NICU [Neonatal Intensive Care Unit] guys in." "The right side of her heart is not working properly ... " "We are arranging a transport to the Cardiac Intensive Care Unit at Egleston Children's Hospital at Emory University." "The ventilator will allow the baby's body to be able to focus on the heart." Within five hours of that beautiful birth, I was sitting in the front of an ambulance that was carrying Ruby, and my daughter was in my car with her father driving her and her husband through that February blizzard. Surreal. No rest – twenty minutes on a recovery bed. No instructions for healing - one signature and dismissal.

Our daughter is a superhero. She healed on her own while in the wheelchairs, hallways and bathrooms of Egleston Children's Hospital. But Ruby had the assistance of an army. Cute, sweet, pony-tailed nurses of Emory training and a team suggestions to CatnKids1@ of doctors, American and foreign named, each over

a specific organ system all of her systems were in jeopardy. But the bigger army was the thousands of folks who were praying for Ruby. All of the adults on both sides of the family represented dozens of congregations in several states. Prayer groups spread the word to more churches. Challenge Youth Conference, 12,000 youth from the Shoals and beyond who were convened in Gatlinburg, lifted Ruby up. Our son was in Houston leading at a youth service church camp where 1000 teenagers prayed for Ruby.
